Ariful Haque Chowdhury Ripon, who was released yesterday, along with his wife Bonya Chowdhury came to the office near the DMCH police camp to share their experience.

"As a group of angry interns along with several Chhatra League activists and outsiders were approaching, other journalists left the room. We also locked the door from inside. But they broke into the room and swooped on the patient, his wife and me," added

"They then took me, the patient and his wife to the DMCH director's room, from where we were sent to Gabtali by an ambulance. But I got down from the ambulance at Nilkhet," the journalist said.

Meanwhile, the interns vandalised the reporters' office and locked it. They also posted a banner at the emergency gate mentioning a ban on journalists entrance to DMCH.

After the incident leaders of different journalists' organisations including Dhaka Reporters Unity (DRU) and Crime Reporters' Association of Bangladesh (CRAB) went to DMCH to talk to the authorities around 2:00pm. As the reach the entrance of the emergency department a band of 30-40 interns, BCL activists and outsiders led by DMCH Deputy Director Mushfiqur Rahman again swooped on the journalists and beat them up.

During the attack they broke at least four cameras and a motorcycle, and beat the journalists up.

The injured are GTV reporter Sayedur Islam, Focus Bangla photojournalist Dipu Hazra, Desh TV reporter Mahmudul Hasan, Daily Jugantor senior reporter Moniruzzaman Ujjal, Justnews reporter

The journalists received treatment at different city hospitals including Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Medical University.

CRAB president Aktaruzzaman Lavlu said a group of doctors suddenly attacked them in presence of police when they went to DMCH to talk about the incident with the authori-

"The doctors attacked journalists and ransacked their room though they didn't enter the hospital today [yesterday] according to the authorities' direction. We wanted to talk about the issue with the director, yet they attacked us," he added.

The journalists were being attacked for last three days in presence of police, he alleged.

Mushfigur Rahman, however, denied the allegation of his involvement in the incident. But he declined to comment further on the incident.

"Journalists are responsible for the overall indiscipline in the hospital. They take photographs without the authorities' consent and roam all over the hospital. It can't be accepted," Mushfiqur Rahman, told The Daily Star on Tuesday.

Sirajul Islam, officer-incharge of Shahbagh police, told The Daily Star that nobody had been arrested following the incident. He did not say anything about the role of police.

Meanwhile, Health Minister AFM Ruhal Haque yesterday directed the health secretary to form a one-member probe committee headed by a joint secretary of the ministry to investigate the assault inci-

Two cases were lodged last night with Shahbagh Police Station against 10 DMCH doctors, including Mushfiqur Rahman, and 100 to 150 unnamed others in this connection. Three general diaries were also lodged with the same police station.

On Monday, in a formal letter "upon discussions with patients, doctors and visitors", DMCH authorities imposed restrictions on journalists' access to the hospital. They also directed the journalists to obtain permission from the authorities for entry during and after the office hours.

The authorities have also banned taking photographs inside the facility without permission.

Recently, a senior doctor has recently reportedly assaulted a patient physically. The news was published in several newspa-

According to the reports, DMCH Deputy Director Ariful Haque Chowdhury Ripon, who was injured in a road accident, was admitted to DMCH on June 29.

The doctor pulled Ripon off his bed, slapped him and discharged him from the hospital after an altercation between Ripon and a female intern over dressing his wounds on July 17. The interns later staged

demonstrations on DMCH premises and assaulted six journalists "in protest against" publication of the news.

The authorities also termed the news "false and ill-motivated" and imposed restrictions on the media's access to "restore discipline' on the hospital campus.

However, medical representatives and visitors were seen coming to the hospital every now and then. In the past few months even some incidents of theft of new born baby and burglaries took place at the hospital.

### 'Armed conflict possible in S China Sea'

AFP, Manila

Tensions over competing claims in the South China Sea could escalate into conflict, with an arms build-up among rival nations raising the temperature, an international think tank warned Tuesday.

Prospects of solving the disputes "seem to be diminishing" after a recent failure by the 10-nation Asean grouping to hammer out a "code of conduct" that would govern actions in the sea, the International Crisis Group (ICG) said. "Without a consensus on

a resolution mechanism, tensions in the South China Sea can easily spill over into armed conflict," warned Paul Quinn-Judge, the ICG's program director for Asia.

vital posts including president, general secretary and organising secretary. Besides, some influential BNP leaders, who were also student leaders, are lobbying for their own men to be entrusted with these posts to ensure their control over JCD, insiders say.

To overcome this situation, Khaleda Zia has started holding meetings with the central leaders of the organisation and a new committee comprising JCD's senior and junior leaders might be announced soon, the insiders add.

Tenure of JCD's current committee expired a year ago, but the BNP high command could not take any decision regarding the new committee due to disputes and conflicts among JCD ranks and file over its leadership.

Shahid Uddin Chowdhury Annee, MP, student affairs secretary of the main opposition BNP, said they are working to form a new committee. "Process is underway and the chairperson will announce

the committee in time," he told The Daily Star.

Meanwhile, besides the ICD leaders and workers, many influential BNP leaders who are former student leaders are trying their best to ensure their dominance in the new committee.

Party insiders say Khaleda would announce the new committee, as JCD, which is considered the country's one of the biggest student organisations, could not hold its council since 1993 due to internal feuds. On several occasions in

the past JCD factions even engaged in gunfights whenever the BNP high-ups had planned to hold a council. Factional clashes also marked almost each announcement of new committee in last 15 years.

Khaleda held a meeting with the central committee leaders on July 19. Meeting sources say around 27 leaders got the chance to express their opinions regarding formation of the new committee.
