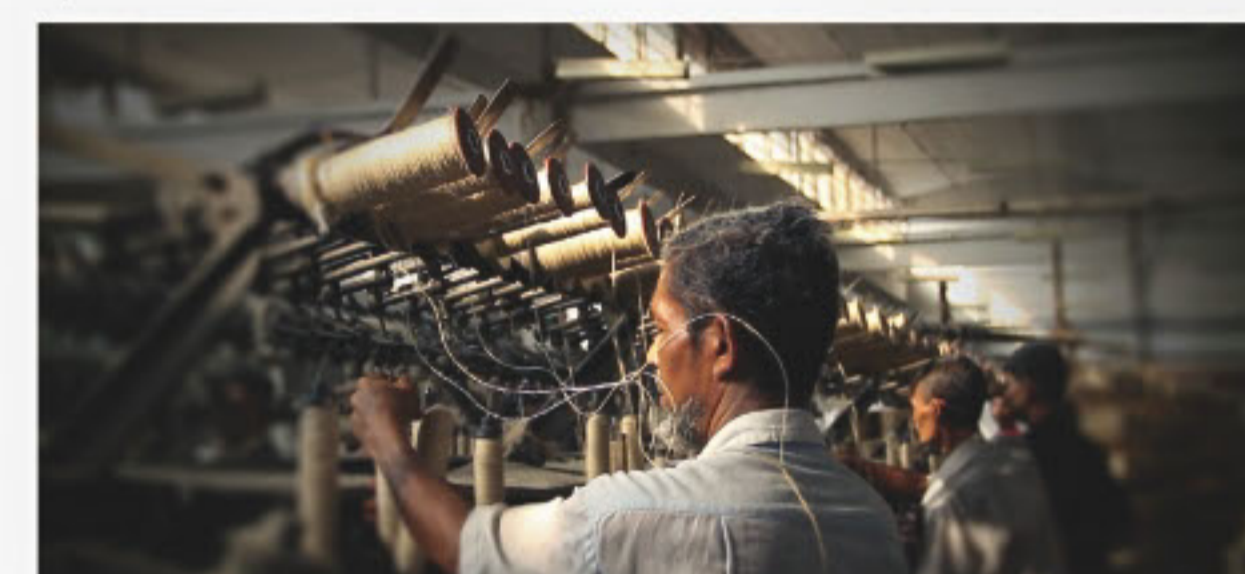
Made of gold

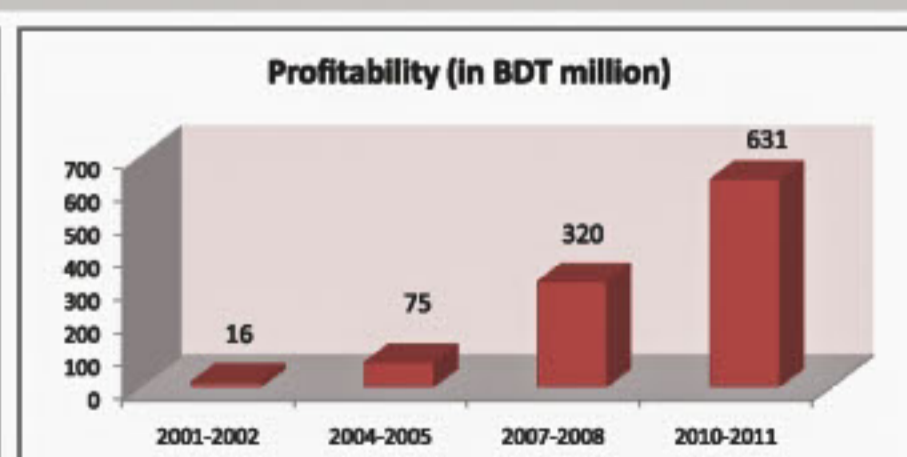
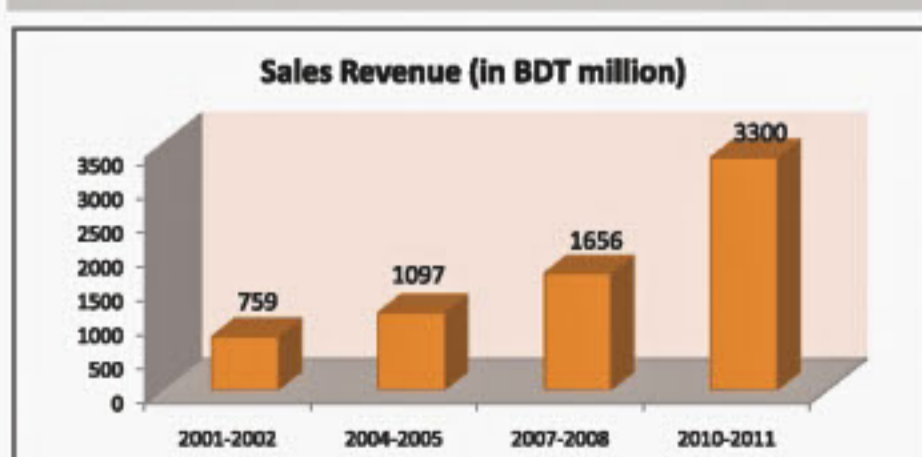
