DU student commits 'suicide'

A student of Dhaka University (DU) allegedly committed suicide in the district town on Saturday night. The deceased was identified as Golam Rasul alias Rasel, 26, only son of Mujibur Rahman of Kalikapur in the town. He was a student of Philosophy department at DU. Police and family sources said, Rasel came out of their home in the evening and jumped off Patuakhali Bridge at about 10:00pm. Later, he died on way to Barisal Sher-E-Bangla Medical College and Hospital. The body was sent to the hospital morgue for autopsy. Rasel's father said his son, who came home two days ago of Eid, failed in the final examination last year.

Forest robber arrested

UNB, Bagerhat

The ringleader of a forest robber gang was arrested at Dewanbati in Sadar upazila early yesterday. The arrestee was identified as Omar Faruk alias Master Faruk, 45, chief of the outfit 'Tiger Bahini' and also son of late Ekhlas Sheikh of Dema village in the upazila. Sub-inspector of DB police Mohammad Abu Siddique said, a team of DB police raided the house of Faruk in order to arrest him. He tried to flee sensing the presence of the team, but the law enforcers managed to arrest him after a good chase, said the police official. Members of the outfit have long been engaged in attacking wood collectors in Sundarbans, looting their belongings and realising ransom after abduction. Faruk was wanted in 12 different cases, including that of murder, said police.

Man beaten to death

UNB, Barisal

A man who was beaten by his neighbour following previous enmity in the city on Thursday, died at Barisal Sher-e-Bangla Medical College Hospital on Saturday. The victim was identified as Jahangir Hossain, 35, of Astakathi in Jagua area of the city. Shaheduzzaman, officer in-charge of Barisal Kotwali police station, said Jahangir was beaten mercilessly by his neighbour Abul Kalam Mithu and his men at Panchgao Bazar of Chandipur in the town Thursday noon. He was admitted to Barisal Sher-e-Bangla Medical College Hospital in critical condition and succumbed to his injuries on Saturday noon. Akkas Hossain Kuttu, brother of the victim, lodged a murder case in this connection against Mithu and 7 others.

TANGAIL-3 BY-ELECTION

Hanif threatens to expel rebel candidate Rana

Awami League (AL) Joint Secretary Mahbubul Alam Hanif has said rebel AL candidate Amanur Rahman Khan Rana will face expulsion if he does not withdraw his candidature from by-election to Tangail-3 (Ghatal) parliamentary seat within three days.

He sounded the warning while addressing a meeting of workers of AL candidate Shahidul Islam Lebu at Ghatal Upazila Parishad auditorium yesterday afternoon.

Hanif asked the party men to gear up election campaign and seek vote for Lebu.

Awami League Parliamentary Board (APB) nominated former Ghatal upazila AL general secretary Shahidul Islam Lebu for Tangail-3 (Ghatal) by election slated for November 18.

Rana, religious affairs secretary of AL Tangail district unit, was one of the six AL nomination seekers. He filed nomination paper as an indefinite candidate and is still in the race.

The convening committee of Ghatal upazila AL was declared dissolved in the

meeting. District unit General Secretary Fazlur Rahman Faruque was given the additional charge of the upazila unit.

Chaired by district AL General Secretary Fazlur Rahman Faruque, AL presidium member Kazi Jafarullah, Organizing Secretary Ahmad Hossain, AL leaders Khalid Mahmud Chowdhury MP, Abu Sayeed Al Mahmud Swapan and Enamul Haque Shamim, Jubo League Joint Secretary Mamunur Rashid Mamun, and Chhatra League President Bodiuzzaman Shohag spoke at the meeting.

Meanwhile, Election Commissioner (EC) Brigadier Gen (retd) Mohammad Jaber Ali has said all necessary measures have been taken to hold a free and fair by-election in Tangail-3 constituency.

The EC said this at a view exchange meeting on the by-election in the deputy commissioner's conference room yesterday.

Returning Officer (RO) Syed Khurshid Anwar and Superintendent of Police AKM Hafiz Akter spoke at the meeting with Deputy Commissioner Anisur Rahman Miah in the chair.

Jhalakathi Jasas secretary arrested with arms

December 8, 2003, police said. In Gopalganj, Rab-8 arrested three criminals along with one shutter gun and a bullet in Shankarpasha-Kalna ferryghat area under Kasiani upazila on Saturday night, reports a correspondent. The arrestees are Sohel Sheikh, 26, Md. Masum Hossain, 25 and Md. Imran Sikder of Bhatupara, Jangal Mukundapur and

Shankarpasha villages in the upazila.

Among them, Sohel Sheikh is wanted by police in a murder case.

Rab sources said, acting a tip off, a team of elite force at Madaripur camp, raided the office of Aanjurul Islam Aanju, former chairman of the Ratail union under the upazila and arrested them along with the arms.

Besides, the team seized a motorbike, five mobile sets and some cash taken from them.

Our Correspondent in Benapole, Jessore, adds: DB police arrested an arms peddler along with a foreign made pistol, six bullets and two magazines at Mohisadanga village under Benapole Port PS yesterday.

The arrestee was identified as Rahmat Ali, 34, son of Mozammel Hossain of the village.

DB police sources said, on secret information, a team raided Mohisadanga village and arrested Rahmat along with the arms and ammos at about 5:00am.

The Environment Specialist will report to the Project Director and will be assisted by full time officials in performance of the overall environmental functions of the project.
3. Key Functions of the Environment Specialist:
 - a) Support PMU in the preparation and review of EIA documents for all subprojects;
 - b) Provide inputs on environmental issues in the preparation of EOI, RFP, tender and contract documentations as required;
 - c) Support PMU to establish procedures to promote continuing improvement of compliance with all applicable environmental laws and regulations;
 - d) Support PMU to establish procedures to continue efforts to strengthen and improve knowledge of environmental issues within the organization through training programs;
 - e) Support PMU in establishing laboratories and analytical procedures for the analysis of water and other environmental samples for different parameters as required;
 - f) Support development of Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) and Quality Assurance and Quality Control (QAQC) procedures for the CWSISP/CWASA laboratories;
 - g) Assist PMU in overseeing activities of consultants and studies to be undertaken in respect of the environment related issues in the project;
 - h) Support PMU in promoting cooperation and understanding with the public, customers, and governmental agencies in developing economically feasible and environmentally sound objectives;
 - i) Continue to promptly report all noncompliance issues in accordance with applicable governmental reporting requirements, evaluate causes of noncompliance, and support implementation of corrective actions;
 - j) Support PMU in establishing procedures for periodic review of environmental compliance with all laws and regulations, as well as with the ISO 14001 Environmental Management System;
 - k) Review reports prepared by various consultants engaged under the environment component of the project and prepare written reports for PMU;

Rangpur docs on week-long 2-hour work abstention

Call to withdraw 'false' case

Doctors of Rangpur Medical College and Hospital and private clinics yesterday started a week-long two-hour work abstention every day from 10:00am, demanding withdrawal of 'a false' case against their four colleagues.

They also wore black badge during the protest programme.

On Saturday, the physicians at a press conference at the hospital auditorium announced the programme.

Sources said, one Moklesur Rahman filed a case against doctors Azizul Islam, Sharmin Sultana Lucky, Moni and Monwar Hossain with Kotwali police station on October 31.

Moklesur in his case stated that his wife gave birth to a baby at a clinic in the city on October 30, who died due to faulty operation.

The agitating physicians at the press conference also threatened to continue the work abstention programme until the demand was met.

Dr Nurunnabi Laiz, joint secretary of Swadhinat Chikitsak Parishad of Rangpur district unit, Dr Lelin and Dr Monwar Hossain, were present, among others.
