Man gets life for murder

A man was awarded life term imprisonment and fined Tk. 5000, in default to suffer one year more in jail, for killing his wife. According to the prosecution, following a family feud, Abdul Latif, 30, of Khukhsia village under Kazipur upazila beat his wife Sheuly Khatun dead on April 1, 2008. Sukur Mahmood, father of the deceased, filed a murder case and police submitted charge sheet against three accused. Father-in-law of the victim Sanjat Ali and mother-in-law Nur Jahan were acquitted as allegation against them could not be proved.

Shops gutted in Sylhet

Three shops were gutted in a fire that broke out at Burunga Bazar under Osmaninagar police station on Monday night. Witnesses said the fire originated at a grocery shop of Madhu Mia at about 8:30pm and soon engulfed the adjoining two others. On information, a firefighting unit from Tajpur rushed to the spot and doused the flames after an hour of frantic efforts. The reason behind the fire could not be known yet.

Boy drowns in Thakurgaon

A 4-year-old boy drowned in a pond on Monday afternoon at Salondar village under Sadar upazila. The boy was identified as Badal, son of Monsur Ali, of the village. Local people said, the boy was playing on the bank of 'Dehapukur' pond with other children near his house. Somehow he fell into the pond and drowned as he did not know how to swim. Hearing screams of other children, local people searched for the boy in the pond but failed to find him. Later divers from Rangur recovered the body at 7:00am Tuesday after two hours of frantic efforts.

Fake fertiliser factory

A mobile court fined the owners of a fertiliser factory Tk 10,000 for manufacturing and marketing fake fertiliser in Hashimpur area on Monday. Agriculture department sources said, a mobile court, led by Upazila Nirbahi Officer Abu Hena Mostafa Kamal, raided AM Agro Chemical and found that fake fertiliser was being loaded in two nasimons (locally-made vehicles) there. The mobile court fined the management of the factory Tk 10,000 and seized the two fertiliser-loaded vehicles.

Lightning kills man

Lightning killed a man at Singri Beel (water body) at Toakul union in Goainghat upazila on Monday evening. The deceased was identified as Sayeed Mia, 38, of Loshkorkandi village. Locals said, a thunderbolt struck Sayeed when he was catching fish at the water body, leaving him dead on the spot at about 6:30pm.

Rain triggers floods in Gaibandha

Heavy rain for the last 4-5 days, followed by onrush of water from across the border, triggered flash flood in the district, leaving at least 5,000 people of two upazilas marooned.

Low lying areas of Jamuna river basin in Shaghata and Phulchhari upazilas have gone under knee-deep water, said an official of Water Development Board.

The affected areas are Hatbari, Gobindi, Sathalia, Hasilkani, Patilbari, Nalsia, Gobindapur and Haldia in Saghata upazila, Galna, Nilkuthi, Bhajondanga, Baje Phulchhari, Pipulia, Gabgachi, Kholabari, Ziadanga, Khatiyamari, Kalasoner

char, Kaiteer hat, Harichandi, Kabilpur and Rasoolpur in phulchhari upazila.

Crops, including aman paddy and pulse, on 3000 acres of land went under water in Phulchhari.

Sukkur Ali of village Golna in Phulchhari, said the floodwater damaged paddy on his three bighas of land.

Seedlings of aman on my two bighas of land were washed away by the flood, said Amir Hossain of Baushi village in the same upazila.

A number of lanes and by-lanes in the town were inundated by the rain water. The water also entered many houses, causing immense sufferings to the dwellers.

In Lalmonirhat, at least 60,000 people of 70 villages in five upazilas remain

marooned due to flash flood caused by heavy rain for the last one week, reports our correspondent.

Low lying areas of Teesta and Dharla rivers basin in Hatibandha, Aditmari, Kaliganj, Patgram and Sadar upazilas have been affected, said WDB sources.

Aman paddy on vast tracts of land in 14 unions of the upazilas went under water.

The affected unions are Angarpota-Dahagram, Bawra, Kuchlibari of Patgram upazila, Bhotmari, Kakina of Kaliganj upazila, Goddimari, Sindurna, Dawabari, Patikapara, Saniyazan of Hatibandha upazila, Mohishkhocha of Aditmari upazila and Khuniyagachh, Rajpur and Mogolhat of Sadar upazila.

Missing schoolgirls rescued in capital

Two schoolgirls, who went missing from their respective schools in the city on Sunday, were rescued in the capital city on Monday.

They were a Class V student of Osmani Medical School hailing from Jhalopara in Dakkhin Surma and a Class VI student of Osmani Adarsha High School from Bhatalia in Sylhet city. Sub-inspector Khasrul

Alam Badal of Kotwali police station said, acting on secret information, a police team of their police station with the help of Sutrapur police station in capital city Dhaka conducted a drive at a house at Companyganj Lane in the early hour of Monday and rescued the victims.

The two schoolgirls were missing between 1:30pm and 2 pm on Sunday. But how they went missing could not be known immediately.

Jewellers protest robbery

Jewellers in the district town kept their shutters down yesterday, protesting robbery at a shop.

Robbers looted cash and gold ornaments worth Tk one crore from a jewellery shop at Station road early yesterday.

Police picked up four night guards Abdul Goffar, Bakul, Alamgir and Papul in this connection.

Bangladesh Jewellery Malik Samity Gaibandha unit observed a daylong shutdown of all the jewellery shops in the town yesterday, demanding recovery of the missing ornaments and immediate arrest and punishment of the culprits.

At a protest programme, leaders of the samity said a gang of 10/12 came by a pick-up van and tied up night guard Goffar at about 4:00am.

They then entered Hira Jewellers by breaking open the locks of its shutter and took away the gold ornaments at gunpoint, they said.

The jewellery traders felt insecure as the robbery took place in the heart of the town, said Tapan Chandra Karmaker, president of the samity.

Conductor pushes student off bus, sparking protest

Students of Government Bangabandhu University College in the district town yesterday protested harassment of a female student by a transport worker.

They blocked Bangabandhu Road by burning tyres and vandalised at least three vehicles at around 11:00am, demanding immediate arrest and punishment of the stalker.

Victim Chameli Biswash, a

second year student of Botany Department, said she boarded a bus of 'Bhaskar Paribahan' from Patkelbari on her way to college.

The conductor of the bus hurled abuses at her when she gave him half of the fare for student concession.

The conductor then pushed her off the bus when it reached Kuadanga bus stand of the town, said Chameli.

As the news spread, the agitating students blocked the road, halting traffic movement for an hour.

(vii) The Fair Authority will not be responsible for poor turnout of visitors and premature closure of the fair for any reason whatsoever and any plea for refund of rent and taxes will not be entertained;
(viii) Sale or display of non-declared items is prohibited. Breach of these provisions will lead to the forfeiture of the security deposit and make the exhibitor liable for other punitive actions as decided by the Fair Authority.
(ix) In addition to the documents referred to in condition B (i), applicants have to quote total bid amount including 15% VAT and 5% for leasing restaurants and will be required to sell food and drinks as per approved rate determined by the fair authority. In this connection, a written undertaking has to be provided on Tk.150/- Non-Judicial Stamp along with the application form. The applicant must be a professional restaurant owner/food supplier and should have appropriate license for running a restaurant or supply of food.
