

# CALL FOR CLIMATE CHANGE ADAPTIVE RESEARCH PROPOSALS

Funded by the Danish International Development Assistance (Danida), the Agriculture Sector Program Support (ASPS II) has extensive field activities within the crop, livestock, fisheries, and rural road sub-sectors and involves a range of stakeholders, including extension services, research agencies, Community Based Organizations (CBOs), Farmer Clubs/Groups, Local Contracting Societies (LCSs) and the private sector.
