

3 housewives killed allegedly for dowry

Another 'commits suicide'

Three housewives have been murdered allegedly for dowry in Jessor, Bogra and Jhenaidah.

Another housewife allegedly committed suicide in Magura.

A young housewife was killed allegedly by in-laws for dowry in Bagharpura upazila of Jessor on Monday night.

The deceased was identified as Muslma Khatun, 17, wife of Monirul Islam of Adampur village in the upazila, reports UNB.

Police said, Rabiu Islam Molla, father of Muslma of Monirampur upazila, had promised to give Tk two lakh and gold ornaments as dowry during the marriage of his daughter seven months ago.

Recently, Mariam Begum, mother-in-law of the Muslma, demanded a motorbike as dowry.

As Muslma turned down the demand, Mariam, aided by her younger brother and son, strangled her at about 11pm and hung the body with a beam of the house to prove the incident as a case of suicide.

Police arrested Monirul but other members of his family went into hiding.

In Bogra, a housewife was murdered allegedly by her husband and in-laws at Katnarpura in the town on Monday.

The deceased was identified as Reba Begum, 24, wife of Ashik Mahmud of the area, reports a correspondent.

Reba's uncle said, Ashik demanded Tk. 1.20 lakh as dowry for doing business.

The reason behind the 'suicide' could not be known immediately. A case was filed in this connection.

Locals rescued Reba and took her to the Shaheed Ziaur Rahman Medical College and Hospital (SZMCH) where she died at 6:00pm.

In Jhenaidah, police arrested Rubel Hossain, 30, on Tuesday on charge of killing his wife at Sonardari village under Harinakundo upazila, reports our correspondent.

Police and locals said, Rima Khatun, 22, daughter of Ramzan Ali of Sonardari village under the upazila was killed allegedly for refusing to bring dowry.

Officer in-charge (OC) Abul Khayer of Harinakundo police station said, Rima Khatun, 22, was married to Rubel Hossain, son of Mosharrof Hossain of the same village four years back.

On Tuesday evening, Rubel and his wife were returning to home from his father-in-law's residence. But locals found the housewife's body lying by the side of a ditch in the area.

On information, police recovered the body at around 9:30pm.

Police later arrested Rubel on charge of killing Rima.

Double murder in Manikganj

Two people were murdered at Char Paltan village under Singair upazila in the district on Monday night.

The deceased were identified as Biplob Hossain, 32, son of Delwar Hossain and Abul Kalam Habu, 22, son of Alauddin of Dhalikanda village under Keraniganj upazila in Dhaka.

Biplob Hossain's brother Ilyas Hossain alleged that following a call from wife

Jharna Begum, Biplob went to the house at Char Paltan village with his relative Abul Kalam Habu at around 8:30pm on Monday. There, Jharna and her accomplices killed them brutally and dumped their bodies at two separate spots of the village.

He further said that there was an illicit relation between Jharna and another youth of the village. Police recovered the bodies in the morning and sent them to Manikganj

Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy.

Officer in-charge (OC) of Singair police station Md. Liaqat Ali told this correspondent that previous enmity might be the reason behind the murders.

There was a serious feud between Biplob Hossain and family members of his wife Jharna for the last few months, he said.

We have already arrested two people, including Jharna, the OC said.

PABNA NURSING INSTITUTE

Students give 3-day ultimatum to remove in-charge

Student nurses of Pabna Nursing Institute yesterday gave a three-day ultimatum demanding removal of institute In-Charge Halima Khatun by November 3.

The student nurses, who issued the ultimatum through an application submitted to Dr Monwarul Aziz, assistant director of Pabna Medical College Hospital, warned of tougher agitation programmes if their demand is not met by the time.

To press for the same demand, over 150 students of the nursing institute last week submitted an application to the director of nursing under the Directorate General of Health Services.

In the letter they alleged that Halima Khatun often misbehaves with the students, threatens to take action in case of results' and mentally tortures them, causing disturbance to academic activities at the institute.

Contacted by this correspondent, Dr Monwarul Aziz said, "The nursing

institute is controlled by the director of nursing under the Directorate General of Health Services. As the students earlier lodged a complaint with the director of nursing against the in-charge of Pabna Nursing Institute, they should wait for the next action of the DG office. But they have threatened strike. Departmental steps will be taken if they go on strike again."

Contacted, Halima Khatun, in charge of Pabna Nursing Institute, refuted the allegations against her, and said, "The students might have been instigated by others. The director of nursing will take action if I am guilty."

Earlier student nurses of Pabna Nursing Institute started demonstration on October 15, demanding giving pass marks to six third year nursing students who had failed in the year final examinations.

After seven days' work abstention the student nurses joined work at the hospital on October 23 on condition but they have now started agitation demanding removal of the nursing institute chief.
