Lightning kills 3

Three people were killed and another was injured by lightning in Provatkbaripara area of Dighinala upazila on Friday night. The deceased were identified as Kala Mia Chakma, 30, Shontu Bikash Chakma, 35 and Gita Rani Chakma, 40, of the area. Meanwhile, the injured, Prokash Jyoti Chakma, was admitted to Khagrachhari Adhunik Sadar Hospital. Mohammad Israfil Majumder, officer in-charge at Dighinala police station, said the victims were struck by lightning at around 7:30pm when they were gossiping in the area. They were rushed to the upazila health complex where the doctors declared the trio dead, said the OC.

College girl found dead

Police recovered the body of a college girl at her residence in east Katpatti area of Jhalakathi district town yesterday. The victim, Ishita Akter, 17, daughter of Rafiqul Islam of the area, was a second year student at Jhalakathi Govt. Women's College. Family members said they found Ishita's body hanging from the ceiling fan of her room in the morning and informed police.

17 injured in wall collapse

At least 17 students and teachers were injured as a wall of Kadambari Union College in Rajoir upazila collapsed on them during a storm yesterday afternoon. Of the injured, 14 were identified as students and the rest teachers. College sources said the storm lashed the area at about 2:00pm when the first year examination was in progress. Suddenly, the side wall of the institution fell on the victims, leaving them seriously injured. They were rushed to Gopalganj Sadar Hospital.

Man held for killing woman

Police yesterday arrested a youth in connection with killing of a woman by some criminals during their attempt to abduct her daughter in Komolnagar upazila Friday. Acting on secret information, police arrested Mansur, son of Shah Alam, from Motirhat area of the upazila at about 7 am. Shahinur Akhter, 45, was stabbed to death and her husband injured in an attack by some criminals when they resisted a bid to abduct their daughter Munni Akhter at Char Kalkini village in the upazila early Friday.

Teachers lock classrooms, take out processions

Week-long strike to realise 17-pt demand, including nationalisation of job

Teachers and employees of non-government high school in Barisal division yesterday started a week long strike to press home their 17-point demand including nationalisation of job.

Their other demands include implementation of time-scale and enhancement of medical allowance and house rent.

Barisal divisional units of Bangladesh Shikshak Samity and Shikshak

Karmachari Oikya Parishad Barisal jointly gave the strike call.

In the city, teachers of different non-government high schools locked the school gates and classrooms in the morning. They later took out a procession in the city held a rally in front of the Shiksha Bhaban.

Chaired by Abdul Malek, district unit president of Bangladesh Shikshak Samity, the rally was addressed by Faridul Alam Jahangir, secretary of the unit, Tofael Ahmad, vice-

president, Halim Mia, joint secretary, HM Jasimuddin, Barisal city unit president of Shikshak Samity, and AB Tofazzal Hossain, organising secretary of the unit.

The speakers demanded that the government nationalise their job without further delay. Otherwise, they threatened to go for an indefinite strike.

They also urged the government to end discrimination in education sector and keep all educational institutions free from political influence.

Four kids drown

Four children drowned in Pabna and Khulna districts yesterday and the day before

Two kids drowned in ponds in Bera and Sujanagar upazilas of Pabna, reports our correspondent.

The victims are Shahin Hossain, 8, son of Azahar Uddin of village Bhadrurav in Sujanagar upazila and Laun Hossain, 6, son of Rezaul Karim of village Brishalikka in Bera upzila.

Locals said Shahin went to take bath at a pond of the village yesterday morning. But he drowned as he did not know how to swim.

Laun also drowned in a pond in the same way on Friday morning.

In Khulna, two children drowned in a pond at Talegati village in Dumuria upazila on Friday evening, reports UNB.

Touhidul Gazi, 7, son of Motin Gazi and his cousin Iktaer Gazi, 6, son of Abul Gazi drowned near their house while trying to pick a balloon from the pond at about 6pm.

Gamblers stab 4 teenage boys

Two arrested in Pabna

Gamblers stabbed four teenage boys at Sadhupara village in Sadar upazila on Friday evening.

Police arrested one Md Parvez Hossain, 25, and Shahidul Islam Shahid, 45, of the village in this connection.

The injured were identified as Nasir Hossain, 15, son of Farid Hossain, Joyal Uddin, 14, son of Jalal Uddin, Mehedi Hossain, 14, son of Kawsar Hossain, and Aunur, 14, son of Eunos Ali of Mondolparavillage.

Md Afzal Hossain, officer in-charge at Sadar police station, said the boys were playing cricket at the village in the afternoon.

When the game was on, a ball sailed over the field and hit one of the members of the gang who were gambling in a nearby compound.

When the boys went there to bring the ball, the gamblers hurled abuses at them

and locked in an altercation.

At a stage, the gang attacked the four with sharp weapons, leaving them critically injured.

They were rushed to the hospitals, said the OC. Away in Narail, a four-year-old boy was killed allegedly by his 'drug addict' father at Kumri village in Lohagara upazila early Friday over a family feud.

The deceased was identified as Siam Sheikh, son of Mukul Sheikh of the village, reports our correspondent.

Akram Hossain, officer in-charge at Lohagara police station, said Mukul returned home drunken at midnight and locked in an altercation with his wife.

At one stage, he threw Siam to the ground from the bed, leaving him dead on the spot.

On information, police recovered the body and sent it to Narail Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy.

They also arrested Mukul, said the OC.

Record revenue collection by Mongla customs house

UNB, Khulna

Mongla Customs House has collected a record amount of revenue in the last financial year.

The customs realised Tk 1,198 crore in revenue against the target of Tk 850 crore in 2011-2012 fiscal year, Tk 348 crore higher than the target and Tk 391 crore more than that of the last financial year.

A total of Tk 807 crore were realised in fiscal 2010-11.

Mongla Port realised Tk 798 crore from import of vehicles, Tk 16 crore from machinery, Tk 87 crore from clinkers and Tk 297 crore from import of other goods.

The record amount of revenue collection from the port has been possible due to quick service delivery, increasing service standard, strengthening the skills of the customs officials and employees, effective measures to check tax evasion, auto-

mation, and zero tolerance to irregularities, said Customs Commissioner SM Humayn Kabir.

Sources said the arrival of foreign ships at Mongla Port started declining in the early 90s due to frequent labour unrest, politicisation, bureaucratic tangles, and irregularities of a section of politicians and businessmen.

The image of the port was damaged badly while the state coffers remained deprived of huge revenue.

However, positive efforts during the present government, mobilisation of local businessmen, politicians and civil society members have encouraged importers to trade through this port, said the Customs Commissioner.

He said the import cost decreased to a great extent due to quick delivery of goods after completing necessary official formalities within short time.

Encashment of bank guarantees after settlement of cases pending with the Supreme Court has also helped boost the revenue income.

Observers said many more ships will arrive in the port on export-import purposes if adequate ferries are ensured at Mawa.

General secretary of Greater Khulna Development Coordination Committee Ashraf Uz Zaman said there is no alternative to starting capital dredging of Mongla Port to keep the economic wheel of Khulna region moving.
