The longer they watch, the larger their waistlines become



Children who increase the number of hours of weekly television they watch between the ages of two and four years risk larger waistlines by age 10. A Canadian study found that every

extra weekly hour watched could add half a millimetre to their waist circumference and reduce muscle fitness.

The study, in a BioMed Central journal, tracked the TV habits of 1,314 children.

Experts say children should not watch more than two hours of TV a day.
