FROM PAGE 1 If the briefing by BNP Vice-Chairman Shamsheer Mobin Chowdhury is anything to go by, Khaleda had, during her luncheon meetings with Indian Prime Minister Manmohan Singh and Foreign Minister Salman Khurshid, conveyed to them that she wanted to make a "new beginning" in relations with India.

The former Bangladesh premier, known for her strident anti-India stance, sought to address issues of India's concerns relating to security, connectivity and illegal migration, and indicated her willingness to accept India's participation in building a deep sea port at Sonadia. While in Delhi, she made all the right noises.

However, the big question is whether Khaleda or her party will be able to follow through on the words and warmth expressed in the Indian capital during her visit.

Bangladesh observers here would like to see if this is a genuine change of heart on the part of the BNP or just another instance of posturing.

According to Veena Sikri, a former Indian High Commissioner to Bangladesh, it remains to be seen whether the BNP or its chief will express the same sentiments on Khaleda Zia's return to Bangladesh or will walk the talk if they come back to back.

Sikri told The Daily Star that the BNP had said the same things when it was in power from 2001 and 2006, but "things on the ground were completely different from their words at that time".

She, however, said Khaleda's visit to Delhi was a "useful exercise" and it should be seen in the context of India's readiness to engage all shades of opinion in the democratic polity of Bangladesh.

The former Indian diplomat pointed to serious incidents during the BNP's last period of rule (2001-06), such as the massive arms haul in

Chittagong in April, 2004 which were meant for the north eastern Indian insurgent outfit ULFA, the 2004 serial bomb attacks across Bangladesh and the deadly August 21 grenade attack on an Awami League rally in Dhaka, all of which showed how Bangladesh had become a happy hunting ground for extremist elements.

Sikri said it remained to be seen if Khaleda's remarks made to Indian leaders would be reflected in the BNP's manifesto for the 2013 parliamentary elections, and what action would be made on the ground to match those remarks.

"Trust but verify" is the message from Dr Muchkund Dubey, another former Indian High Commissioner to Bangladesh and India's ex-Foreign Secretary, when he was asked to comment on Khaleda's remarks made in Delhi.

Dubey told The Daily Star that while India had to take at face value Khaleda Zia's remarks made in Delhi, "it must verify on the ground if her words are matched by her actions in Bangladesh".

He said it was, however, "quite right" for the Indian government to invite Khaleda and have talks with her "because in a democratic system, there should be relationship with all mainstream political parties. It is the right thing done by India".

The former envoy said it should not be India's strategy to help this party or that party in Bangladesh as "this is totally misguided and counter-productive".

US rivals go for last edge

FROM PAGE 20 night in Virginia and an event today in New Hampshire. The two presidents had planned to campaign together across three states earlier this week, but that trip was called off because of Superstorm Sandy. And, of course, there is always Ohio, the top battleground of them all.

In a whiff of 2008 nostalgia, some of Obama's travelling companions from his campaign four years ago were planning to join him on the road for the final days of his last campaign. Among them are Robert Gibbs, who served as Obama's first White House press secretary, and Reggie Love, Obama's former personal aide who left the White House earlier this year.

Not to be outdone, Romney hosted a massive rally Friday night in West Chester, Ohio, drawing more than 10,000 people to the Cincinnati area for an event that featured rock stars, sports celebrities and dozens of Republican officials. It was a high-energy event on a cold night designed to kick off his sprint to the finish.

Romney arrived in New Hampshire close to midnight on Friday after an 18-hour day on the campaign trail that took him from Virginia to Wisconsin to Ohio. He was attending a morning rally on the New Hampshire seacoast before making an afternoon appearance in Iowa, and two more in Colorado. He shifted an original plan to campaign in Nevada today in favour of a schedule likely to bring him back to Iowa, Ohio, Pennsylvania and Virginia.

Aides stress that his schedule is fluid and may change with little notice as they evaluate where his time is best spent.

Yesterday, Obama's first stop was in Mentor, Ohio, then he was campaigning in Milwaukee and Dubuque, Iowa, and ending the day in Bristow. On Sunday, he was taking his campaign to New Hampshire, Florida, Colorado and, yes, Ohio.

Polling shows the race

remains a toss-up heading into the final days. But Romney still has the tougher path; he must win more of the nine most-contested states to reach 270 electoral votes: Ohio, Florida, Virginia, North Carolina, Colorado, Nevada, Wisconsin, Iowa and New Hampshire.

Romney has added Pennsylvania to the mix, hoping to end a streak of five presidential contests where the Democratic candidate prevailed in the state. Obama won Pennsylvania by more than 10 percentage points in 2008; the latest polls in the state give him a 4- to 5-point margin. Romney will campaign in the Philadelphia suburbs on Sunday. Obama aides scoff at the Romney incursion, but they are carefully adding television spending in the state and are sending Clinton to campaign there tomorrow.

The final frenzy of campaigning comes in the wake of Superstorm Sandy that has dominated much of the news coverage for the past several days as New York, New Jersey and Connecticut recover from the brunt of its force. Friday also offered an economic finale to the campaign with the release of October jobs reports that contained better than average economic news but gave both campaigns a talking point. Employers added a better-than-expected 171,000 jobs last month, but the jobless rate ticked up to 7.9 percent from 7.8 percent - mainly because more people jumped back into the search for work.

In crucial early voting, Obama holds an apparent lead over Romney in key states. But Obama's advantage isn't as big as the one he had over John McCain four years ago, giving Romney hope that he could make up that gap in Tuesday's election.

About 25 million people already have voted in 34 states and the District of Columbia. No votes will be counted until Election Day, but several battleground states are releasing the party affiliation of

people who have voted early. So far, Democratic voters outnumber Republicans in Florida, Iowa, Nevada, North Carolina and Ohio. Republicans have the edge in Colorado.

The investigators also asked questions about his appointing of lobbyists abroad for a campaign against his rival.

Quashem refrained from answering anything, an investigator requesting anonymity told The Daily Star. The investigator said the Jamaat leader told them that he knew several people who had committed crimes against humanity in 1971 and had become well-established after 1980.

Nurul Islam, the investigation officer probing Quashem's alleged crimes, however, said they got important information from Quashem about issues involving him.

He refused to disclose anything saying that the International Crimes Tribunal Act, 1973, under which the crimes against humanity are being tried, does not permit them to do so.

Nurul said they have not decided yet whether they would ask the International Crimes Tribunal-1 for permission to interrogate Quashem more.

He claimed that the Jamaat leader yesterday extended cooperation to them during interrogation.

Quashem's counsel Tajul Islam said his client was taken to the "safe house" for quizzing in the morning as per the Tribunal-1's wish.

On September 15, the investigation officers had quizzed Quashem, he said.

The Tribunal-1 on October 8 allowed the investigation officers to interrogate him one more day at the same place.

The government has provided the tribunal a house, which is called the "safe house" in Dhanmondi to interrogate suspects.

The Awami League knows of the promises the BNP chairperson has made to India, Ashraf said, adding the ruling party would convene a press conference to let people know about them.

He talked to reporters after placing wreaths at the graves of the four national leaders killed at Dhaka jail on November 3, 1975.

Ashraf, who is also local government and rural development (LGRD) and cooperatives minister, said that as leader of the opposition, Khaleda Zia could definitely visit India; there was nothing wrong in it. Incumbent Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina had also visited India when she was the opposition leader.

Replying to a query, the ruling party spokesperson said Khaleda's India visit did not worry the ruling party.

Ashraf, son of the country's first acting president Syed Nazrul Islam who was among the leaders killed in prison, said the nation expected the trial of their killers to be completed soon. All the evidence of the jail killings had been destroyed during the BNP-Jamaat coalition government.

There is no need for any special commission for investigating the 1975 jail killings or for the trial of the killing case, the LGRD minister said.

As in the murder case of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, the case of the national leaders' killing would be resolved through a normal process, he said. And thus the nation would come by justice.

Foreign Minister Dipu Moni, Vietnamese Agriculture and Rural Development Minister Cao Duc Phat, President of Federation of Bangladesh Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FBCCI) AK Azad, President of the Vietnam Chamber of Commerce and Industry (VCCI) Vu Tien Loc, Vietnamese Ambassador to Bangladesh Quang Thuc and Bangladesh Ambassador to Vietnam Supradip Chakma also spoke at the function.

Foreign Minister Dipu Moni, Ambassador at-Large M Ziauddin, PM's Press Secretary Abul Kalam Azad and other members of her entourage were at the ceremony.

In the afternoon, the prime minister visited the Vietnam Military History Museum.

Hasina is set to visit Bai Dinh Buddhist Pagoda in Ninh Binh town today.

LAOS VISIT

The prime minister today leaves Hanoi for Vientiane on a four-day official visit to the Lao People's Democratic Republic to attend the 9th Asia-Europe Meeting of Heads of State and Government (ASEM9).

On Monday, she will join the summit's opening ceremony at the National Convention Centre. She is set to attend the plenary and concluding sessions of the summit the next day.

A VVIP flight of Biman Bangladesh Airlines carrying the prime minister and members of her entourage will take off from the Noi Bai International Airport in Hanoi at 5:00pm local time and is scheduled to reach Wattay International Airport in Vientiane at 6:00pm Laotian time.

The summit of the 48-nation forum will be held this year with the theme "Friends for Peace, Partners for Prosperity" aiming at promoting mutual understanding, peace, stability, development and prosperity of Asia and Europe.

On November 7, Hasina will hold official talks with Laotian Prime Minister Thongsing Thammavong at the Prime Minister's Office and make a courtesy call on President Choummaly Sayasone at the Presidential Palace.

She will join a luncheon to be hosted in her honour by the Laotian prime minister at Lao Plaza Hotel before leaving for home.
