



## PM for global actions to end poverty

UNB, London

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday called for concerted efforts of the international community to fight against poverty and hunger as the two issues had global origins and implications.

"The whole world needs to mobilise its resources, share experiences, research findings and technology, and fully commit themselves to implementing global and national plans and strategies on these issues," she told the inaugural session of Global Nutrition Event at 10 Downing Street.

Joint Chair of the event British Prime Minister David Cameroon and Vice-President of Brazil Michel Temer also spoke at the session.

Hasina mentioned that there was a need for global consensus to effectively respond to over-speculative transactions and commercialisation of commodity markets. "Likewise, external banking, currency and financial transactions also have tremendous impacts."

She said, "The farmers and consumers both suffer from price volatility. This must be addressed if we're to achieve progress on hunger and under-nutrition."

# 329 more BGB jawans jailed

A special court of Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) yesterday sentenced 329 jawans of the directorates of Pilkhana and Rifles Sports Board (RSB) to various terms of imprisonment, ranging from four months to seven years, in a mutiny case.

The jail term will be effective from today and the convicts will serve their sentences in non-military prisons.

The three-member Special Court-11 led by Brig Gen Md Nasir Uddin Ahmad also fined each convict Tk 100. It also acquitted seven of the accused as the allegations against them were not proven. Three of

them had pleaded guilty before the court.

officers, were brutally murdered during the February 25-26 mutiny in 2009 at Pilkhana, the then Bangladesh Rifles (now BGB) headquarters.

The court set up at Darbar Hall of the BGB headquarters in Pilkhana, started at 10:00am and ran for nearly four hours.

A total of 14 charges were brought against the jawans. Those include leaving the Darbar Hall defying the orders of the then director general Maj Gen Shakil Ahmed, collecting firearms and ammunition from the armouries, participating in SEE PAGE 19 COL 7


### SAFARI PARK PROJECT Forest boss removed


