Rakhaine people protest attack

About 50 members of local Rakhaine community in Kuakata formed a human chain yesterday, protesting attack by a criminal gang on Sunday. They also demanded immediate arrest and punishment of the culprits. Monju Mon, a Rakhaine youth told this correspondent that on Sunday noon, Anchang, 22, another youth of the community was returning home from the town. A gang of ruling party men, waylaid him and beat him up. Monju said he tried to resist the gang to save Anchang but the gang also assaulted him. Luma Rakhaine, mother of Anchang, filed a complaint with Kuakata PS in this regard but police are yet to take any action against the culprits.

BCL, Shibir clash in Bogra

Activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) and Islami Chhatra Shibir clashed at Bogra Govt Azizul Haq College on Sunday, leaving three Shibir men injured. Police and locals said the trouble broke out when 10-12 BCL boys beat up 5-6 Shibir activists at about 9pm. Later, the BCL men drove out the Shibir men from the college compound after a chase and counter-chase. The injured -- Jahangir Alam, 20, Abu Sufian, 21, and Mahfuz Alam, 20 -- were taken to different private clinics in the town.

Tk 2.14 cr Yaba tablets seized

Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) seized 67,135 pieces of Yaba tablets from Sabrang union in Teknaf upazila early yesterday. Lt. Col. Zahid Hasan, commander of BGB-17, said acting on a secret information, a patrol team of BGB raided the area and seized the tablets worth Tk 2.14 crore at about 5.00 am. None was arrested in this connection as the smugglers fled the scene, sensing the presence of the border guards. A case was filed with Teknaf PS.

Houses of Hindus attacked

Criminals ransacked and set fire to two houses of Hindus in Kharol upazila yesterday afternoon, leaving four people injured. The injured were identified as Ratan Kumar Roy, 30, and Laxmi Kanti Roy, 28, sons of Atul Chandra Roy and their wives Bharoti Rani Roy, 28, and Parul Rani Roy, 25, of village Mutunihai under the upazila. According to the locals, there was a longstanding land dispute between Atul Chandra Roy, a retired village police and Abdul Wahab and Abdul Latif. At about 2.00pm yesterday, around 20 to 25 people, equipped with wooden sticks and sharp weapons, arrived on a three-wheeler and started ransacking Atul's houses. The gang also looted goods around Tk 50,000 and beat up two sons of Atul and two daughters-in-law. Later they set two houses and a shop belonging to Atul on fire and left the area. Sukumar Mohanta, officer in-charge of Kharol PS visited the spot.

'Stalker' headmaster suspended

The headmaster of Habra Girls' High School in Parbatipur upazila of Dinajpur has been suspended on charge of stalking a student of the school.

Following a complaint filed by the father of the victim with upazila nirbahi officer (UNO), school managing committee and upazila education officer on Thursday, the committee held an emergency meeting on the issue on Sunday night.

Chaired by Md Azaharul Islam, president of the school managing committee, the meeting passed a resolution, suspending headmaster Md Mamunur Rashid on charge of stalking a class 1X student of the school.

The committee also suspended assistant headmaster Md Azizul Islam and assistant teachers Sultan Ali and Sagar Ranjan for keeping mum about the incident.

A three-member committee has been formed to

investigate the matter. School Managing Committee President Azaharul Islam said the probe body has been asked to submit its report as early as possible. "We will take the next steps on the basis of the report," he said.

The upazila administration also formed an inquiry committee headed by Upazila Education Officer Md Shamser Ali. Contacted, Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) Md Rehenul Islam said if the allegation against the headmaster is found to be true, stern action will be taken him.

In the complaint, father of the girl stated that headmaster Mamunur Rashid has been stalking his daughter over a period of six months. She has stopped going to the school since September 10 as the headmaster made an indecent proposal to her, he further said.

Headmaster Mamunur Rashid could not be contacted as his cellphone remained off.

21 BNP men among 46 sued in Ruhea union

Twenty-one BNP activists including Ruhea union unit BNP President Md Reazuddin and 25 other unnamed people have been sued on charge of Friday's attack on Water Resources Minister Ramesh Chandra Sen's village home and assault of Ruhea union Awami League (AL) President Ashraful Islam.

Ashraful's elder brother Aszharul Islam filed the case with Thakurgaon police station on Sunday night.

Demonstrators attacked Water Resources Minister Ramesh Chandra Sen's home at Ramnath village on Friday evening, protesting what they said 'unjustified change' of the earlier announced gazette notification to create a new union

comprising part of existing Ruhea union, sources said.

They also beat up Ashraful Islam and two others.

The district administration on May 24 this year issued a gazette notification for making a new union parishad (UP), dividing Ruhea union into two parts, DC office sources said.

After the notification was made public on August 17, the people of eastern portion of Ruhea union expressed their dissatisfaction as important educational institutions including Ruhea Boys' High School, Ruhea Girls' High School and Ruhea Degree College would fall within the jurisdiction of the new UP comprising the western part.

Protesting splitting of the union and demanding 'correction' of the gazette, they observed different programmes including human chain, road blockade, public gathering and hartal since August 20. Minister Ramesh Chandra Sen attended a meeting of the representatives of two sides of Ruhea union on Friday afternoon. There he announced 'necessary correction' of the gazette notification.

As the news spread in the area, the people of western side became agitated. A group of people attacked the minister's home at Ramnath village, threw brickbats there and damaged windows and doors of the house.

The agitators also damaged the house of union AL President Ashraful Islam, beat him and two others.

Oil tanker train derails

An Iwardi bound oil tanker train derailed near Chuadanga Railway Station yesterday morning, disrupting railway communications between Khulna-Dhaka-Rajshahi-Syedpur for four hours.

Seven tankers of the train derailed at about 9:30am but there was no report of oil spilling, railway sources said.

Ainal Hossain, driver of the train said that the train coming from Khulna derailed due to damaged railway line.

Later a rescue train from Iwardi went to the spot at about 11:00 am and rail communications resumed at about 1.45 pm after the tankers were salvaged.

There were around 11,000 liters of octane, 8,800 litres of kerosene and 35,500 litres of diesel in the seven tankers.

4 return home after serving jail in India

Four Bangladeshis, who served three years in jail in India's Assam state, returned home yesterday.

They are Alam Mia, 23, son of Kamrul Hasan, Islam Hossain, 23, son of Rafiqul Islam, Ala Uddin, 40, and Mohammad Ali, 32, sons of Abdur Rashid Biswas of Derua village in Sadar upazila.

According to prosecution, Zannatul Ferdous Seema had an extramarital relation with Lavlu.

Seema and Lavlu brutally killed Shiblu Biswas on January 11, 2010 following a feud with Shiblu over the issue.

Police arrested Seema and Lavlu after Shiblu's elder brother Asaduzzaman Biswas filed a case with Magura Sadar PS the next day.
