Power outage protested in Pathar Ghata

Local people protested power outage in Pathar Ghata area of Chittagong city yesterday.

They staged demonstration in front of the Power Development Board (PDB) office, Pathar Ghata Division, as power supply in the area remained suspended since July 4.

Jalal Uddin, ward councillor of the area, said he had informed the PDB office of the power crisis four days ago, but they did not change the damaged transformer saying that they did not have an extra one.

PADMA BRIDGE

Suranjit for self Sammilito Ainjibi Samannoy Parishad (Sasp), a forum of the lawyers backed by ruling The lawyers backed by ruling

Awami League Advisory Council member and minister without portfolio Suranjit Sengupta yesterday said the Padma bridge would be constructed with own financing of the country, if required. "Besides, Bangalees will not yield to

prescription of any controversial agency in the work of the bridge," the minister said while speaking as the chief guest at a discussion in the capital. Suranjit said, "We have to construct the

Padma bridge for the sake of our socioeconomic necessity and there is no alternative to it." Bangabandhu Nagorik Sanghati Parishad held the discussion on "In the world demo-

cratic system, election is held under the elected government" at the auditorium of Dhaka Reporters Unity marking its seventh founding anniversary.

Pointing at the opposition, Suranjit said, Everybody wants that you would extend support to the government on an issue of national importance like Padma bridge for the people's sake. Instead, it is not desirable that you are nodding for implementation of the agenda of a foreign agency."

Referring to an article of Vice-Chancellor of Brac University Prof Jamilur Reza Choudhury, Suranjit said in his article Prof Reza mentioned that there was no corruption in the Padma bridge. Rather, he said the World Bank was upset of Bangladesh as a Chinese company was not allowed to indulge in corruption.

He alleged that the WB has been playing tricks in many ways to put someone special in the limelight through implementation of its hidden agenda as Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina had given priority on investment in two sectors by ignoring its prescription to construct roads closing the railway and river way.

Turning to the report of the New Yorkbased Human Rights Watch, Suranjit said, "It was nothing but interference into the country's internal affairs and that its suggestion regarding the dismantling of the RAB was unacceptable and tantamount to audacious attitude."

Dhaka City Awami League General Secretary Mofazzal Hossain Chowdhury Maya, Publicity Secretary Abdul Huq Sabuj and Principal Md Abdul Halim also spoke.

MS Rod Transportation from Ctg stops today

MS rod and Iron-Made Goods Transportation Owners Co-Council has decided to stop carrying MS rod and other ironmade products from and to Chittagong city for an indefinite period from today demanding security on highways.


Abu Mojaffar, convener of the council, said despite several requests the administration is yet to take necessary steps to stop criminal activities including murder, abduction and robbery on the highways.

"We have been compelled to take the decision in this situation," he said.

Incidents of the criminal activities on the highways including Dhaka-Chittagong highway, Dhaka metro and suburb areas have increased in recent days, he added.

The council members transport imported and exportable products from and to Chittagong port and different steel rerolling mills in the country.

ILLEGAL STRUCTURES

Over 100 removed in capital

Dhaka North City Corporation (DNCC) yesterday in a drive demolished more than a hundred illegal structures in the city's Gabtoli and Mohammadpur areas.

Two teams led by executive magistrates Kazi Shafiqul Alam and Sheikh Kamal Hossain conducted the drives from 10:30am to 2:00pm and demolished illegal bus-ticket counters, footpath eateries, billboards, banners, makeshift shops and hawkers.

Shafiqul told this correspondent that they launched the eviction drive in different parts of Gabtoli area with the assistance of police.

Another team assisted by the police conducted a drive in Saat Masjid Road, Town Hall kitchen market and Azam Road of Mohammadpur area and removed billboards, banners, and demolished some other illegal structures, said DNCC Executive Magistrate Kamal.

The owners of the demolished structures alleged that the DNCC did not give them time to remove their possessions before the eviction.

However, Shafiqul said the illegal owners were informed of the eviction earlier.

In a bid to keep city footpaths free for public movement and ease traffic congestion on the streets, the LGRD ministry on Monday strictly directed the authorities concerned to remove all illegal roadside establishments including the offices of different political and social organisations, temporary "mango fair" stalls and banners-festoons within 12 noon on Tuesday.

Earlier, drives were conducted in different areas including Farmgate, Mohakhali, Gulshan-1, Gulshan-2, Chankharpool, Motijheel, Fakirer Pool and New Market.

Despite the ultimatum, many occupiers of the footpaths have been reluctant to dismantle or shift the illegal structures, mainly political offices, in many areas of the city. Yet yesterday, many mango stalls, and large banners and festoons -- mainly carrying political message -- were visible in different areas.

HR VIOLATION

Govt tarnishing country's image

BNP acting Secretary General Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir yesterday said violation of human rights by the government is tarnishing the country'simage abroad.

Referring to recent reports about the country's human rights situation released by Human Rights Watch and the US State Department, he said, "the reports give a horrific picture of human rights violation by the government which has destroyed the country's image abroad".

He was addressing a symbolic hunger strike programme at National Press Club in the capital.

The party's Uttara thana unit organised the programme demanding release of former Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) President Azizul Bari Helal. Helal contested the

general election in 2008 from Uttara (Dhaka-18) constituency. But he was defeated by Home Minister Sahara Khatun in the poll. Opposition leaders and workers are facing torture and

repression in the constituency, Fakhrul said adding that Helal was arrested, as he was contending against the home minister in the election. Urging the party men to

be prepared for a tougher anti-government movement, he said, "Be prepared for the movement, and we will compel the government
