 Science Laboratory involved the most elaborate attempt yet to drop a robotic car on the surface of the Red Planet, and required a heat shield, supersonic parachute and rocket-powered sky crane.

The process, known as entry, descent and landing, or EDL, was referred to as "Seven Minutes of Terror" by Nasa, but went off without a hitch, in what US President Barack Obama called an "unprecedented feat of technology."

On approach, a heat shield protected the Curiosity rover's fiery entry into Mars' atmosphere, a supersonic parachute deployed to slow it down, and the spacecraft back shell separated.

Then, a rocket powered backpack was fired to power the one-ton rover downward before it was slowed by nylon tethers. The sky crane was designed to detach and fly away to crash somewhere in the north.

The latest black and white picture released Tuesday was taken by the Mars Reconnaissance Orbiter as it flew about 300 kilometres above the landing site of Gale Crater, near Mars' equator.

It shows the Mars Science Laboratory rover, nicknamed Curiosity, with the now defunct sky crane about 650 meters away to the northwest.

The parachute and backshell of the spacecraft that separated before it lowered down landed about 615 meters away from the rover to the southwest.

The heat shield appears to be about 1,200 meters from the rover to the southwest.

"This is like a crime scene photo here," said Sarah Milkovich, a Nasa

scientist who is the lead investigator of the HiRISE camera on the Mars orbiter.

"Hopefully in our future images we be able to get even better, more detail," she said, adding that the dark areas in the photo show where dust was kicked up during the landing.

The EDL team has reviewed the latest photos and said "the layout looks kind of the way they expected," according to mission manager Mike Watkins.

The pieces will likely stay on Mars. There are no plans to recover them to bring back to Earth.

Nasa is continuing to run tests on the various instruments on board the rover, which aim to help hunt for signs that life may once have existed on Earth's neighbour planet, once believed to be a wetter place than it is today.

So far most of the checks have gone well and the rover appears to be in good shape.

Yesterday, Nasa plans to lift the rover's remote sensing mast for the first time. More images, including colour high-resolution shots, are expected to arrive in the coming days.

But the rover is not expected to start moving for several more weeks, and it may be a year before it reaches its scientific target of Mount Sharp.

Deputy project scientist Joy Crisp said the latest analysis shows that the rover is 6.5 kilometres from the base of the mountain, if it were to travel straight there.

However, scientists have warned it is difficult to estimate the exact start of the base and they have no plans to drive to it directly, but will likely take a more meandering route.

They decided to make their proposal on the basis of the 13th amendment, which the parliament scrapped last year.

The 13th Amendment Act, 1996, provided for a non-party caretaker government which, like an interim government, would give all possible aid and assistance to the Election Commission for holding general elections to the Jatiya Sangsad peacefully, fairly and impartially.

But the caretaker government system was abolished by the fifteenth amendment, which was passed in parliament on June 30 last year.

The BNP, however, declared that it would not participate in any election if a non-party neutral government system was not restored.

Following the year-long debate and controversy over an election-time government, Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina

recently proposed a small cabinet that would include members from the opposition to oversee the next parliament election. Predictably, the proposal was rejected by her archrival Khaleda Zia.

Against this backdrop, the BNP national standing committee, the highest policymaking forum of the party, recently held an academic discussion on the caretaker government system.

A Dhaka university law professor briefed them in detail about the 13th and 15th amendments, existing provisions and the prime minister's proposal.

After the briefing, party policymakers held a brief discussion and dismissed the premier's proposal for a small cabinet.

They preferred a restoration of the 13th amendment but decided to hold further discussions on the issue before finalising the proposal.

However, they agreed to change the provision relating to the appointment of the chief adviser of the caretaker government.

"We may keep the provision for selecting the chief adviser from among all former chief justices instead of the immediate past chief justice so that the political parties can pick one of them through discussion," said a member of the party standing committee.

Khandaker Mosharraf Hossain, a senior member of the standing committee, told The Daily Star the caretaker government system must be restored. Otherwise "no election will be allowed to be held under any party government".

"We can sit for a dialogue on the selection of the head of the caretaker government if the ruling party agrees in principle to restore the caretaker system," he said in reply to a query.

# Allow NGOs to help

 Action Contre La Faim and Muslim Aid UK -- were ordered by the government to stop activities in and around unofficial camps near Cox's Bazar.

The government order banning NGO activities came when hundreds of Rohingya were trying to enter Bangladesh following sectarian violence in Myanmar's Rakhaine state that left around 80 dead in June and July.

"If the order is implemented, it will have a serious humanitarian impact on some 40,000 unregistered people who had fled Myanmar in recent years and settled in the Leda [of Teknaf] and Kutupalong [of Ukhiya] makeshift sites," UNHCR spokesman Adrian Edwards

told reporters in Geneva.

"Local villagers nearby will also be affected as they, too, have been benefiting from basic services provided by the NGOs," he added.

UNHCR also urged the government to reconsider its decision in the light of its long tradition of hospitality towards people who have fled Myanmar over the years.

In addition to the unregistered population, there are some 30,000 registered people living in two official camps in Cox's Bazar.

Meanwhile, UNHCR is keeping an eye on the northern Rakhaine state, following reports of renewed violence there.

The UN refugee agency has received unverified accounts of some villages being burnt in the Kyauk Tau

township north of the state capital, Sittwe. Many of the young men there have reportedly fled, leaving women and children behind.

The United Nations and its humanitarian partners have drawn up a response plan to assist some 80,000 people who have been displaced or are otherwise affected in Rakhaine state since inter-communal clashes broke out in early June.

UNHCR has so far distributed emergency aid -- plastic sheets, blankets, sleeping mats, mosquito nets and kitchen utensils -- to more than 40,000 people.

It is also mobilising its relief stocks in Cox's Bazar for delivery by boat across the Naf river to Rakhaine state once it obtains permission.

# No highway in bad shape

 condition have been made fit for traffic," the minister told journalists emerging from a meeting with railway officials at Railway Bhaban in the capital.

Quader, also in-charge of the railway ministry, however, admitted that some of the district-level roads were in bad shape and needed to be repaired.

The minister also asked media to verify the reports on the status of roads and highways coming from outside Dhaka before publishing those.

The minister's remarks came when both print and electronic media reports suggest that many highways and roads across the country are in a battered condition, and therefore, would cause sufferings to the home-bound people during Eid.

The issue of depleted

roads and highways drew much attention ahead of Eid last year when the former communications minister had to undergo severe criticisms from different quarters.

"I welcome criticisms; but do not scare people saying that the highways are in dilapidated condition," Quader urged newsmen, adding, "If there is panic, passengers will rush for trains putting huge pressure on the rail."

On railway's preparations, he said a total of seven pairs of special trains would start operating three days before the Eid to carry the extra passengers. After Eid, the special trains would continue for another seven days with a two-day break.

Abu Taher, director general of the railway, added that the special trains would operate on the Dhaka-

Khulna, Dhaka-Dewanganj, Dhaka-Parbartipur, Chittagong-Noakhali, Chittagong-Chandpur and Mymensingh-Kishoreganj routes.

Apart from this, Taher said a special train would carry the Muslim devotees heading for Sholakia in Kishoreganj from Dhaka on the Eid day. The country's largest Eid congregation has been taking place in Sholakia for years.

The minister directed the rail authorities to prevent passengers from travelling on the roof of trains, to look after women and children while getting in and out of the trains, and to prevent any sort of subversive activities during the Eid.

Quader also asked officials to keep ready relief trains so that any situation could be handled promptly in case of accidents.

The date of his funeral is yet to be decided as the Royal Family members will finalise the date, said sources in the family. As per Buddhist ritual, funeral takes place seven days after the death.

Aungshoi Prue was the fifteenth King in the Bomang Circle. The Royal family and people in hills have been reeling with profound shock at the death of their oldest Raja.

The next chief of Bomang Circle has not been declared yet. The Raja is usually nominated from the Royal Family

on the basis of seniority.

During the regime of Ziaur Rahman, Aungshoi Prue had served as a state minister for food.

Many people from all walks of life thronged the Bomang palace after hearing of his death to take a glance of the deceased.

Bir Bahadur Ushoi Singh, chairman of CHT Development Board; M Shamsul Huda, brigade commander of Bandarban; Kaya Shoi Hla, chairman of Bandarban Hill District Council; KM Tariqul Islam, deputy commissioner of Bandarban; Kamrul Ahsan, superintendent of police, and M Zayed Reza, the municipality mayor, visited the Royal Palace and

expressed sympathy with the bereaved family members.

A large number of civil society representatives and political leaders also visited the palace to convey their condolences at the death of the Bomang Raja.

Meanwhile, the chairmen of three hill district councils (HCDs), political party leaders and individuals sent condolence messages at the death of Bomang Raja.

Parbattya Chattagram Jana Sanghati Samity (PCJSS) in a condolence message expressed deep shock at the demise of the oldest king and said Aungshoi Prue had been a very revered traditional leader.
