BCL activists attack coaching centres, Shibir office

A group of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) men ransacked two coaching centres and an office of Islami Chhatra Shibir in the city on Tuesday night.

Witnesses said, a procession, led by city AL convener Shawkat Hossain Hiron, also mayor of Barisal City Corporation (BCC), was brought out by city and district Awami League in the evening, protesting attack on the escort cars of the law minister in the capital on Tuesday.

Among others, AL lawmaker Talukdar Md Yunus and activists Laskar Nurul Huq, Syed Anis, Anusiddin Shahid and Saidur Rahman Rintu, joined the programme.

When the procession was parading different streets of the city, a group of BCL men led by city chief Jasimuddin ransacked Retina and

Focus coaching centres in Battala and BM College areas and looted valuables from there. Later, they ransacked a local ward Shibir office in Kashipur area at around 9:00pm.

They also forced to shut down Masum Computer, adjacent to AL office in Bibir Pukur area.

Babul, cashier, and Saiful, peon of Retina coaching centre, were injured as the activists beat them up during the rampage. Later, BCL men handed the two over to police identifying them as Shibir activists.

Shaheduzzaman, officer in-charge at Kotwali police station, said Babul and Saiful were admitted to Barisal Sher-e-Bangla Medical College and Hospital.

Despite repeated attempts, Jasimuddin was not available for his comment in this connection.

Disgruntled aspirants ransack room of BMA election chief

A group of Swadhinata Chikitsak Parishad members yesterday ransacked the room of Prof PC Babla at Mymensingh Medical College (MMC).

They attacked the room of Dr Babla, head of election commission to Bangladesh Medical Association (BMA) election at MMC allegedly after failing to get nominations.

The agitated doctors damaged the windowpanes and notice board of the room and scrapped the voters' list hung in front of the room. They also ransacked some furniture kept before the room, witnesses said.

Earlier, a group of doctors, who failed to get nomination rejected the panel for November 29 election and snatched nomination withdrawal forms from some candidates on November 11, the last day for withdrawal of candidature, sources said.

After the untoward incident, the election commission, headed by Prof PC Babla, postponed the election.

At least 200 candidates from different groups of Swadhinata Chikitsak Parishad filed nomination papers to contest the elec-

tion to 23-member Mymensingh BMA unit.

As it was difficult to nominate candidates for all 23 posts from the parishad, central leaders on Saturday held a meeting with Captain (ret'd) Mujibur Rahman Fakir, MP, at his residence in the capital.

The meeting finalised a panel but the rival members of the parishad here rejected the panel, sources added.

As the doctors of a faction who got nominations along with their supporters were preparing to join the election on the scheduled date, the doctors belonging to other faction of the parishad started to press for fresh schedule with fresh candidates from their side, they said.

Today the panel is likely to be introduced at a function at MMC auditorium in presence of the central leaders of the parishad.

The vested quarters may foil the programme and yesterday's incident is related to it, said a parishad leader, expressing fear.

Contacted, MMC principal Dr. Motiur Rahman, however, said the air of grievances centering the BMA election has already been minimised through a meeting at MMC yesterday afternoon.

Human chain, roadblock by IU teachers and students

Around 1000 teachers, officers, staff and general students of the Islamic University (IU) formed a human chain on the campus yesterday, demanding removal of vice-chancellor, pro-vice-chancellor and treasurer of the university.

Yesterday's human chain was a part of the agitation that had been continuing on the campus for the last two months since September 8.

Islamic University Teachers Association (IUTA) organised the programme.

Sources said, before the human chain, the participants brought out a procession on the campus. After parading the campus, they put up a barricade on Kushtia-Khulna highway for half an hour from 11.00.

The teachers criticised the university authorities for clinging to the power although all teachers, officers, staff and general students had rejected them.

The agitation started at IU after a syndicate meeting in September appointed 132 teachers and staffs at the university including daughter of the vice-chancellor as a lecturer at the department of Applied Chemistry. Different teacher's organisations and students fronts brought allegations of massive irregularities in the recruitment process and demanded its cancellation.

No class and examination were held in the last two months.

Jubo Dal activist killed in Pabna

A Jubo Dal activist was murdered allegedly by Swechchhashebok League men at Koromza village in Santhia upazila of the district on Tuesday night.

The victim, Md Abdul Hannan, was a member Santhia upazila unit of BNP's youth front.

Police quoted family members as saying that Hannan came under attack while he was returning home at Koromza village from Koromza haat at around 9:30pm.

They said Santhia upazila Swechchhashebok League leader Md Abul Barkat and his associates intercepted Hannan near his house and locked in an altercation with him over toll collection from the haat.

At one stage, Barkat and his men hit Hannan with sharp weapons and left the scene, they added.

Critically injured Hannan was taken to the upazila health complex where suc-

cumbed to his injuries soon after admission.

Hanna's wife Mariam Begum filed a case with Santhia Police station yesterday morning, accusing Barkat, organising secretary of the upazila unit of Swechchhashebok League, and nine others.

Santhia upazila Jubo Dal President Abdul Matin said Hannan was murdered as a sequel to a previous conflict with local AL men over toll collection from Koromza haat. He demanded immediate arrest and exemplary punishment of the killers.

Meanwhile, unidentified assailants killed Rangpur district Jubo Dal leader Rezaul Karim Milon in Pasharipara area of Rangpur city on Monday night.

Milon's wife Jannatul Ferdous Joly filed a case with Sadar Police Station on Tuesday, accusing seven people of killing her husband.

Police arrested four of the accused on the day while the rest are still at large.

BCL leaders hurt in JCD attack

Three Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) leaders were injured as Jatiyatobadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) activists attacked them on Manikganj Government Devendra College campus yesterday. The injured are Abid Hossain Khan Sakib, organising secretary of BCL college unit, Tanvir Foysal Rahi, assistant relief and disaster affairs secretary of the district unit and its member Joy Khandaker. Of the trio, Abid was admitted to Manikganj Sadar Hospital in critical condition. Injured Tanvir and Joy said a group of JCD men numbering 30/40 and led by Awlad Hossain suddenly beat them up with iron rods mercilessly while they were gossiping on the campus. Contacted, former president of the college unit JCD Awlad Hossain said he was not present on the campus when the attack was made.

Nine injured in clash

At least nine people were injured in a clash between two rival groups over a piece of disputed land at Khordamalibari village in Sadar upazila yesterday. Locals said there was a longstanding conflict between one Azahar Ali of Khordamalibari and Sekender Ali of Fakirtari village over the land. The supporters of the rivals attacked each other with lethal weapons, leaving at least nine from both sides injured following an altercation over the issue. Of the injured, five were admitted to Gaibandha Sadar Hospital.
