Hanif for fair probe into alleged IU corruption

Mahbubul Alam Hanif, joint general secretary of Bangladesh Awami League, has called for proper investigation into allegations of corruption against the Islamic University (IU) authorities.

The AL leader made the call while talking to journalists at Kushtia Circuit House yesterday.

"The University Grants Commission (UGC) has already formed a three-member committee to investigate what actually happened at IU," Hanif said, adding that the vice-chancellor, pro-vice chancellor and other officials concerned will face action if the allegations against them are found to be true.

He said the persons involved in malpractices, which put the university into a stalemate since September 8, won't be spared.

The situation arose after the university authorities on September 7 recruited four teachers, four officials and 124 class three and class four employees against 76 advertised posts.

Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) and Bangabandhu Parishad IU units, and pro-AL

teachers' front alleged massive irregularities in the recruitment of teachers, officials and 124 employees and demanded cancellation of all appointments.

Academic and administrative activities came to a halt after BCL university unit started agitation on the campus on September 8 demanding removal of the VC, pro-VC and treasurer for their alleged involvement in the recruitment process. In the face of agitation, the VC, pro-VC and other officials have stopped coming to the university since the day.

On September 13, BCL locked the main gate of the university. On September 30, Bangabandhu Parishad IU unit demanded immediate removal of the VC, Pro-VC and treasurer, terming them 'corrupt' and 'incompetent' to run the university.

On October 2, the IU Teachers' Association (IUTA) in a written statement declared the VC, pro-VC and treasurer unwanted on the campus. The IUTA also demanded cancellation of all illegal appointments and judicial inquiry into alleged corruption in the recruitment.

Trade thru' Hili resumes

The export and import activities at the port came to a halt on October 19 due to the Eid-Ul-Azha and Durga Puja in the two countries. However, immigration remained open during the holidays, said Khwaza Nazimuddin, an immigration official at the land port.

Abducted girl rescued

A teenage school student, who was allegedly abducted by criminals from Singa village under Shigashobpur union in Sadar upazila on October 25, was rescued from a house at Tarapur village yesterday. Earlier, the father of the victim filed a case accusing five people. The accused are Miskar Sardar Tufan and his four accomplices of the village. Sub-inspector (SI) Mokaddes Hossain of Narail police station said that the family members of Miskar Sardar Tufan handed over the girl to the union parishad chairman in the morning and fled the scene. "We are trying to arrest the criminals," he added.

KCC employee killed

An employee of Khulna City Corporation (KCC) was hacked to death by criminals near Boya Textile Mill under the city's Sonadanga PS on Monday night. The deceased was identified as Guddu, 25, a resident of the area. Police said Guddu was attacked by a gang of criminals. The gang hacked him with sharp weapons, leaving him fatally injured at around 9:30. His body was recovered from Molyapota slum area at 11:00pm, they said.

10 rescued from traffickers

Members of Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) rescued 10 people from Putkhali border yesterday morning while they were being trafficked to India. The victims, including a woman and a child, hailed from different areas in Faridpur and Narail districts. Acting on a tip-off, a BGB team raided the area and rescued the ten when they were being trafficked to India through the border, said Subedar Ayub Hossain, in-charge of Putkhali BGB Camp. However, no one was arrested as the human traffickers fled the scene sensing the presence of the border guards, he said.

Two die from snakebites

Two housewives died from snakebites at different places in Sadullapur upazila yesterday. Jyotsna Rani, 35, wife of Koka Chandra Das of village Baro Daudpur in the upazila was bitten by a poisonous snake when she opened an old and long unused leather suitcase. She died on the spot. In second incident, housewife Marzina Begum, 42, of village Joyenpur, while coming from her parents' house at noon, was bitten by a poisonous snake at a paddy field. She fell unconscious and later died while being taken to Rangpur Medical College Hospital.

Boat race in Barisal

A traditional boat race was held at Harta on the Sandhya River in Wazirpur upazila on Monday. Organised by Harta Bazaar Committee on the occasion of Laxmi Puja, the race was aimed at patronising indigenous sports and rural culture. The race started from Harta old union parishad at 4:00pm and ended at Harta Bazaar Ghat. Thirteen teams, including one women's, from different areas of the region participated in the competition. Monirul Islam, MP, attended the occasion as the chief guest.

Body found in toilet

Body of a man was found in a toilet of a mosque in Companiganj upazila on Monday night. The dead was identified as Abu Naim, 30, son of Md. Zahurul Hoque of Bashirhat municipality in the same upazila. Md. Emran Ali, officer in-charge of Companiganj police station said, a devotee opened the door of the toilet and saw Abu Naim lying on the floor around 11pm. Police recovered the body and sent it to Noakhali Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy. Police found some marks of injuries in the body, the OC added.

Rivals cut off tendons of BCL activist

A BCL activist was severely injured as his tendons and fingers were cut off by the activists of rival factions during a clash at Betbaria village under Narail municipality on Monday evening. Injured Masud Mollah, 19, son of Phul Mia of the village was admitted to Narail Sadar Hospital in critical condition.

BCL sources said, the clash ensued at around 5:00 pm between Mussabar and Masud groups following an altercation over a trivial matter.

During the clash, both the groups, equipped with sharp weapon and sticks, locked in a clash. One group cut off Masud's three fingers of right hand and tendons of two legs.

Fire damages property

Fire incidents in Munshiganj and Chuadanga districts gutted at least four business establishments and four houses on Monday.

A devastating fire gutted at least four business establishments and a house at Manikpur in Munshiganj town, reports our correspondent.

Local fire service sources said the fire originated from an electric short circuit at a business house at about 8:30pm and soon engulfed the three adjacent others and a house.

Vehicular movement on Mukterpur-Manikpur-Munshiganj route came to a halt for one and a half hours from 8:00pm due to the fire.

In Chuadanga, fire gutted at least three houses at Bhogol Bogadi village under Bhangbariya union in Alamdanga upazila on Monday afternoon, reports a correspondent.

Police and fire service sources said the fire originated from a heap of burning jute stalks at Beltu's house.

The victim families claimed that the damages caused by the fire could be worth Tk 8 lakh.
