Though the girl was a legitimate child of the couple Aloy and Tareque who was also captured by Pakistani Army during the war, the society stigmatised Aloy's new born baby. A mentally tormented Aloy finds herself in a lunatic asylum where she lives for 22 years. Suspense starts again later when Mili falls in love with a boy.

The cast also includes Nipun, Nirob and others. Khandakar Nurul Alam and Satya Shaha are the music directors while Hasan Ahmed is the cinematographer. Atiqur Rahman Mallick has edited the film. Azad has directed dance; Kalantar and Shahjahan Chowdhury have directed art.

Single episode TV play "Saheb Holo Nurul"
