Bombs found in graveyard

Members of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) recovered 10 bombs from a graveyard at Bujruk Gorgori village in Sadar upazila of Chuadanga district on Saturday. Assistant police superintendent Tanvir Ahmed of Rab-6 said on secret information, a team raided the area at about 10:30pm and recovered the bombs, wrapped in a bag, in an abandoned condition. However, none was arrested. Meanwhile, criminals blasted several bombs in Kushtia and Meherpur on Saturday night. In Meherpur, the gang exploded three bombs at Bamundi village in Gangni upazila at around 11:00pm. Anisur Rahman, sub-inspector of Bamundi police camp, said criminals blasted the bombs in front of Nazril tower at Bamundi Bazar. In Kushtia, unknown gang blasted two bombs in front of Bangabandhu Hall of Islamic University at around 8:30pm.

Students besiege clinic

Students of Dinajpur Polytechnic Institute besieged a clinic in the town following death of a female student of the institute due to alleged wrong treatment at the clinic on Saturday night. The dead, Mukta Rani Roy, 17, daughter of Ulen Chandra Roy of Daulatpur village under Thakurgaon Sadar upazila, was a student of computer science department of the institute. Mukta had been living in a female students' mess in Nimnagar Balubari area in the town. She was admitted to Janata Clinic at Mohajanpara under the municipality with severe headache and abdominal pain at around 7:00pm on Saturday. Mukta's roommates, who took her to the clinic, alleged that her condition deteriorated after a nurse gave her (Mukta) an injection. She died at around 9:00pm, they said, adding that wrong treatment led to her death. Doctors, nurses and other staff of the clinic left the hospital soon after the incident. Hearing the news, several hundred students of Dinajpur Polytechnic institute rushed to Mohajanpara and besieged the clinic. They lifted the siege at midnight at the request of law enforcers. Despite repeated attempts, this correspondent could not contact the doctors of the clinic as their cellphones remained switched off.

BLUDGEONING OF HEADMASTER

Tangail teachers vow to continue agitation till culprits arrested

Teachers of different schools and colleges of Tangail formed a human chain in the district town yesterday demanding immediate arrest of the culprits who bludgeoned the headmaster of Bindubasini Government Girls' High School in the town on Tuesday last.

Several hundred teachers under the banner of Sammito Shikkhak Sangram Parishad (SSSP) joined the programme at Nirala intersection in the morning and vowed to continue agitation until the culprits are arrested.

Sangram parishad convener Mohammad Abdul Karim, also the headmaster of Bindubasini Government Boys' High School in the town, said they got frustrated as police could not arrest any of the attackers even after five days of the incident.

He demanded security of the teachers and students of different educational institutions in the district. A three-member committee formed to probe the incident will submit its report on

September 12. Mohammad Afsar Ali, headmaster of Bindubasini Government Girls' High School, was seriously injured allegedly by Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) activists on Tuesday.

They entered the school at around 6:00pm and created pressure on Afsar Ali for admitting three students to the school. As the headmaster refused to do so, the intruders started beating him with hammers.

With serious injuries in his leg and jaw, and several teeth broken, the headmaster was brought to Tangail

General Hospital on Tuesday evening. He was referred to Dhaka Dental College Hospital the same night.

Moriam Begum, mother of the victim, filed a case with Tangail Model Police Station the following day, accusing Tangail district BCL vice president Mostafizur Rahman Sohel and 6/7 others.

Protesting the brutal attack on Afsar Ali, teachers of the school and other institutions in the area brought out a procession in the town shortly after the incident.

Police swoop on BNP-led 18-party protesters

Police intercepted a procession by BNP led 18-party alliance district unit, charged baton on the participants and took away banners from them yesterday.

The alliance brought out the procession in the district town in the morning as part of their countrywide agitation programme against partisan politics, rising criminalism, corruption and bank scams.

When the protesters reached near Sonali Bank branch at DB Road, a police contingent swooped on them.

After an altercation and scuffle between the cops and agitators, police snatched away the banners and tore them off.

Later they started charging baton on the demonstrators to disperse them, leaving seven activists of both BNP and Jamaat-e-Islami injured.

Police also picked up BNP district president Anisuzzaman Khan Babu and Jamaat-e-Islami district ameer Dr. Abdur Rahim Sarker. However, they were released as the activists put up a barricade on the road.

meeting was held on Gaibandha Shaheed Miner premises.

The speakers at the meeting protested police action on peaceful demonstration.

Away in Gopalganj, at least 15 activists of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal were injured as police charged baton on their procession yesterday, reports our correspondent.

The BNP student front brought out the procession in the morning to congratulate the newly formed JCD central body.

Police also arrested Russell, 22, Rajib, 21, and Raju, 20 from the spot.

District Chhatra Dal President Sheikh Reaz Uddin Lipton said district JCD brought out a procession from Miapara area in the city.

When the activists reached Kalibari intersection, police swooped on the procession, leaving 15 people injured.

Mikail Hossain and Ziad Hossain, municipal joint convener, Sangram, Sadar upazila convener and Aman, convener of city unit of JCD were among the injured.

Zakir Hossain, officer in-charge of Sadar police station, said they arrested three people on charge of bringing out procession with prior permission.

ACTION AGAINST 7 SPARKS PROTEST

Dinajpur textile students go on rampage

Students of Dinajpur Textile Institute yesterday went on a rampage after the authorities did not allow seven of their fellows to fill up their registration forms.

They vandalised the principal's office and a laboratory room during the violent protest.

Of the seven, Shafiqul Hasan, Imtiaz Ahmed, Forhat Monzur and Hamidul Islam are the students of 4th semester while Arifuzzaman, Golam Mostafa and Boni Amin of

6th semester.

The incident took place at around 12:00pm when the seven came to know that they were not eligible to fill the forms for appearing the final and test examinations, said the campus sources.

As the news spread, the angry students locked in an altercation with the teachers over the issue and went on rampage at the institute.

On information, police rushed to the spot and brought the situation under control at about 1:00pm.

According to the authorities, attendance of the seven students at their classes was

less than 80 per cent which barred them from filling the forms.

Meanwhile, the aggrieved students said all the textile institutions across the country allowed their students to appear examinations who had class attendance below 80 per cent.

The agitating students also threatened to go for a tougher programme if the seven were not allowed to fill up the forms within today.

Contacted, principal Md Mohibul Islam said the decision to bar the 7 was taken by the academic council.
