## BCL men foil freshers' reception in Ishwardi

A freshers' reception programme at Pakshey Railway Degree College in Ishwardi upazila was yesterday foiled allegedly by BCL men.

College sources said the BCL men vandalised the podium erected for the programme on the campus, alleging that their leaders were not invited to address the students who have just started their first year at the college.

At the beginning of the programme, BCL activists led by Abul Hossain, president of Pakshey unit, and Md Rakibul Islam, president of the college unit, came to the venue and requested the college authorities to give their leaders a chance to say something to the freshers, said a teacher of the college, requesting anonymity.

As the college authorities refused to allow all the leaders of BCL college unit to give speeches to the new students, they got angry, ransacked the venue and forced the college authorities to postpone the programme, the teacher said.

Contacted, Principal Md Monirul Islam said a few BCL men attacked the reception venue. "We have later managed the situation," he added.

Refuting the allegation, BCL college unit President Rakibul said the second year students, who were not accorded reception by the college authorities last year, had created the untoward situation.

The college authorities did not file any case in connection with the incident as of filing of this report at 5:00pm yesterday.

Ahmed Sharif Dablu, President of BCL Pabna district unit, said they will investigate the incident. "If any BCL man is found guilty, we will take stern action against him, Dablu added.

## Jubo League activists held on extortion charge

Police arrested three Jubo league activists in an extortion case filed with Baufal police station yesterday.

The arrestees are Anisur Rahman, 35, president of ward no. 4 of Surjomoni union under Baufal upazila and Sumon, 22 and Saddam, 23, of the area.

Police said the authorities of Indrokul High School recently started construction work of two buildings.

Two BCL activists, allegedly led by Anisur, demanded Tk 2 lakh as toll from assistant headmaster Harun-ur-Rashid at about 11:00am.

Angered by refusal, they assaulted two workers and tried to stop the construction work forcibly.

As the news spread, students and locals caught the trio and gave them a good beating, leaving them injured.

On information, police arrested them from the spot, said the officer incharge of Baufal police station.

Following the incident, headmaster Mizanur Rahman filed a case accusing the three activists at noon, the OC added.

# Bipul's 'main killer' still at large

Hajee Danesh Science and Technology University (HSTU) of Dinajpur, which was closed on June 11 following the death of a student, reopened yesterday.

After the death of Fahim Mahfuz Bipul, 23, of final year Veterinary Science on June 9, Dr Boloram Roy, acting registrar of HSTU, filed a case with Dinajpur police station,

accusing six people including Mrinal Kumar Goswami, a suspended class four employee of the university.

The other accused were unidentified.

Police later arrested two people in this connection.

Demanding arrest of Mrinal and other accused, students, teachers and employees of the university yesterday formed a human chain on Dinajpur-Dhaka highway near the

A mourning procession was also brought out on the campus.

Fahim Mahfuz Bipul, also vice president of HSTU Chhatra League, was attacked by some outsiders led by Mrinal Kumar Goswami and stabbed in broad daylight near the campus.

Locals rescued Bipul and took him to Dinajpur Medical College and Hospital where he succumbed to his injuries.

Md Abdul Mojid, investigation officer (IO) of the murder case, said police arrested Kamruzzaman Kamu, 22, son of Fazlur Rahman of Karnai village under Dinajpur Sadar upazila and Ali Akbar Liton, 20, son of Md Shamsul Haque of Mostafabag under

Dinajpur town. However, prime accused Mrinal is still at large, he said.
