Police sue 1000 in Sylhet

Over a thousand people were sued yesterday on charge of assaulting police in the city. Sanjib Das, sub-inspector of Jalalabad police station, filed the case accusing 1000 to 1200 unidentified people, said Gousul Hossain, officer incharge of the PS. On Saturday, the students of Shah Khurram Degree College and transport workers locked in a clash over tempo fares in Temukhi area. At one stage, five policemen came under attack when they rushed there to bring the situation under control on receiving information, said the OC.

2 hurt as bomb goes off

Two people were injured as bomb went off in Kharki area of the district town yesterday morning. Police also arrested one Jahangir Alam, 22, of Shastitola, who escaped unhurt. Prodip Ghosh, 25, of Shastitola, and Robiul Islam, 18, of Kharki area in the town, were admitted to Jessore Medical College and Hospital. Officer in-charge of Kotwali police station Golam Rahman said the accident happened at an abandoned house in the area while the trio were making bombs.

Outlaw held in Pabna

Police arrested an outlaw of a faction of Purba Banglar Communist Party (PBCP) and a fake Rab member in Ataikula bus stand and Bonogram Bazar areas of the district on Sunday night. They also recovered a bomb from the possession of the outlaw. The arrestees are outlaw Aslam Hossain, 22, son of Kalu Hossain of village Boroibari in Santhia upazila and Monju Hossain, 35, son of Munnat Hossain of Rasulpur village in the upazila.

Dowry-hungry man jailed

A Jessore court on Sunday sentenced a man to three years rigorous imprisonment for demanding dowry from his wife. The convict is Jasim Uddin, son of Habibur Rahman of Chengutia village in Abhaynagar upazila. According to the prosecution, Jasim married Majeda Khatun, daughter of Akhil Uddin of Kachua village in Sadar upazila, on December 20, 2009. He took cash Tk 2 lakh, gold ornaments and furniture from Majeda's father as dowry at the time of marriage. Later, he demanded Tk 2 lakh more from the parents of his wife in the name to going abroad. As Majeda refused to bring the money, she was tortured mercilessly and driven out of her husband's house on March 17, 2011. Later, the victim filed a case against Jasim on March 20. After examining the records and witnesses Chief Judicial Magistrate Sheikh Mafizur Rahman handed down the verdict.

Rock lifters block highway protesting use of dredger

Several hundred manua rock lifters barricaded different points of Panchagarh-Tentulia highway under Sadar and Tentulia upazilas yesterday protesting extraction of rock by dredgers.

Vehicular movement on the road remained suspended for about four hours from 10:00am due to the agitation.

Over a hundred vehicles, including long distance passenger buses and goodsladen trucks remained stranded, much to the sufferings of traders and commuters.

Import and export activities at Banglabandha land port was also disrupted due to the protest programme.

Police and local sources

said, the rock lifters put up road barricades in Bhajanpur, Buraburi Bazar areas under Tentulia upazila and Dashmile under Sadar upazila with the help of electric poles, vechiles and tree trunks, demanding steps to stop

use of dredger machines.

The leaders of the workers alleged that a vested quarter was lifting rocks with dredger machines illegally, 'managing' the ruling party leaders and officials of civil and police administration and ignoring the threat of ecological disaster.

Contacted, general rock lifters' leader Muktarul Haque, chairman of Tentulia upazila, told this

correspondent over cell phone that the use of dredgers would leave hundreds of people of the area unemployed.

A decision to stop use of

dredger machine was taken at a meeting at Panchagarh deputy commissioner's office on June 30 but to no effect yet, he said. The manual rock lifters

withdrew the barricade at about 2:00pm following an assurance by DC Md Toffazzol Hossain Mian of taking steps to stop rock lifting by dredgers.

The transport leaders also withdrew their road barricade at the request of the DC.

Earlier on July 16, the manual rock lifters observed a similar day-long road barricade programme to realise their demands.

Villagers attack school to protest 'rape' by teacher

Villagers vandalised Naogaon Government Primary School in Birganj upazila of the district yesterday protesting alleged rape of a class five student by a teacher of the school.

The protesters damaged chairs, tables and benches of the classrooms and assaulted five teachers who tried to pacify them.

Locals said an assistant teacher asked the girl to stay at her classroom after school hours and later raped her.

The girl told her parents and some classmates about the incident. As the news spread at Naogaon village yesterday morning, around 200 people gathered on the premises of the school at around 10:00pm and started vandalising the institution.

Education officer Tajul Islam told this correspondent that they would soon launch a departmental investigation into the incident and then take action against the person involved.

our Lalmonirhat correspondent adds: Patgram upazila officer of Bangladesh Rural Development Board (BRDB), arrested on Sunday for his alleged bid to rape a college girl, was sent to jail yesterday.

Police produced the arrestee in the Court of Judicial Magistrate Saiful Islam who sent him to jail, rejecting his bail prayer.

Police said the BRDB officer tried to violate a first year student of Patgram Government College when she went to his office to see the list of ultra-poor people of her village Sunday noon.

Two teenage girls 'missing' from Jessore, Barguna

Two teenage girls who went missing in Jessore and Barguna districts have remained untraced.

A college girl in Sharsha upazila of Jessore district remained missing for 10 days, reports our Benapole correspondent.

The victim, aged 17, is an HSC first year student at Navaron Fajilatunnesa Women's College of Kagojpukur village in Benapole.

Victim's uncle Md Ishaque said that the girl went out of her house on July 20 morning to buy books for new class but did not return and remained missing.

Family members alleged that police did not take any step to rescue the girl despite filing a general diary the next day.

Contacted, officer incharge of Benapole Port police station Hasan Hafizur Rahman said they were trying to rescue the missing girl.

Away in Barguna, a schoolgirl of Chootobogi village under Taltali upazila remained missing for two and half months. Police failed to arrest anybody in this regard or rescue the victim, reports our Patuakhali correspondent.

The girl appeared in the SSC examination this year from Bogirhat High School under the upazila.

Father of the 16-year-old victim alleged that a local gang led by Al-Amin, 25, kidnapped the girl at about 4pm on May 8 from in front ofherhouse. Al-Amin used to disturb

my daughter on her way to school, he said.

"Just after the incident I

went to Taltali police station to file a case in this regard. But Md. Hanif, the on-duty officer at the police station refused to accept the case," he further said.

However, police later took the case (No. 141/12) following the order by superintendent of police of Barguna district on May 12. The victim's father fur-

ther said that he filed another case (No. 193/12) with the Women and Children Repression Prevention tribunal.

"But police are yet to arrest anybody or rescue my daughter though the accused are moving freely in the area," he said.

When contacted, SI Saidul Islam, IO (Investigation Officer) of the case, said they tried their best to rescue the victim and arrest the accused but failed as the culprits left the area.

Under trial prisoner dies
