A schoolboy was killed as a goalpost collapsed and one of its bars fell on him at a playground in Dighinala upazila on Wednesday evening.

The victim, Mohammad Fazlul Karim Rubel, 15, son of Mohammad Abul Bashar of Purbathana area, was a class seven student at Anath Ashram Residential High School.

Police said the bar of the dilapidated goalpost fell on Rubel, leaving him critically injured.

He was rushed to Khagrachhari Adhunik Sadar Hospital where the doctors declared him dead, said Mohammad Israfil Majumder, officer in-charge at Dighinala police station.

The incident occurred at around 6:00pm when the victim was removing net from the goalpost following the final football match of national inter school-madrasa sports competition.

Locals blamed sports management committee for the incident as the committee held the match without repairing the bar.

Later, the law enforcers arrested five students following a case filed by the university authorities, said the agitators a protest programme.

The authorities then expelled the arrestees which turned the situation more violent. Finally, the university was closed on August 4.

"We will return to classes on Sunday as vice chancellor Mozaffar Hossain assured us of withdrawing the case and expulsion order next week", said Baki Billah, convener of the student agitation committee.

Quoting the VC, Baki said that the other demands would be fulfilled gradually.

70 pc of rly west zone land illegally occupied: Quader

Communications Minister Obaidul Quader yesterday said at least 70 percent of the total 950 acres of railway land in west zone is still under illegal occupation.

The minister said this while visiting Lalmonirhat Railway Station yesterday.

Some unscrupulous railway men are also involved in grabbing of the land and steeling railway sleepers, said Quader, also in charge of the railway ministry. He asked the officials concerned to recover the land within a month and take action against the railway men involved in stealing sleepers.

"We could build at least three to four bridges over the Padma with the value of the grabbed railway land," the minister said, adding that action will be taken against the railway officials if they fail to recover the grabbed land within the deadline.

He asked the railway high officials to take necessary steps to reopen Lalmonirhat-Mogholhat rail route. The minister transferred four railway officials from Lalmonirhat for their alleged negligence of duties and issued show cause notices to them.

The officials are Railway Divisional Engineer Asadul Haque, Divisional Estate Officer Abu Sayeed, Divisional Electrical Engineer Kholilur Rahman and Ticket Booking Master Abdul Motin.

Earlier on the day, the minister visited Teesta road bridge site in Sadar upazila. Taking to the journalists, he said Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina will open the muchawaited road bridge over the Teesta River on September 20.

Roads and Highways Department implemented the project spending Tk 122 crore. Of the amount, the government provided 85 percent while the rest came from the government of Kuwait.

With its opening, the bridge will establish road links with Rangpur, Lalmonirhat and Kurigram districts and bring dynamism in the economic activities of the northern region.



The much-awaited bridge over Teesta River is likely to be opened by Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina on September 20.

Four injured as rivals clash over control of railway land

At least four people were injured in a clash between two groups over taking control of railway land near Mogholhat rail gate in the district town yesterday.

The railway authorities demolished 15 illegal structures on their land in the area on Wednesday evening.

After departure of Communications Minister Obaidul Quader, also in charge of the railways ministry, from Lalmonirhat yesterday noon, the two groups gathered in the rail gate area to erect new structures on the land.

Later, they locked in a clash over capture of the land, leaving at least four people from both sides injured. Being informed, police rushed to the spot and dispersed the clashing groups.

One of the injured named Ripon Islam, 32, was admitted to Rangpur Medical College Hospital in a critical condition while the rest given first aid at a local clinic.

Officer-in-Charge Sirajul Islam of Lalmonirhat Railway Police Station said police have been deployed in the area to thwart any bid to grab the railway land.
