EID CATTLE MARKET Prices high, sales low

Although cattle markets in the capital are already experiencing a glut of sacrificial animals, sales are yet to gain any momentum due to a low turnout of customers. Indeed, such was the picture last evening.

Traders were pinning their hopes on making brisk business today as it is a public holiday.

Customers, however, complained that the traders were demanding higher prices for the cattle than last year.

Traders said they had earned hefty profits last year as there was a huge shortage of sacrificial animals just before eid day. This encouraged them to bring in much more cattle this year.

A trader from Faridpur, Tuku brought 20 cows to the Sadeque Hossain Khoka playground cattle market two days ago.

He said traders from his area had brought in 25 percent more cows this year compared to last year.

The situation was completely different in 2010 when the traders incurred a huge loss, said Minhaz, a trader from Ishwardi of Pabna.

"Last year I brought only six cows, but this time I have brought 19," he added.



A businessman of Chittagong bought the two camels from Gabtoli cattle market in the capital yesterday for Tk 13 lakh. Camels have been featuring in cattle markets of the capital alongside cows, goats and sheep. However, they are pricey and most people cannot afford them.

Hall-Mark workers clash with cops

200 hurt; vehicles smashed, highway barricaded in Savar for eid bonus, arrears

Around 200 people sustained injuries, mostly from rubber bullets, as several thousand garment workers of Hall-Mark Group clashed with law enforcers during their demonstrations for arrears and Eid bonus in Savar in Dhaka yesterday.

The sporadic demonstrations left around 30 vehicles ransacked and a three-hour-long tailback on Dhaka-Aricha Highway causing immense sufferings to the people bound for home to celebrate Eid.

Obama 'wins' final debate

President Barack Obama scolded challenger Mitt Romney for being "all over the map" on foreign policy in their final presidential debate on Monday, but the Republican appeared to have passed the "commander-in-chief" test of looking authoritative on national security issues.

With two weeks left until Election Day, the high-stakes debate strayed frequently into domestic policy, with Romney seeking to bolster his argument that Obama had bungled the US economic recovery.

Running neck and neck in polls, neither man threw a knockout punch or made a noticeable gaffe as they clashed over Israel, Iran, Russia and the size of the US Navy in the encounter at Lynn University in Boca Raton.

Mother, 2 kids murdered in Chittagong

A mother and her two children were hacked to death by unknown criminals at their rented flat in Chittagong city yesterday evening.


The deceased are Doly, 30, wife of expatriate worker Anwar, their son Albhi, 10, and daughter Payel, 6.

All of them hailed from Kagotia village of Raozan upazila in Chittagong.

The murders occurred at a flat on the top floor of a five-storey building in Khotiber Haat area where Doly along with her two children had been residing for the last two months.

Police recovered the bodies of the three after they were informed by neighbours around 7:00 pm.
