A housewife was murdered while another was hurled acid allegedly by husbands in Chuadanga and Magura districts on Friday and on the previous day.

A woman was killed allegedly by her husband for dowry in Boldiya village under Shankorchandra union in Chuadanga Sadar upazila on Friday night.

The deceased was identified as Momotaj, 30, daughter of Moyruddin and wife of Abdullah of the village, reports a correspondent.

Victim's mother Sahida Khatun said Momotaj was married off to Abdullah, son of Motleb Ali Mondol of Phulbariy village of the upazila eight years back.

During the marriage, Abdullah was given Tk 2 lakh and other goods as dowry. But recently Abdullah demanded Tk one lakh more

and often tortured Momtaj for the money. On the fateful day, Abdullah locked in an altercation with Momtaj in the evening over

In Magura, a housewife sustained severe burn injuries in an acid attack allegedly by her husband at Amalsar village in Sreepur upazila on Thursday night, reports UNB.

The victim was identified as Aklima Begam, 47, daughter of Afazal Sheikh of the village.

Family sources said, Kalam Joardar, 58, son of Ekdel Joaraer of Kudla village of the same upazila, married Aklima long ago. Police said the couple used to quarrel over

extramarital affairs of Kalam.

At one stage, Aklima went back to her father's house.

On Thursday night, Kalam to the house and threw acid on Akima's body, leaving her seriously injured.

Hearing her cry for help, local people rescued her and took her to Sadar Hospital. Kalam went into hiding after the incident.

## Youth murdered in Narsingdi; 5 hurt, houses ransacked in Netrakona

A youth was murdered in Narsingdi while five people were injured and five houses ransacked in Netrakona due to incidents over disputed lands on Friday.

A youth was brutally killed by his rivals over a land dispute at Damerbawla village in Sadar upazila of Narsingdi district on Friday night. The deceased was identi-

fied as Mubarak Hossain, 30, son of late Olek Mia of Shantibawla village in the upazila, reports UNB. Police and locals said

there was a longstanding dispute between Mubarak Hossain and Shuvo Mia of neighboring Damerbawla village over a piece of land. An arbitration meeting

was held at 8 pm on the day at Damerbawla village between the rival groups but the issue was not settled.

After the meeting, when Mubarak was returning home at about 9 pm, Shuvo along with his supporters swooped on Mubarak. They

stabbed him first and later slit his throat with a sharp weapon. In Netrakona, at least five

people were injured and five houses ransacked during an attack by the criminals over a piece of disputed land in Nagra area of the district town on Friday night, reports our correspondent. Police and locals said

there was a longstanding conflict between one Ranjit Sarker of the area and his neighbour Mojibur Rahman over the land. As a sequel to the conflict,

a gang of 10/15 allegedly led by Mojibur, his three sons Roni, Joni and Ani attacked Ranjit and his family members with lethal weapons, leaving at least five injured at about 8:00pm.

The attackers also damaged their houses and looted cash and gold ornaments worth Tk 6.5 lakh.

Of the injured, Ranjit, Sanjit and Sanjoy were rushed to Netrakona Sadar Hospital in critical condition.

to Rab-10. A Rab-10 team in collaboration with Rab-5 in Joypurhat made a trap in the name of payment of ransom money through the father of the victim. When Salam went to pay the

amount at village Simultair in Shaghata, the elite forces caught the three red-handed.

Later as per confession of the

arrestees, the team rescued abducted the girl from the house of one Jamaluddin at Simultair village.

The arrestees are Jamaluddin, Rezaul and Kohinoor Begum of the village.

In Narail, two teenage school students, who were abducted by criminals from Atlia village of Chachuria union in Kalia upazila on October 30, were rescued by police from Avoynagor in Jessore district on Friday.

Father of the victims filed a case accusing five people. The accused are Kamrunahar Kochi 23, Rohima Khatun, 16, Moziron, 47, Anayet Hossain, 50, of Atlia village of the same union and upazila of the district and Pannu Mia, 43 of Satkhira district. Quoting local people police said, two

daughters of a man of Atlia village in the upazila were going to a market near of their house. A gang forcibly picked them up and took them to an unknown place.

On Friday, locals held Kamrunahar Kochi, Rohima Akter on suspicion and handed them over to Kalia police.

On the basis of their confession, police rescued the abducted girls from Avoynagar.

Motiar Rahman, officer in-charge of Kalia PS said that police were raiding different places to arrest the two other accused.

A 13-year-old schoolgirl was abducted allegedly by a local Jubo League activist in Luxmipur district on Friday. The victim hailed from Tumchur village.
