A prosecution witness yesterday told International Crimes Tribunal-1 that before his very eyes the Pakistani army took away Shiru Mia and his son Kamal along with 36 others from Brahmanbaria jail for killing.

Testifying against war crimes accused former Jamaat chief Ghulam Azam,

Ahmed Imtiaz Bulbul said he later heard that all 38 had been killed at Koiratola on that November night, which was the night of Eid-ul-Fitr in 1971.

This incident relates to one of the five charges of crimes against humanity against Ghulam Azam.

# Romney goes on offensive






