

# MMC teachers protest attack on admin bldg

The teachers of Mymensingh Medical College (MMC) brought out a silent procession on the campus yesterday protesting attack on the administrative building by BCL men on Wednesday.

BCL enforced an indefinite strike at MMC from Wednesday as college authorities postponed students' union election, scheduled for June 18. The BCL activists locked the gate of the administrative building and vandalised its rooms.

After the incident, the college authorities lodged a general diary (GD) with Sadar Police Station and also formed a three-member committee to investigate the incident.

The BCL college unit also took out a procession and held a rally on the campus yesterday protesting postponement of the election. No classes and examinations were held.

The college authorities on Monday postponed the election, saying that final examinations of first, second and third year students will begin from July 1. "It is very difficult for us to hold the election, hampering the academic activities on the campus," said MMC Principal Prof Motiur Rahman.

Earlier on May 30, the BCL MMC unit went on an indefinite strike demanding college students union. They withdrew the strike on the following day after the college authorities assured them of holding the election in the shortest possible time.

Following a discussion with the BCL leaders, the authorities fixed July 18 to hold the election, college sources said.

On the other hand, Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) MMC unit has boycotted the election, alleging that the campus atmosphere is not conducive to holding election. In a memorandum submitted to the college authority recently, the JCD demanded a congenial atmosphere on the campus and safe stay of their supporters at college dormitories for a peaceful election.

# 12 hurt as BCL factions clash over tender

At least 12 activists were injured as two rival BCL factions locked in a fierce clash in the town over dropping tender of PWD yesterday noon.

Locals said yesterday was the last date for submitting bid as well as opening schedule in presence of the bidders for a Tk 1.20 crore work to build fire service office building at Jaldhaka.

Both the feuding factions were trying to get the work order. On Tuesday, the BCL faction led by former Sadar upazila committee general secretary Shourov prevented the other group led by Jahangir from dropping tender.

One Nurol Islam Nuru, favoured by Sourov, got the work on the same day after sorting the tenders which angered Jahangir.

Yesterday, both the groups became face-to-face, triggering a fierce clash.

During the clash, both the groups used sticks and brickbats chasing each other. Twelve people were injured in the clash that lasted for one hour.

Of the injured, Jahangir, 30, and Alamgir, 28, were admitted to Nilphamari 100-bed hospital with serious injury.

Contacted, Deepok Chakkraborty, president of district unit BCL said both Sourov and Jahangir are at present not involved with the AL-back student body.

## 24 families evicted in Barisal

Twenty-four families became homeless yesterday as the district administration evicted them from the land acquired for newly established Barisal University at Karnakathi village under Charkawa union of Barisal Sadar upazila.

A team of Barisal district administration accompanied by a large number of police cordoned Karnakathi village and surrounding areas at about 7:00am and completed the eviction within two hours, demolishing 24 establishments on four acres of land, said Sadikur Rahman, revenue deputy collector, Barisal.

There was an earlier government directive to establish Barisal University on 200 acres of public land on the Kirtonkhola River but later 50 acres of private land with huge movable and immovable properties of 52 families including those of a few freedom fighters was included for the project, said several eviction victims.

The selected lands include three mosques, 13 family graveyards, over 100 ponds and ditches, thousands of trees and 15 acres of waqf land under Babrullah Talukdar Waqf Estate, said Moksed Ahmed Talukdar, motawalli of the estate.

SM Arifur Rahman, deputy commissioner of Barisal, said the private lands were acquired as those are in better places for implementing the Barisal University project.

The university started admission and classes of its first batch of students at its temporary campus on Barisal Zila School on December 8 last year.

## MAY 31 CLASH ON CAMPUS 4 expelled by Hajee Danesh university

Four students of Hajee Danesh Science and Technology University (HSTU) were yesterday expelled temporarily for their involvement in a clash between two groups of students on the campus on May 31.

The expellees are Aninda Dutta, level-2 and semester-2, Raihanul Nabi, level-4 and semester-2, Ratan Ahmed, level-2 and semester-2 of Computer Science and Engineering Faculty, and BBM final year student Nahid Hossain.

Of them, Aninda was expelled for four semesters and fined Tk 5,000, Raihan for three semesters, Ratan for three semesters and Nahid for four semesters.

Campus sources said two groups of students clashed

while they were playing football on university playground on May 31.

On the following day, the academic council held an emergency meeting with Vice-Chancellor Professor M Afzal Hossain in the chair. The meeting formed a seven-member to investigate the incident.

The committee in its report submitted to the vice-chancellor on Wednesday held the four students responsible for the incident. It urged the university authorities to take action against the four for breach of discipline.

The Disciplinary Committee of HSTU held a meeting yesterday afternoon with VC Prof M Afzal Hossain in the chair. On the basis of the probe body's report, the Disciplinary Committee expelled the four students.

### BSF returns 4 women

Four Bangladeshi women were returned by BSF through the check post here on Wednesday night. The women who served two years in an Indian jail hailed from Bagerhat, Satkhira and Naogaon districts. OC Kamruzzaman of Benapole immigration police said, a group of human traffickers sent the young women to India promising good jobs there four years ago through Jessore border. Later, they were arrested by Kolkata police. A case was filed against them and the Indian court sentenced them to two years imprisonment for having no valid documents.

### Minor boy burnt alive

A five-year-old boy was roasted alive while his brother received severe burn injuries in Raruli union under Paikgachha upazila during a fire incident on Wednesday evening. The victim was identified as Minarul Islam, son of late Latif Sana, of village Bederdanga. Police and locals said, the fire broke out when Hafiza Khatun, a seven-year-old girl of Latif Sana was playing with fire near her house at around 6:30pm. Later, a devastating fire roasted alive her younger brother Minarul Islam and injured elder brother Monirul Islam, 16. Both were asleep in the room. Monirul was admitted to local health complex for treatment.

### Boy hacked to death

A teenage boy, who went missing on Sunday, was found dead at Navaran Jadabpur village in Sharsha upazila of the district on Wednesday night. The deceased was identified as Akash Hossain, 14, son of Ali Akbar of the village. On information, police recovered the body from a jute field behind Akij Biri Factory in Navaran and sent it to hospital morgue for autopsy. Jhikargachha police said criminals abducted Akash on Sunday from Navaran Bazar, hacked him to death and dumped the body in the field.

### Youth held with arms

A youth was arrested along with four foreign-made pistols, seven bullets and 8 cartridges in Choubarihat area of Manda upazila on Wednesday evening. Arrestee Rentu alias Kalu, 30, is son of Sirajul Islam of Telkupi village under Shahbazpur union in Shibganj upazila of Chapainawabganj district. Acting on a tip-off, a team of police in the guise of buyers contacted Rentu at 5:00pm, said OC of Manda PS Abdullahel Baki. Later, the police team, led by senior ASP Sharifuddin, went to Choubarihat area and arrested Rentu along with the arms and ammunition.
