

Upazila chairman suspended on corruption charge

Allegation against UP chairman

Ullapara Upazila Parishad Chairman Zahedul Haque has been suspended on charges of corruption, misuse of power and misbehaviour with the elected representatives.

M Kazi Emdadul Haq, senior assistant secretary of the Ministry of Local Government and Rural Development (LGRD), informed Ullapara Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) Atul Sarker through a fax message on Tuesday afternoon.

On May 20, chairmen of 13 union parishads and two vice chairmen of Ullapara Upazila Parishad brought a no-confidence motion against the UZ chairman for his alleged corruption, misuse of power and misbehaviour with the elected public representatives and submitted it to Rajshahi Divisional Commissioner

the following day.

Divisional Commissioner Swapan Kumar Roy launched an investigation on July 12 and found the allegations against the UZ Chairman Zahedul to be true. On the basis of the investigation report, the Local Governed Division issued the suspension order on Tuesday.

Vice Chairman Khalilur Rahman has been given the charge of acting upazila parishad chairman. Contacted, Zahedul termed it a conspiracy against him by a group of UP chairmen.

Lawmaker Shafiqul Islam from Sirajganj-4 constituency declined to make any comment on the issue. UNO Atul Sarker said he has already sent the copies of the order to all concerned.

Our Rangamati correspondent reported that the chairman of Borohorina Union Parishad (UP) under Barkal upazila has been

charged with corruption.

Ward members, traditional leaders (karbaries) and VGF programme beneficiaries brought the allegation against the UP Chairman, Sanjoy Moni Chakma on Wednesday. They later submitted the allegation to the upazila nirbahi officer (UNO), seeking immediate action against the chairman.

They alleged that UP Chairman Sanjoy embezzled money from different projects including test relief (TR), food for work, Vulnerable Group Feeding (VGF) and Vulnerable Group Development (VGD).

The complainants include Dhono Bikash Chakma, member of ward No 6, Reboti Ranjan Chakma, member of ward No 1, Dhono Lal Chakma, member of ward No 4 and Buddha Debi Chakma, female member of ward Nos 4, 5 and 6.

Indefinite transport strike in Sherpur

Local transport leaders said some local transport workers were beaten by transport workers of Mymensingh on Tuesday afternoon.

Local transport leaders called the strike, demanding punishment of the attackers. Sanwar Hossain Sanu, president of local Bus-coach Owners' Association, said that through loudhailers they informed local people of the strike on Tuesday night.

The strike caused immense troubles to the commuters.

Former CS jailed in corruption case

A Pabna court sentenced a former civil surgeon to one year imprisonment in a corruption case on Monday.

The convict is Dr Md Abdur Rashid, former civil surgeon of Sirajganj district. The Special Judge's Court also fined him Tk two Lakh, in default he is to suffer three months more in jail.

Md Amirul Islam, assistant director of the Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC), filed the case against Dr Rashid with Sirajganj Police Station on

April, 15, 2000.

In the case statement, the complaint said Dr Md Abdur Rashid, civil surgeon of Sirajganj, approved the offer of the second lowest bidder to supply medicines in the fiscal 1998-99. Thus, the government incurred a loss of Tk 3,88,040, the complainant stated.

Special Judge Amulla Kumar Sarkar pronounced the verdict at noon. "He was punished under Section 5 (2) of the Anti-Corruption Act of 1947," said Md Abdul Karim, deputy director of ACC Pabna Zonal office.

Co-accused of Limon surrenders to court

Md Jahangir Zamaddar, charge-sheeted along with college student Limon Hossain in two cases filed by Rab on March 23, 2011, surrendered to Jhalakathi courts yesterday.

Police pressed charges against Limon and seven others in two cases---one filed under the Arms Act another for obstructing law enforcers from performing their duties.

Court sources said Jahangir, son of Hamid Zamaddar of Noikathi village under Razapur upazila of Jhalakathi district, surrendered to the Special Tribunal in connection with the arms case.

Manzurul Imam, judge of the tribunal, rejected the bail prayer and sent him to jail. Later, police produced Jahangir before the Senior

Judicial Magistrate's Court where he surrendered in connection with the second case and sought bail.

Magistrate Shamsul Alam also sent Jahangir to jail, rejecting his bail prayer. The hearing on charge framing will be held at the Judicial Magistrate's Court on September 2 while at the Special Tribunal on September 16, court sources said.

Sub-Inspector Ariful Islam, also the investigation officer of the two cases, submitted charge sheets against Limon, Morshed, Zamal, Hatu Mizan, Jahangir Zamaddar, Halim, Labu Zamaddar and Sumon on April 24, 2011 and July 1, 2012.

Limon, who was maimed by Rab shooting in Jhalakathi on March 23, 2011, was earlier granted bail in both the cases.

Youth killed in Habiganj clash

Sunamganj accused arrested

A young man was killed and at least 10 people were injured in a clash between two groups over a piece of disputed land at Shankarpasha village in Sadar upazila on Tuesday.

The deceased was identified as Nesar Mia, son of Jalal Mia of the same village.

Locals said, there had been a longstanding dispute between Golam Mostafa Member and Arab Ali of the village over the ownership of the land.

The clash ensued as Arab Ali along with his men tried to occupy the land. Later, both the groups equipped with lethal weapons attacked each other at noon, leaving Nesar Mia and ten others injured.

Critically injured Nesar Mia was rushed to Sadar Hospital where the duty doctor declared him dead.

Of the injured, Golam Hakkani, Jalal Mia, Jamir Ali, Rezia Khatun and Nasima Khatun were admitted to the Sadar Adhunik Hospital.

In Sunamganj, another young man was shot dead and three others bullet-hit in a fierce clash between two rival groups over previous enmity at Raibangali village in Derai upazila on Tuesday afternoon, reports our staff correspondent in Sylhet.

The deceased was identified as Ali Hossain, 35, son of Hasan Ullah of the village.

SI Ziaur Rahman of Derai PS said there was a longstanding dispute between Zahir Ali and Ali Hossain of the village. On Tuesday, supporters of Zahir Ali attacked and opened fire on Ali Hossain's men in the afternoon triggering a bloody clash that left Ali Hossain dead on the spot and seven others injured.

Golam Rabbani, cousin of the deceased, later filed a case accusing Zahir and 59 others.

Police arrested prime accused Zahir Ali when he went to surrender his licensed firearm to Sunamganj Sadar police station yesterday.

The People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a grant [No. TF010526] administered by IDA in the amount of US\$ 0.2 million toward the cost of the Establishment of Secretariat for the Bangladesh Climate Change Resilience Fund Project to be implemented by the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MOEF). The Ministry of Environment and Forests intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for the provision of consultancy services for the project by hiring a Climate Change Technical Advisor.

2. The objective of this consultancy is to fulfill three functions of the secretariat viz. (a) provide logistic support to the Governing Council and Management Committee of BCCRF, (b) provide advocacy, communications and coordination support to all agencies implementing activities funded by BCCRF, and to (c) develop a long term plan to enhance the capacity of MOEF to effectively manage climate change activities.

3. The broad tasks to meet the objectives of this consultancy will include, but not necessarily be limited to the following:
a. Setting up the secretariat- It includes office renting, staff recruitment, set up procurement rules and procedures based on existing rules of World Bank and the Bangladesh Government, procurement of goods and services and development of public information tools and outreach materials.
b. Governing Council and Management Committee Meetings- Prepare agenda and documents for Governing Council and Management Committee meetings in collaboration with the World Bank team and ensure full attendance and participation; prepare the BCCRF work plan and budget in collaboration with the World Bank team; liaise with the line ministries to help prepare grant requests to be tabled before Management Committee for consideration; handle logistical arrangements for Management Committee and Governing Council meetings; guide Governing Council and Management Committee members - in collaboration with the World Bank team - to achieve the meetings' objectives, and promote effective meeting procedures and behaviors; facilitate preparation of closing resolutions/agreements reached for meetings, recording proceedings in minutes; maintain open communications with the World Bank team, resolving day to day issues, and share higher level decisions to Management; ensure that Implementation Manual is updated to reflect recommendations from the Governing Council, Management Committee, and the World Bank team and prepare minutes of the Management Committee and Governing Council meetings.

4. Key Qualifications:
i. Masters in Economics/Business Administration/ Natural Sciences/Environment/Engineering Sciences;
ii. A minimum of 7 years working experience with the government.
iii. Candidates having experience in dealing with the donor aided projects will get preference;
iv. A good understanding of project preparation, management, result based monitoring and impact evaluation;
v. Candidates with diverse practical and research experience in the field of climate change will have an added advantage;
vi. Excellent interpersonal problem-solving, diplomatic and team skills and proven ability to work across boundaries and interest groups;
vii. Strong written and spoken English and Bangla language communication skills.

5. The Consultant shall perform the services for 24 months commencing from September 2012 or any other period subsequently agreed upon by the parties in writing.
6. The Consultant will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out by the World Bank's Guidelines, "Selection and Employment of Consultants under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits and Grants by World Bank Borrowers dated January 2011".
