Shimul's relative now sues Pabna mayor, 23 others

Pabna municipality Mayor Kamrul Hassan Mintu and 23 other BNP leaders and activists have been sued on charge of attacking the procession of Pabna district unit BNP on Monday when a bloody clash between two rival factions of the party left one killed and 20 others injured.

Faridul Islam Dalu, panel mayor of Pabna municipality, Siddikur Rahman Siddique, secretary of Pabna municipality unit BNP, and 21 other BNP activists -- all followers of Mayor Kamrul, are other accused in the case filed by Pabna district unit BNP member Borzahan Bishwas on Friday, police said.

Complainant Borzahan is also cousin of Shamsur

Rahman Shimul Biswas, personal assistant to BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia.

"The complainant claimed that the accused people attacked a procession of Pabna district unit BNP on September 24, leaving their activists injured. We have recorded the case under the Speedy Trial Act. The accused are absconding. Police are trying to arrest them," said Nure Alam, officer in charge (Investigation) of Pabna police station.

"The case has been filed following instruction from the senior leaders. It has been filed late as our activists were injured in the clash and we were busy for their treatment," said complainant Borzahan Biswas.

Siddikur Rahman Siddique, secretary of Pabna municipality unit BNP, said,

"This is a false and politically motivated case and has been filed to harass us."

BNP activist Milon Hossain was killed and 20 others were injured as the Pabna district unit BNP led by its president KS Mahmud and general secretary Habibur Rahman Tota and its rival faction led by Kamrul Hassan Mintu and Siddikur Rahman Siddique got locked in a clash on Friday.

Earlier police filed two cases against the district unit BNP leaders and activists in connection with the incident while the slain BNP man's family filed a murder case against Shimul Bishwas, Mahmud, Tota and 21 other BNP leaders in the district on Tuesday.

Police earlier arrested Mahmud and Tota in connection with the incident.

Ruling party men occupy Kuakata JP leader's land

Ruling party men, led by Jubo League Kuakata municipality unit chief Sagor Molla, illegally occupied a land owned by local Jatiya Party (JP) leader Anwar Hossain Howlader yesterday.

Anwar, president of JP Kuakata municipality unit, bought over one acre of land at Kuakata in 1970 and since then he has been living in a tin-shed house on the land.

One Nurul Islam filed a case with Kalapara Judge's Court in 2009, claiming the ownership of the land, but the court dismissed the case. Later, Nurul Islam filed an appeal with the district

Judge's Court, which also rejected his claim and issued a decree in this regard.

As Nurul Islam again made an appeal to the court, seeking stay on the decree, the court sent a commission led by an advocate. After examining all documents relating to the land, the commission submitted a report to the court on behalf of Anwar.

On Thursday, Anwar submitted a complaint to the court, saying that Nurul Islam and his men were trying to grab his land. The court then issued a show cause notice to Anwar and asked both parties to maintain status quo.

Anwar alleged that Nurul Islam, ignoring the court order,

sent about 100 people led by Sagor Molla to grab his land at around 7:00am yesterday.

They grabbed the land and erected a tin-shed house there, he said, adding that he immediately went to Kuakata police camp, but they could not prevent the gang.

Later, Anwar informed the superintendent of police (SP) of the matter, the SP sent a special police team to Kuakata. On arrival of the police team, Sagor and his men left the place, leaving two families inside the newly built house on the land.

This correspondent tried several times to contact Sagor for his comments on the matter, but his cellphone (01718-158974) remained off.

Boy gets life for murder

A court here on Thursday sentenced a teenage boy to life term rigorous imprisonment for killing another teenage boy in Chhagalnaiya upazila of the district in 2007.

Convict Tanvir Ahmed Arefin alias Samrat, 18, is son of Nurul Amin Bhuiyan of Gothaia Sonapur village under the same upazila.

According to the case statement, on May 18, 2007, Samrat took his neighbour Robiul Aawal Robi, 14, a class VII student and son of an expatriate, to a lonely place at the village and took away his mobile set sent by his father.

As Robiul tried to resist, Samrat killed him and hid the body under hyacinth in a ditch.

Two days after the killing, his body was recovered by police from the water body.

Victim's mother Ruby Akther later lodged a murder case with Chhagalnaiya police station and police arrested Samrat on May 25 of the same year.

Erosion renders 122 families homeless in Faridpur

Erosion by the Madhumati River has taken an alarming turn, rendering at least 122 families of Gayeshpur village in Madhukhali upazila of Faridpur district homeless in the last four days since Wednesday.

The river has also washed away farmland and homesteads at the village under Kamarkhali Sadar union and around 182 feet areas of Kamarkhali-Gayeshpur-Bakshipur embankment during the period.

River water entered the damaged portion of the embankment, inundating Gayeshpur and two other villages in the union.

Talking to this correspondent on Thursday, Kamarkhali Union Parishad (UP) Chairman Mohammad Lutfor Rahman said, "Erosion by the Madhumati has taken a

serious turn due to downpour in the last two days and onrush of water from the upstream".

Iran Chowdhury, former chairman of the same union said more areas of the dyke are on the verge of collapse as breaches have developed at several points.

"If the embankment further collapses, more villages in Madhukhali upazila will go under water and course of the river may be changed," he added.

He urged the authorities concerned to take immediate steps to stop onslaught by the river and sought relief materials for the affected people.

Around 122 families of Gayeshpur village have lost their homesteads while others shifted their houses and household belongings to new addresses, fearing onslaught by the river.

Local people complained that no officials of

the Water Development Board (WDB) in Faridpur or upazila administration came to the village to see the havoc caused by the Madhumati River.

"We informed the WDB officials and upazila administration about the matter, but nobody came here or took any step to check the erosion, alleged former UP member Golam Sarwar who hails from Gayeshpur village.

Executive engineer of Faridpur WDB Abdul Matin Sarkar could not be contacted despite repeated attempts as his cellphone remained off.

Contacted, over cellphone on Friday, Madhukhali Upazila Parishad Chairman Mozibur Rahman Manju said steps to stop river erosion will be taken as soon as possible. The UZ chairman said he will soon visit the area and provide relief

materials for the affected people.

Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) Mirajul Islam Ukil visited the area on Friday. He told the affected villagers that steps would be taken for their rehabilitation as soon as possible.

He also assured the villagers of taking immediate steps in association with the Water Development Board (WDB) to check river erosion in the area.

Our Lalmonirhat correspondent adds: Erosion by the Dharla River has made at least 60 families shelterless at five villages of Mogholhat and Kulaghat unions in Sadar upazila in the last two days.

The affected villages are Bajaitari, Bumka, Kurul villages under Mogholhat union and Shiberkuti and Char Kulaghat villages under Kulaghat union.

Two Bangladeshis hurt as BSF opens fire

Two Bangladeshi cattle traders were injured as Indian Border Security Force (BSF) opened fire on them near Masudpur frontier in Shibganj upazila on Friday night.

The victims were identified as Mohammad Dulal, 24, son of Shafiqul Islam of Ghughudanga village and Shafiqul Islam, 22, son of Sadek Ali of Shayampur-Sahapara village under the upazila.

BSF men at Daulatpur camp under 20 Battalion in Maldah of Paschimbanga fired on the cattle traders at around 10:45pm when they approached the border to collect cattle, said Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB)

and locals.

Injured Dulal and Shafiqul were admitted to Maldah General Hospital. Major Abu Nayem, Operation Officer of 9 BGB battalion in the district said, Dulal received bullet in his hand and Shafiqul in the leg.

Earlier, BSF personnel shot and injured Mister alias Ahmed, 20, son of Ebadul Tarapur-Sahapara village under Monakasha union of Shibganj upazila on September 10.

The Indian border force also beat-up and injured cattle trader Mohammad Mukul, 27, son of Khalaf Ali of Parchouka village taking him to Daulatpur camp in Maldah, opposite to Chouka frontier in Shibganj upazila on September 25.
