Three fishermen kidnapped

UNB, Laxmipur
Robbers kidnapped three fishermen along with a trawler for ransom from Meghna River in Gabtali area of Ramgati upazila on Tuesday afternoon. The victims were identified as Sayez Uddin, Abul Khayer and Sattar Kazi of Saheb Char village in Sadar upazila. Local fish traders said, a gang of armed robbers led by Noman and Wahed Nayan swooped on the trawler and abducted the fishermen in the afternoon while they were catching fish in the river. Later, the bandits took the fishermen along with the trawler to an unknown place.

Murder accused held

UNB, Sylhet
Police on Tuesday arrested an accused in the city in connection with the killing of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) leader Shawkat. The arrestee was identified as Atikur Rahman Chowdhury Lavlu, 26, son of Mujibur Rahman of Gorai village in Kanaighat upazila. He used to reside at No. 27 road of Upashahar. Police raided the area and arrested him from his residence in the early hours.

Smuggled clothes seized

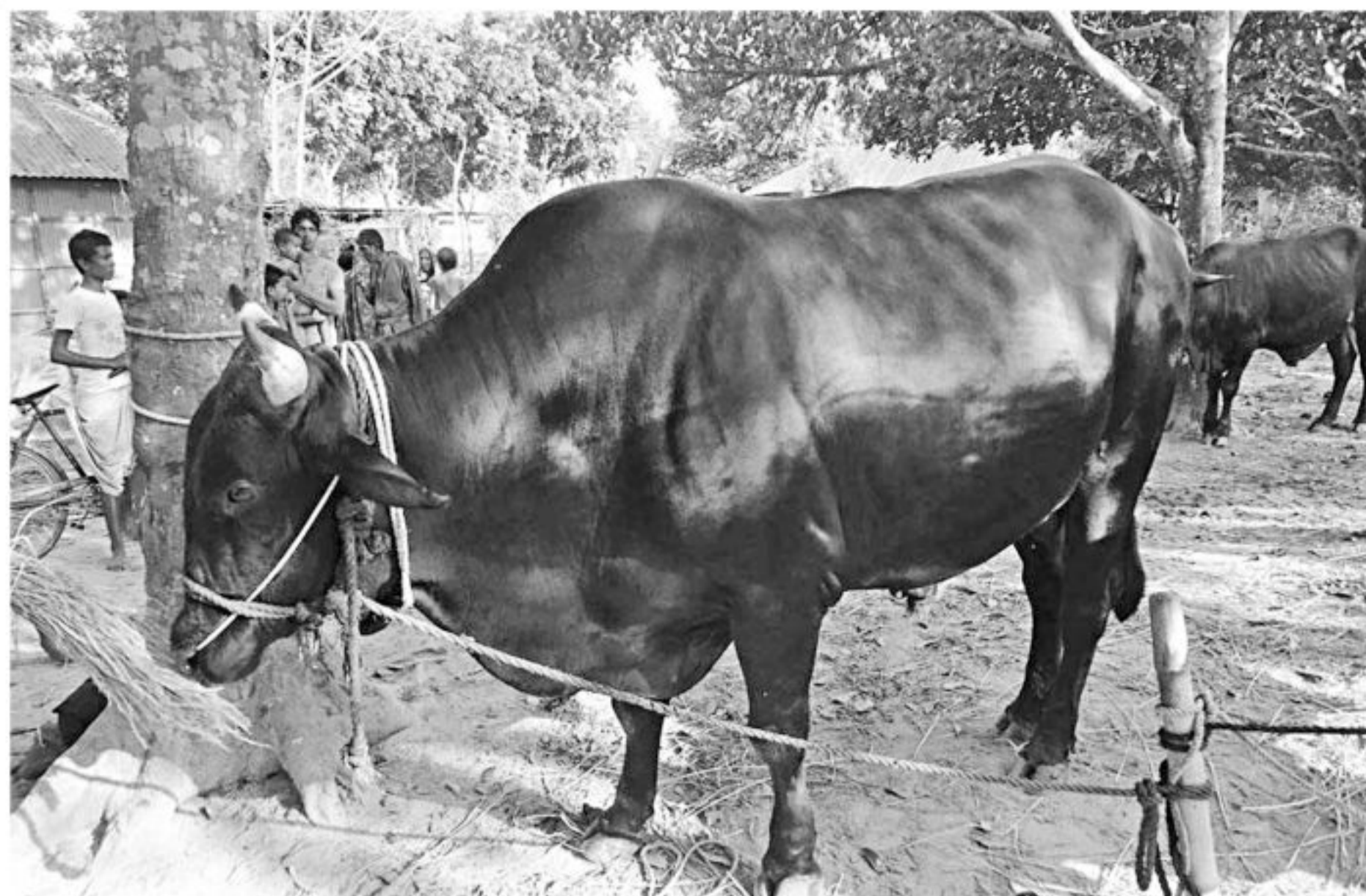
UNB, Benapole, Jessore
Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) members seized a huge quantity of Indian sari, three-piece dress materials and cosmetics worth Tk 2 crore from Gorpara border in Sharsha upazila on Tuesday night. Operation officer of BGB-26 Major Firoz Wahid said, on secret information, a team of BGB conducted a drive in the area and intercepted a truck at night. Later, they recovered the Indian contraband goods from the vehicle. None was arrested in this connection as the driver and smugglers managed to flee the scene.

Training course for journo

A three-day basic training workshop for journalists, organized by Press Institute of Bangladesh (PIB), concluded at local press club on Tuesday. The participants were imparted practical training on different matters such as gathering information for writing news report, reporting process, technique of feature writing, press conference, online journalism and code of conduct of journalism. Dr Dulal Chandra Biswas, director general of PIB, attended the concluding ceremony as chief guest and distributed certificates among the participants.

Injured woman dies

UNB, Sylhet
A woman who was injured in a clash between the residents of two villages in Chhatak upazila of Sunamganj district on Monday died at a hospital in Sylhet city early yesterday. The deceased was identified as Sadeka Begum, 30, wife of Ali Hossain of Shewtarchar village in the upazila. Locals said at least 30 people, including Sadeka, were injured in the clash that broke out between the residents of Shewtarchar and Tetiarchar villages over catching fish on Monday morning. Sadeka succumbed to her injuries yesterday.

4 firearms, bullets recovered in Comilla

Four foreign made pistols, 40 bullets and six magazines were recovered from Rajapur railway station in Burichang upazila early yesterday.

Being tipped-off, a team of BGB, led by Lt Col Aktaruzzaman Bir Pratik, raided the area at about 5:40am and found that a bag was thrown from a Chittagong-bound train 'Turna Nishitha' coming from capital at the outer signal. The train was running slowly before its arrival to the station when someone threw the bag containing the arms.

Seeing this, the BGB team recovered the bag and recovered the arms after searching the bag. Illegal arms traders, who came to receive the bag, fled the scene sensing the presence of the BGB members.

Teacher murdered in Moulvibazar

Manipuri community leader and primary school teacher Rabindra Kumar Sinha, 40, of Komolganj upazila in Moulvibazar district was shot dead at about 10:00pm Tuesday.

Brother of the deceased Roben Sinha said, three people coming by a motorbike intercepted his auto-rickshaw near his house at village Kalarbil when he along with his family members was returning home after visiting Ranibazar puja mandap. Rabindra and others got down from the auto-rickshaw and tried to flee the scene. But the attackers shot in his chest before leaving the area.

Seriously injured, he was rushed to the upazila health complex, where the doctors declared him dead.

Police recovered the body and sent it to the Moulvibazar Sadar hospital for postmortem.

Officer in-charge of Komolganj police station

Abul Kalam Azad said, they are yet to ascertain the motive behind the killing. However, police have arrested auto-rickshaw driver Abdus Salam, as a suspect.

Rabindra was the acting headmaster of Baghhachhara Government Primary School of Komolganj upazila.

Meanwhile, members of Manipuri community in the upazila suspended all the puja celebration to protest killing of Rabindra, who was also general secretary of Hojat Dalua, a youth organisation of the community.

Wearing black badges, the primary teachers also organised a protest rally in the town yesterday afternoon, demanding immediate arrest and punishment of the killers.

At the rally, they announced an agitation programme on 30 October.

The programme includes human chain, wearing black badge, mourning procession and giving memo to the Upazila Nirbahi Officer and police officials on the day.

Minor girl killed in fire incident

UNB, Khulna

A six-year-old girl was killed and her elder sister injured as a fire broke out at their house at Chakmathurabad in Dumuria upazila on Tuesday night.

The deceased was identified as Meem, daughter of Jamal of the village. The injured is Tumpa, 10.

Locals said the fire originated from the kitchen at about 9:30 pm and soon engulfed the entire house when Meem and Tumpa along with their two other siblings were staying at the house. Jamal and his wife left the house for a local bazaar before the incident took place.

Tumpa and Meem took shelter under a cot to save themselves from the blaze while their two siblings managed to come out of the house and raised an alarm.

Later, locals rushed to the spot, doused the blaze and took the two sisters out of the house in an unconscious condition. In the meantime, Meem died.

Badly injured, Tumpa was rushed to the burn unit of Khulna Medical College Hospital.

College student murdered

UNB, Khulna

Police recovered the beheaded body of a college student from Shibpur area in Dumuria upazila yesterday.

The deceased was identified as Obaidur Rahman alias Rubel, 18, a student of Dumuria College and son of Lutfar Rahman Sheikh of Gotudia village of the upazila.

Locals said a villager found Rubel's body at his paddy field in the area in the morning and informed police.

Family sources said Rubel went missing since Tuesday morning as he hired a motorbike to visit Durga Puja mandaps in the upazila.

8 killed in 2 days in 4 districts

Eight people were killed in Kushtia, Thakurgaon, Narail and Jessore districts yesterday and the day before.

Police recovered the bodies of two people in Sadar and Kumarkhali upazilas of Kushtia yesterday morning, reports our correspondent.

Locals found the beheaded body of an unidentified man in a field at Barupara village of Sadar upazila at about 10:30am and informed the police.

Police also recovered the body of a youth from Pant village.

The deceased, Uzzal Hossain, 25, son of Oliar Rahman of the village, remained missing since last month.

Criminals might have killed Uzzal as several marks of injury were found in the body, said the OC.

In Thakurgaon, police recovered the hanging body of a man from a house at Munshipara Gorea village in Sadar upazila yesterday, reports our correspondent.

The dead, Krisnakumer, 50, hailed from Bhusir Bandar village in Dinajpur. He worked at a shop named 'Babul Bastraloy' at Gorea Bazar in the upazila as manager.

Locals said, shop owner Mohidul Islam recently claimed that his five employees including Krisnakumer had taken away about Tk five lakh from the shop.

Mohidul filed a complaint with chairman of Gorea union parishad who asked them to pay Tk one lakh each before eid.

At this, the manger took his life by hanging himself, they said.

Contacted, officer in-charge of Thakurgaon police station Zahedur Rahman Chowdhury said they were waiting for the autopsy report to see whether the incident was suicide or murder.

Away in Narail, A man was

killed allegedly by his younger brother at Ariara village in Lohagara upazila on Tuesday night.

The deceased was identified as Rafiq Sheikh, 28, son of Akhter Sheikh of the village, reports our correspondent.

Akram Hossain, officer in-charge of Lohagara police station, said Delwar Sheikh stabbed Rofiq indiscriminately, leaving him dead on the spot following an altercation over family feud.

In Jessore, four people including a housewife were found murdered in separate incidents in the district on Tuesday, reports a correspondent.

The deceased are Anwarul Fakir, 36, son of late Aziz Fakir of North Dihi village in Fultola upazila of Khulna, Asad, 35, son of Mosharof of Jugnipasha village in Abhaynagar upazila, Salma Khatun, wife of Shaheen Hossain of Kamalpur village in Sadar upazila of Jessore and a cow lifter.

Locals found the bodies of Anwarul and Asad in Tetultola area of Abhaynagar upazila in the morning and informed the police.

The accused might have been stabbed to death by their rivals, said the OC of Abhaynagar PS.

Locals said they found a housewife's body floating on River Mokteshshori at Kamalpur village and informed the police who recovered the body and later arrested the deceased's husband.

Besides, an alleged cow lifter was killed in mob beating at Mahakal village in Abdaynagar at night.

A group of cow lifters entered the house of one Amit Ghosh and tried to lift cattle.

Hearing the hue and cry, neighbors rushed to the spot and caught one of the cow lifters and beat him up, leaving him dead on the spot, said OC Abdus Salek.
