Brick field worker strangled

Criminals strangled a brick field worker at Fazilpur village under Kotchandpur upazila on Friday night. The victim was identified as Munsur Ali, 22, son of Hazrat Ali of Mohajanpur village in Satkhira district. He was a day labourer at a brick field owned by one Anil Paul in Kaliganj upazila. Officer-in-Charge (OC) Mizanur Rahman of Kotchandpur Police Station said a gang abducted Munsur Ali from the brick field Thursday morning. Locals found the body near the Chitra River under Kotchandpur Police Station on Friday night and informed the police who recovered the body and sent it to Jhenidah Sadar Hospital for autopsy.

6 held for killing guard

UNB, Munshiganj

Police arrested two managers and four employees of Padma Resort for their alleged involvement in the killing of its security guard Joynal Abedin in Louhajang upazila on Friday night. The arrestees are managers Abu Jafar Sarwar, 37, and M Shahbaj, 50, and employees Mafiz, 27, Mostafa, 27, Russel, 17, and Rafiq, 35. Victim's brother-in-law Azizul Islam said Joynal Abedin, 60, went missing from his work place on October 17. Locals found his body floating on the Padma on Friday evening and informed the police who recovered the body and then arrested the six.

Seven shops gutted

Seven shops were gutted in a fire in Hetalia Badghat area on Patuakhali-Kuakata Road on Friday evening. Locals said the fire originated from a gas cylinder shop at around 4:00pm and soon engulfed the six others. Being informed, fire fighters from Patuakhali district headquarters rushed to the spot and extinguished the blaze at around 5:30pm. The affected shop owners estimated the losses caused by the fire at about Tk 25 lakh.

'Mugger' killed in mob beating

UNB, Rangpur

An alleged mugger was beaten to death and another injured by an angry mob while trying to take away an auto-rickshaw in Amashu Kukrul area of the city early Friday.

The deceased was identified as Bappi, son of Saiful Islam and the injured Abdul Rahim, son of Abdul Gani of Jummapara area of the city.

Police said a gang of muggers tried to snatch an auto-rickshaw in the area late at night.

Hearing screaming of its driver, local people rushed to the spot and chased the muggers. Later, two of the gang were captured by the mob while the rest managed to flee.

The mob beat them mercilessly, leaving them critically injured.

On information police rescued the duo in critical condition and admitted

them to Rangpur Medical College Hospital where Bappi succumbed to his injuries.

In Manikganj, muggers snatched a motorbike stabbing a youth at Arpara in Shibaloya upazila on Friday night.

The victim was identified as Liton Mia, 30, an employee of a private company.

Locals said a gang of six coming in two motorbikes intercepted Liton while he along with his co-rider Abdul Aziz, 50, was returning to his house from Paturia Ghat at about 10:00pm.

The armed muggers snatched Liton's motorbike and stabbed him indiscriminately as he tried to resist them, leaving him seriously injured.

The injured was rushed to Sadar Hospital where his condition was stated to be critical.

Punish killers of domestic help Seema

Demands Khulna HR body

Combine Human Rights Protection Forum of Khulna yesterday demanded exemplary punishment to the killers of a domestic help.

The leaders of the forum will also submit a memorandum to the deputy commissioner in the first week of next month in favour of their demand.

They made the call at a press conference at Khulna Press Club.

Among others, Sheikh Abdul Quayum, convener of the forum, its coordinator Mominul Islam and Sufia Khatun, mother of the deceased, were present.

Seema, 14, of Lohagara upazila in Narail district was working as a domestic help

at the house of Masud Hasan in Muzgunni area under Khalishpur police station of the city from 2008.

On April 4 last year, Masud along with his wife Fatema Yasmin strangled Seema and dumped her body in a canal in Dumuria upazila after she was raped by him, alleged the speakers at the conference.

Following a murder case filed by Seema's mother, police arrested the couple in the city on October 14 this year, said Shah Alam, sub-inspector of the PS and investigation officer (IO) of the case.

Masud, owner of Milky ice-cream factory, is also a charge sheeted accused in the case for killing of his employee Ujjal, said the SI.

Fisherman injured in firing, trawler looted

Robbers looted fishing trawler, injuring a fisherman on Meghna River near Dhalchar under Hatiya upazila yesterday afternoon.

Milon Majhi of village Jahajmara was admitted to the upazila health complex and then shifted to Noakhali Medical College and Hospital as his condition deteriorated.

Moktar Hossain, officer in-

charge at Hatiya police station, said at least nine fishermen including Milon went to the river for fishing from Hatiya ghat around 5:00am.

While returning home after fishing, a gang led by Nijam (head of Nizam Bahini) opened fire on them at around 2pm near Dhalchar and took away the trawler.

The robbers managed to flee the scene sensing that other trawlers were coming to the spot, said the OC.

Mindless construction threatens important installation in Magura

Influential businessman ignores notices

An influential businessman has constructed a tin-shed structure and continued earth filling in the restricted area adjacent to the four-vent Nabaganga regulator, posing threat to the key point installation (KPI) in Dhaka Road bus stand area in Magura town.

The mindless act has continued although the Water Development Board (WDB) served two notices to Rajab Ali Majnu, proprietor of Laboni Steel Corner in Magura town, on October 1 and 2, and filed a criminal case with Magura Sadar police station on October 6.

Manju is known as an adherent of ruing Awami League.

The two notices, one signed by Mohammad Matiuur Rahman, sub-assistant engineer of Magura WDB, and the other by Mohammad Faruk Bhuyan, executive engineer of the office, asked Majnu to demolish his structure and stop the earth filling work.

Copies of notices were also forwarded to the superintendent of police (SP) and the deputy commissioner (DC) of the district.

"Rajab Ali Majnu, proprietor of Laboni Steel Corner in Magura town, has built a large tin-shed room occupying the approach road attached to the wing-wall of the regulator. He is doing earth filling work on the restricted land owned by the WDB to construct a multi-storied building, in violation of the KPI Act that prohibits any installation within 150 metres around it," goes the statement of the case filed by

WDB official Mohammad Matiuur Rahman on October 6.

When asked, Rajab Ali Majnu claimed that he was running his construction work on 19 decimals of land that he purchased from one Firoza Khatun.

"I have all the necessary documents in this regard," he added.

WDB Assistant Director (Land and Revenue) Abdur Rahim, however, rejected Majnu's claim and said, "According to the S/A (state acquisition) records, Firoza Khatun is entitled to sell only six decimals of land on which Saikat Residential Hotel stands. But for his construction, Majnu has illegally occupied more areas of lands owned by WDB."

"It's unfortunate that police has not taken any step against Majnu although he is involved in grabbing the land adjacent to a KPI," Faruk Bhuyan told this correspondent over cell phone.

When contacted, Magura SP Zihadul Kabir asked this correspondent to contact the officer in charge (OC) concerned to know the details of the matter.

"Although I received a petition signed by Matiuur Rahman, sub-assistant engineer of WDB, we are yet to record it as the complainant did not submit supporting papers of the land that WDB officials claimed as belonging to their department," said Munshi Asaduzzaman, OC of

Magura Sadar police station. Plaintiff Matiuur Rahman said, "We filed the case for illegally constructing structure within 150 metres of Nabaganga regulator, in violation of the country's KPI Act. And so, the question of land document is irrelevant here."

Sub-Divisional Engineer of Magura WDB Kanak Kumar Biswas said, "The Nabaganga regulator cum bridge on Magura-Dhaka highway is the gateway to 10 south-western districts from the capital. If any multi-storied building is constructed on the adjoining land, the key point installation as well as the communication system between Dhaka and the 10 districts will be threatened."
