

# 8th Wage Board

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According to an official handout, Justice Kazi Ebadul Haque, who is also a former chairman of the Bangladesh Press Council, would chair the board while six representatives of the newspaper owners and six from the journalists and employees were named as its members.

The six owner representatives are: Publisher and Editor of the Daily Star Mahfuz Anam, Editor of Prothom Alo Matiur Rahman, Editor of the daily

Azadi MA Malek, Managing Director and Chief Editor of BSS Ihsanul Karim, UNB's Chief Editor Enayetullah Khan, Chief Editor of the daily Manabjatin Matiur Rahman Chowdhury.

The representatives of the journalists and employees are: presidents of the two Federal Union of Journalists (BFUJ) Iqbal Sobhan Chowdhury and Ruhul Amin Gazi, President of Bangladesh Sangbadptra Karmachari Federation M Motiur Rahman Talukdar, Secretary General of

the federation M Khairul Islam, and President of Bangladesh Federal Union of Newspaper Press Workers M Alamgir Hossain Khan and Secretary General Mohammad Kamaluddin.

Information ministry Deputy Secretary Nazmul Hossain Khan has been made the secretary of the wage board.

The handout said the board would review the general cost of living, the existing salary and wage structures at government

offices, corporations and private organisations alongside the financial state and ability of the newspaper industry in suggesting enhanced wages and benefits for the newsmen and their colleagues in the industry.

It said the board also could make a specific proposal for the government to declare a dearness allowance for the interim period ahead of announcement of the wage board award.

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Liberation War and for killing innocent people," said Chairman of the Tribunal Justice Md Nizamul Huq before rejecting the petition.

Defence counsel Abdur Razzaq gave a submission for the review of charges on June 6.

Justice Nizamul Huq said the charges were duly framed against Ghulam Azam following rules and were clear enough. There is time to prove them wrong during the trial proceedings, so the petition is rejected, he added.

With this order there remains no bar to beginning the trial proceedings against the former Jamaat chief, said Prosecutor Zead Al Malum.

Earlier on June 10, the three-member tribunal following an opening statement given by the prosecution fixed June 24 for recording the statement of the first prosecution witness.

The International Crimes Tribunal-1 yesterday rejected another petition on transfer of the case.

The tribunal chief read out the order for about one and a half hours and mentioned some grounds for rejecting the petitions.

Defence counsel Abdur Razzaq gave a submission for transferring the case from the ICT-1 to the ICT-2 on June 5.

Razzaq submitted a newspaper report published on April 11, 1992 to the tribunal that read some lawyers in a rally demanded that the then government execute a verdict of hanging Ghulam Azam.

The verdict was passed by a people's court on March 26, 1992.

Ain jibi Somonnoy Parishad held a rally on April 10, 1992 and demanded that the government execute the verdict. Justice Nizamul Huq was present at the rally.

Since Justice Huq was

present at the rally, the defence fear they might be "prejudiced" if he conducts the trial.

The tribunal yesterday said the defence did not mention how the case will be transferred rather submitted the reasons for the plea.

Justice Huq then mentioned section-11 (A) of the International Crimes (Tribunals) Act, 1973, which only allows the chief prosecutor to appeal for the transfer of a case.

The tribunal can also voluntarily transfer a case for the sake of expediting trial proceedings, according to the Act.

From this point, the petition is liable to be rejected, said the tribunal chief.

In case of fair trial, the tribunal also elaborated its view.

Ghulam Azam has been provided with all facilities and the tribunal has issued several orders to the jail authorities at times to supply him amenities according to the defence's demands, said Justice Huq.

Therefore, fear of unfair trial is not correct and the petition is hereby rejected, he added.

Neither Ghulam Azam nor Abdur Razzaq was present at the tribunal.

Earlier, war crimes accused BNP leader Salahuddin Quader Chowdhury's defence counsel cross-examined prosecution witness Gouranga Singha.

Gouranga was mainly cross-examined for about one and a half hours on the surrounding area of Kundeswari village where Nutan Chandra Singha was allegedly killed by Salahuddin Quader during the War.

The proceeding of the case was adjourned until June 19.

Meanwhile, a counsel of another war crimes accused Delwar Hossain Sayedee yesterday submitted a petition to Tribunal-1 so that Sayedee could spend some time with his family before having an angiogram.

"My client thinks this test would be his last and he may not return alive from the operating theatre. That's why he wanted to see his family," said Sayedee's counsel Tajul Islam.

He told the court that Sayedee was supposed to have the angiogram yesterday around 9:00am but he did not want to go for it without seeing his family.

In response, the tribunal said the issue was beyond its jurisdiction. "We cannot interfere," said Nizamul Huq.

On Sunday, Tribunal-1 adjourned Sayedee's trial proceedings until Wednesday for the medical test and on a petition filed by the defence.

# ICT decision

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Kashem had signed his power of attorney over to his counsel Abdur Razzak.

Razzaq told the court that his 62-year-old client should be granted bail on medical grounds and that as a dignified person, Kashem had no intention to flee.

"He made no attempt to hide or abscond. We will make sure that he does not do so," said the defence.

Razzaq also termed the allegation of Kashem influencing witnesses totally "vague". "He did not make any contact with any prosecution witness," he told the court.

Chairman of the three-member tribunal Justice Nizamul Huq then asked the prosecution for its arguments against the petition.

Prosecutor Zead Al Mamun told the tribunal that witnesses might be killed or made to disappear if Kashem was granted bail.

He said Kashem was a

very influential man and the ongoing investigation against him might be hampered if he was freed.

"I appeal to the court not to grant him bail until the investigation is completed," said the prosecution.

The prosecution also made a mention of the brutality of Kashem-led Al Badr, the then auxiliary force of the Pakistan occupation army, in Chittagong in 1971.

The tribunal then fixed today to pass the order on the matter.

Kashem was arrested at the office of Bangla daily Naya Diganta in the capital's Motijheel area on Sunday, two hours within the tribunal had issued arrest warrant for the Jamaat leader for his alleged involvement with crimes against humanity during the Liberation War of 1971.

The tribunal later sent him to jail with a custody warrant.

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building and in many trade related services like certifying institutes for the quality of products exported from Bangladesh."

Asked what impressions he is taking back home about Bangladesh, the envoy said he has a very positive feeling about Bangladesh, and termed his stay here a very rewarding one. "It is a liberal society. Today's Bangladesh is a very open society."

He went on, "I have been impressed by the strength and the positive contribution of the civil society to development. It is an asset of Bangladesh that should be nurtured and utilised to the full benefit of the people."

Asked whether he sees any positive change happening in Bangladesh, Michael said "I am fascinated by the secular policies in Bangladesh. It is a great asset of the society. In the last decades, no major religion-based confrontations happened. Harmonious coexistence of people is a wonderful thing."

The inter-faith dialogue and the mutual recognition of being of different faiths and the respect of this difference is very commendable, also in comparison with other parts

of the world, he said.

"When [followers of] one religion celebrate their holiday in Bangladesh, members of other religions come and enjoy. This trait also could be used for the branding of Bangladesh, showing that it is a secular society without religious conflicts," he noted.

Michael also lauded women's empowerment, activating the productive force and giving women the opportunity to become members of the society. These are great assets of Bangladesh and contribute to a well diversified and fair image.

Asked about the current political debate over the next general election, the ambassador said, "As any election, also the forthcoming election in 2014 will have to be free, fair, equal and inclusive. The method, in which the election will be carried out, is the exclusive decision of Bangladesh and its people. Foreign observers have no say in it."

Turning again to German investment, he said Germany has an exciting and forward looking investment project in the area of shipping, intending to establish a container shuttle by ship between Chittagong and Dhaka to get the containers off the road and on

the water, instead.

He mentioned that a German company has specifically designed a high-tech ship for this route with state of the art technology and it will be built in Bangladesh, but he regretted that this project is being delayed due to bureaucratic obstacles.

The envoy identified lack of energy, difficulties in transportation, unrest, violence and hartals as major obstacles that hinder foreign investments.

"Foreign investors consider governance, including corruption, as another major problem. When German business people come and see me, asking for advice, they are worried about reports of renowned international organisations on corruption and they are worried about the reported little legal recourse in case of disputes," he said.

With regard to governance, Michael said consensus of the whole society is required to curb practices such as nepotism and corruption. "It is the task of the whole society to eradicate or at least minimise these evils," he said.

Meanwhile, ending his three-year diplomatic assignment in Dhaka, Michael is due to leave for home on June 24.

# Shifting sees

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market into DNCC office will seriously hamper the shifting of city's biggest wholesale kitchen market as it will discourage the Karwan Bazar traders to relocate to the suburbs of the capital, said sources at DNCC.

Besides, the under-construction markets in Jatrabari and Aminbazar will not be able to accommodate all the traders if the Mohakhali kitchen market is cancelled.

A total of 360 shops were planned for Mohakhali, 895 for Jatrabari and 527 for Aminbazar kitchen markets.

Asked about the conversion of Mohakhali market into DNCC office, Shahid Khan said the last caretaker government had decided to build the market just beside the Mohakhali Bus Terminal without proper consideration.

The communications ministry had raised an objection about the market and the LGED ministry favours keeping all the wholesale kitchen markets outside of the capital, he added.

Contacted, Sheikh Shamsul Alam Bulbul, general secretary of Karwan Bazar Market-2 Baboshaye Samity, claimed that the city corporation did not talk to them about the relocation.

It would be suitable for the traders if the market is shifted to Mohakhali, he mentioned adding, the two other sites -- Jatrabari and Aminbazar -- would be totally disastrous for the tradesmen. "We will lose our capital if we go there."

Talking to The Daily Star, Project Director Abdur Razzaq said if the Jatrabari and Aminbazar markets cannot accommodate all the wholesale traders of Karwan Bazar, the DNCC will add more floors to these markets.

Visiting the under-construction markets recently, this correspondent found the construction work (phase II) at Aminbazar kitchen market did not begin.

The concessionaire, MR Trading, has completed around 80 percent work so far and stopped the construction in last December

citing irregular payment by the project authority.

About 60 percent construction work of Jatrabari kitchen market has already been completed.

It will take six more months to finish the construction of Mohakhali kitchen market, said Haradhan Rudra Pal, project engineer of Jony Enterprise, the concessionaire of the scheme.

There is a dispute over a land of Aminbazar kitchen market (phase-II) located outside the flood protection embankment, said Project Director Abdur Razzaq.

"We are going to impose Tk 1.50 crore penalty on MR Trading for quitting the project and will appoint a new construction firm to complete it," mentioned Razzaq, executive engineer at DNCC.

Another land dispute has delayed the construction of Jatrabari market and the project authorities are trying to resolve it, he added.

Regarding using the space of Karwan Bazar kitchen market after the relocation, he said the authorities have not yet decided on that.
