- IMED now invites eligible applicants (Consultant firms) to indicate their interest in providing the services mentioned above. Interested firms are requested to provide necessary information in their Expressions of Interest (EOI) indicating that they are capable enough to conduct impact evaluation studies of the aforesaid project; Consulting firms are required to provide description of similar assignment done (Impact Evaluation/Any type of evaluation /study conducted but not feasibility or any type of survey). Experience in similar operating condition, adequacy of professionals & office staffs, logistics support, information on up-to-date income tax clearance, trade license, etc.
