

One killed, 7 hurt as robbers throw them off running train

A passenger was killed and seven others were injured as robbers threw them off a running train in Sarishabari upazila town on Wednesday night.

The deceased was identified as Rapoti Pal, 50, son of late Hirambo Pal of Baroipatol village.

Injured Ramprashad Pal, 40, of Baroipatol village, Swapon, 30, of Bhatara in Sarishabari upazila, Suruj Ali, 60, Sharif, 15, of Nalitabari upazila in Sherpur district, Tuhin, 20, of Bogra, Nurul Islam, 16, of Jamalpur, and Sirajul Islam,

48, of Tangail were admitted to a local hospital.

Osman Gani, officer in-charge at Jamalpur Railway police station, said at about 10:30pm, a gang of 7/8 swooped on a coach of the Jamuna Bridge-bound train from Dhaka, attacked the passengers with sharp weapons and looted cash and valuables.

At one stage, four of the passengers were pushed off the running train by the gang near post office intersection in the town while the rest in Tarakandi area. Of the victims, Rapoti died on the spot.

A case was filed in this connection, said the OC.

BCL men vandalise buses 'for nothing'

A group of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) activists vandalised two buses in Panchagarh district town on Wednesday evening.

Protesting the incident, transport workers blocked Panchagarh-Dhaka highway for about two hours.

Local sources said, Md Mizanur Rahman, general secretary of BCL district unit, boarded a bus of Nabil Paribahan coming from Dhaka on Monday night.

During the trip, he locked in an altercation with a passenger over a trivial matter.

When the bus reached Saidpur bus terminal in Nilphamari, a few friends of the passenger attacked Mizanur, leaving him

injured.

As a sequel to the incident, the BCL activists smashed the vehicles of the company in front of Karatoya filling station in the town.

They also forced the staff of Nabil Paribahan to shut their counter and beat up the supervisor.

The workers withdrew the barricade following an assurance by police of taking steps against those responsible for the offence, said officer in-charge of Panchagarh police station Humayun Kabir.

Contacted, Mizanur said that BCL activists were not involved in the vandalism.

A case was filed in this connection.

RAJBARI BNP LEADER BABLU MURDER Absconding accused Mir Alam held in Faridpur

Police arrested one of the accused in Rajbari BNP leader SM Shamsul Alam Bablu murder case from Faridpur district on Wednesday night.

The arrestee was identified as Mir Alam Babu, 35. Mir Alam is younger brother of prime accused Mir Enam Ali Bachchu, the incumbent councilor of Rajbari municipality.

Sahab Uddin Khalifia, officer in-charge (OC) of Rajbari Sadar police station told this correspondent that police raided the house of Mir Alam's father-in-law at Bonsardi village in Nagarkandi upazila of Faridpur at about 3:30am on an information that Mir

Alam was hiding there.

Mir Alam remained absconded since the murder took place on August 24.

Police said, a gang led by the two accused opened fire on Bablu around 1:30am when he was returning to his home in Binodpur area in the town from Rajbari bazar.

Bablu was a former convener of Rajbari district unit of Jubo Dal, the youth front of BNP, and also a member of Rajbari district unit BNP.

Prime accused Enam is also former Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal Rajbari district joint convener and now a member of district BNP.

According to sources, Bablu was a victim of an intra-party feud between Ali Newaz Mohammad Khayiam, former lawmaker of Rajbari-1, also the presi-

dent of Rajbari district unit BNP and Harunur Rashid, general secretary of the unit.

Bablu belonged to Khayiam group and he had a rivalry with a group of JCD and Jubo Dal men of the district led by Mir Enam Ali Bachchu.

Soon after the murder, police arrested one Arif Biswas, a BNP cadre of the district. Twelve people were sued including Bachchu and his brother Mir Alam.

"We have investigated the matter on the basis of information extracted from Arif and the clues to the case are now almost clear," OC Sahab Uddin Khalifia told this correspondent over cell phone yesterday.

Charge sheet in the case will be submitted soon, the OC said.

Young man murdered in Khulna

Criminals murdered a young man was in Batiaghata upazila yesterday morning.

Police recovered the body of Milon Gazi, 22, son of Rafiqul Islam of Mohammadnagar village, from a ditch in Pratyasha area on the outskirts of the city.

Family sources said two youths called Milon out his house at 10:00pm on Wednesday and since remained missing.

Locals found the body of Milon in Pratyasha area yesterday and informed police at about 11:00am.

Officer in-charge of Batiaghata Police Station Helal Uddin said Milon might have been killed by rivals due to previous enmity.

Bogra doctors ease work abstention programme

Bangladesh Medical Association (BMA) Bogra unit yesterday relaxed their four-day long work abstention programme.

The BMA leaders said that the programme will now take place for two hours every day from next Sunday at the outdoors of Shaheed Ziaur Rahman Medical College and Hospital (SZMCH) and Mohammad Ali Hospital until their demand was met.

The BMA announced their four-day work abstention programme at all government and non-government hospitals in the district on Monday last, demanding arrest of the

culprits who assaulted some doctors at SZMCH.

Administrative Officer of SZMCH Abdullahil Baki filed a case accusing ten people after the relatives of a patient, who died at the hospital, manhandled the doctors on Friday.

We have suspended the programme as police arrested three of the accused till Wednesday, said a BMA leader.

Considering the condition of the patients, we have decided to continue our programme for two hours only at two hospitals, he said.

Inspector (Investigation) at Sadar PS Atiar Rahman said that police have arrested three accused while the other seven are on bail.
