The five activists are Amirul Islam Khan Alim, Kamal Anwar Ahmed, Meer Sarafat Ali Sofu, Abdul Matin and Badal Hossain.

All accused are now in Kashimpur jail in Gazipur.

A HC bench of Justice Kamrul Islam Siddiqui and Justice Abu Taher Md Saifur Rahman granted them bail after a hearing on a petition filed by the accused. Barrister Raghib

Chowdhury, a lawyer for the petitioners, told The Daily Star that there is no legal bar to his clients' release from jail following the HC order.

# ACC quizzes Destiny boss

The Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) officials yesterday further interrogated Destiny Group Chairman Rafiqul Amin, also managing director of Destiny 2000 Ltd, over various allegations of irregularities and corruption in his organisations.

A three-member team of the ACC led by its Director Squadron Leader Tahidul Islam quizzed Rafiqul Amin for three hours beginning at 11:15am. ACC officials said aside from interrogation, the Destiny

Group chairman submitted some evidential documents that are in his favour against the alleged irregularities in the tree plantation project of the so-called multi-level marketing company. While departing the ACC office, Rafiqul Amin, in response

to journalists' queries, said, "They [ACC] asked me about how many trees we planted and where we planted them. I replied that we could not yet plant all the trees and so far have planted about one third of the total number of trees." In addition to Destiny Tree Plantation, he was asked

about some allegations regarding Destiny Multipurpose Cooperative and Destiny 2000 Ltd, he said. Earlier, Rafiqul Amin went to the ACC office several times

to submit information and documents. The ACC so far interrogated over 40 former and present officials of the MLM company after various allegations like

money laundering, illegal banking, and transferring shareholders' money to personal accounts of some of the officials were raised.

### Ex-Indian president due tomorrow

Former Indian president Dr APJ Abdul Kalam will arrive here tomorrow on a two-day visit to attend the 33rd Foundation Day Celebration of the Centre on Integrated Rural Development for Asia and the Pacific (Cirdap).

Dr Durga P Paudyal, director general of Cirdap, made the announcement at a press conference at Cirdap cafeteria last evening.

This will be Dr Kalam's second visit to Bangladesh. He first came here on July 19, 2009.

During his stay in Dhaka, he will meet Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina and deliver Cirdap Foundation Day lecture on "Providing Urban Amenities in Rural Areas (PURA).

Dr Kalam is scheduled to arrive at Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport at 3:15pm and will be received by officials of the foreign ministry, High Commission of India and Cirdap.

On the first day, he will call on Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina at Prime Minister's Office, attend an interview by a TV channel and attend Cirdap Foundation Day dinner.

On the second and concluding day, the former Indian president will attend the celebration of Cirdap's 33rd foundation day and deliver the lecture. He will also be interacting with children and youths of Bangladesh and Cirdap member countries at 3:00pm on that day.
