Police sources said Osman lodged a general dairy (GD) with Panchlaish Police Station in this regard around 12:30am yesterday.

While talking to The Daily Star Osman told that a man, who mentioned his name Nowshad Mahmud Rana, called him over mobile phone around 10:26pm for three times on Friday. The number, from which the call came, was 01716200240. "When I received the call, Rana rebuked me very much

and threatened to kill both me and ABM Mohiuddin, president of Awami League (AL) of Chittagong Metropolitan unit," said Osman Gani. "Following the incident, I informed my sir of the matter over the phone as he went to Saudi Arabia on October

2 for performing hajj and he instructed me to inform the police of the matter," he added. Manjur Morshed, assistant commissioner of Panchlaish zone in Chittagong Metropolitan Police, said


police are investigating the matter. Despite repeated attempts, the above mentioned

China ready to boost relation

Says top-ranking CPC leader

A top leader of the Communist Party of China (CPC) yesterday said China is ready to enhance cooperation with Bangladesh in the UN, Saarc and Asean regional forums to safeguard peace, stability and prosperity. Li Changchun, fifth top member of CPC's Political

Bureau Standing Committee, said they want to expand cooperation with Bangladesh in culture, education, science, technology, media, and tourism sectors.

Leading an eight-member high-powered CPC delegation at the ruling Awami League's invitation, he said these at a dinner at a Dhaka hotel with leaders of AL, BNP, Jatiya Party and others. Li said they would increase Chinese government scholarships for Bangladeshi students from 160 to 250 and want to set up computer and technology institutions in Bangladeshi universities.

At the dinner, Home Minister MK Alamgir sought Chinese cooperation in building "Digital Bangladesh".

AL Joint General Secretary Mahbubul Alam Hanif said the visit considered a most important one focuses on strengthening China's relations with Bangladesh and AL.

Before leaving for Beijing today, Li will meet the president, prime minister, and opposition leader and sign an economic and technical cooperation agreement and MoU on strengthening cooperation in the power sector.

Speakers at a press conference yesterday demanded that the government stops the project to set up a coalbased thermal power plant at Rampal upazila of Bagerhat, adjacent to the Sundarbans.

They emphasised conducting an international Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) and make public the details of the project to assess its positive and negative aspects.

An agreement was signed on January 29 with India's state-run National Thermal Power Corporation to set up the 1,300-megawatt plant at Rampal, 14 km from the world's largest mangrove forest.

The press conference, "Rampal thermal power plant's possible impacts on the Sundarbans and adjacent areas", was organised by eight NGOs at Jatiya Press Club.

The NGOs are Bangladesh Poribesh Andolon (Bapa), Transparency International Bangladesh (TIB), Bangladesh Environmental Lawyers Association (Bela), Center for Human Rights Movement, Save the Sundarbans Foundation, Krishijami Rakkha Committee, Bagerhat Unnayan Commission, and Green Voice. Bela Chief Executive Advocate Syeda Rizwana Hasan
