

# All ten Dimla UP chairmen allege corruption by PIO

All the ten union parishad chairmen of Dimla upazila have recently lodged a complaint with the ministry concerned alleging that the upazila project implementation officer (PIO) took bribe for implementing rural infrastructural development programmes.

The complainants in their petition submitted on July 1 said that PIO Mozibar Rahman forced the project committee chairmen to pay Tk 1800 against each tonne of rice to issue delivery order (DO).

About 500 projects in different areas of the upazila were implemented in 2011-12 fiscal year under the rural infrastructural development programmes for which 850 metric tonnes of rice was allocated, sources said. According to the allegation, the Dimla PIO thus realised Tk 15 lakh as bribe from all the project chairmen against issuance of the DO.

The PIO even realised money from the projects of renovation work of mosques, temples and other religious establishments, the complainants said.

"I have raised the matter at the monthly co-ordination meeting of the upazila this month in presence of local lawmaker Jafar Iqbal Siddique seeking justice," said Rabiul Islam, vice chairman of Dimla upazila parishad and one of the signatories to the complaint.

He further alleged that since filing of the complaint, the PIO has not been attending his office regularly.

Chairman of Gayabari union parishad Sharif Ibne Faisal Moon alleged that the work of many projects in his area become of sub standard quality as the Dimla PIO realised a big amount of money from the project chairmen concerned for issuing delivery order.

Zahidul Islam, chairman of Balapara union parishad, said many project chairmen in his union were compelled to pay the PIO from their own pockets.

Lawmaker of Damar-Dimla constituency Jafar Iqbal Siddique said he was aware of the allegation. "If the allegations are found true, I shall ask the higher authorities to take action," he added.

Dimla UNO Abu Rafa Md Arif said, he got a copy of the complaint sent to the ministry of disaster, relief and rehabilitation.

Contacted, Dimla PIO Mozibar Rahman refuted the allegations. He said false allegations were brought against him as he did not allow any irregularities and went for strong monitoring of the projects.

# Indigenous people reiterate their demand for land commission

The indigenous people here yesterday demanded immediate formation of a separate land commission to protect their rights and to bring an end to their sufferings.

They said they were becoming landless as criminals and local influential people, in collusion with a section of officials, were grabbing their lands.

At a view exchange meeting with the journalists of both print and electronic media in the town yesterday, they urged the authorities to meet their 9-point demand.

District unit of Jatiya Adivasi Parishad, a platform for the indigenous people, organised the programme while its president Surjo Mormu presided.

Social, economic and political rights of the indigenous people are yet to be established. Many indigenous families have been evicted from their ancestral land and homesteads as local influential people grabbed their lands, the indigenous leaders said.

They called to declare all the fake documents to grab their land illegal and withdrawal of all false cases against the indigenous people.

The indigenous community is still lagging behind in the society as they are not getting facilities like others in the fields of education and job, they further said.

They also demanded allocation of khas land among the landless indigenous people for their survival.

The 9-point demand of the indigenous community included establishment of constitutional rights of indigenous people and formation of a separate land commission to protect their land rights.

The speakers at the discussion said that the indigenous people became victim of discrimination in different fields as the government did not pay proper attention to their causes.

They called to establish a separate ministry for indigenous people to deal with their problems.

The speakers also demanded mother tongue-based primary education for their children and the community's quota in higher education and government service.

# 10 hurt as Shibir, police clash

## 40 arrested in Noakhali

At least 10 people, including two policemen, were injured in a clash between the law enforcers and Chhatra Shibir activists in front of the municipal market in the district town around 12 noon yesterday.

Police arrested 40 people, including Shibir workers, shopkeepers and pedestrians from the spot.

Police and witnesses said, about 150 Shibir leaders and workers brought out a procession from Noakhali municipal building yesterday noon to welcome Ramadan and call for maintaining sanctity of the month. When they tried to hold a rally in front of the municipal market, police obstructed them.

The Shibir workers pelted brickbats at police and one of them tried to snatch a rifle from a police constable, police claimed.

Police charged baton on the Shibir workers to disperse them.

Police constables Amirul and Md Shahjahan were injured as bricks hurled by the Shibir activists hit them.

The two have been admitted to Noakhali Medical College Hospital. Eight injured Shibir workers were taken to a local clinic.

Sudharam Model PS Officer-in-charge (OC) Abul Kalam said, police was compelled to charge baton as the Chhatra Shibir workers hurled brickbats at the

# SIX-POINT DEMAND

## Class boycott at Rangamati TTC

Students of Technical Training Centre (TTC) in the district yesterday boycotted classes to press home their six-point demand.

The demands include reopening of students' hostel, giving monthly stipend and training allowance, recruitment of adequate teachers, keeping the library open during school period and introduction higher training course.

The agitating students boycotted their classes in the morning and locked all the gates of the academic building during the protest.

At the programme, Suppan Chakma, a student of class ten at TTC, said they were not getting stipend for the last 17 months.

"Our classes do not take place regularly due to shortage of teachers", said another student, Shimul Chakma.

Later, the protesters withdrew their class boycott following an assurance by Principal AKM Shamsul Islam of taking steps to meet the demands.

We have sent a letter to the higher authorities providing stipend for the students, said the principal.

### Schoolboy murdered

A schoolboy was murdered in Tangail town yesterday morning. Police arrested Akter Hossain Faisal, 38, a neighbour, in connection with the murder. The victim was identified as Krishna Das, 12, a Class V student of Rukinikanto Govt Primary School and son of Shosthi Das of Biswas Betka area in the town. Locals said, Faisal took Krishna to a lonely place and repeatedly hit on his head by a piece of brick, leaving him seriously injured. The injured boy was taken to Tangail General Hospital and later sent to Dhaka. But he succumbed to his injuries on the way, police said.

### Muggers kill truck driver

A truck driver was stabbed to death by criminals near BCMC College in the district town early yesterday. The victim was identified as Haidar Ali, 40, resident of Barandipara area in the town and son of Taher Sheikh of Palpara village in Sadar upazila of Pirojpur district. Police said a gang waylaid Haidar near the college at about 4am while he was returning to his Barandipara house by a rickshaw after keeping his truck in Monihar area of the town. They stabbed him indiscriminately and looted his mobile phone set and cash and fled the scene. The victim was rushed to Jessore Medical College Hospital where the doctors declared him dead.

### Bombs recovered

Police recovered two powerful hand bombs from an abandoned room near Monihar bus stand in the district town early yesterday. Acting on secret information, a police team led by sub-inspector Sabbir rushed to the spot late at night and recovered the bombs from the room. None was arrested in this connection.

Police recovered the body of a young man from Surma River at Kushighat point in the city on Friday morning. The deceased was identified as Mohammad Abdal, 26, son of Kabir Mia of Kagojpur village in Osmaninagar area. Police suspected that criminals following a previous enmity strangled Abdal late at night and dumped the body in the river.
