Chairmen, members of 108 UPs in Bogra on work abstention

The chairmen and members of 108 union parishads (UPs) in the district refained from official jobs yesterday, the second day of their threeday work abstention programme.

The UP chairmen and members began work abstention from Tuesday as the central committee of Bangladesh Union Parishad Forum (BUPF) called the programme to press their eight-point demand.

The demands include hike in monthly honorarium for chairmen and members, abolition of clauses 34 and 77 of Local Government (Union Parishad) Act 2009, and direct allocation of funds of Test Relief, Food for Work and Annual Development Programme (ADP) and one percent of land tax to union Parishads.

Abu Sufian Shafiq, joint convener of the district unit of Bangladesh Union Parishad Forum, said the central body of the forum will announce its next programme soon to mount pressure on the government to meet the eight-point demand.

Tk 1cr beans sell a day at Muladuli market

Muladuli vegetable market in Ishwardi upazila under the district is buzzing with activities as the largest 'bean market' of the northern region sees trading of beans worth Tk 80 lakh to 1 crore daily during the ongoing reaping season.

Sixty to 70 trucks loaded with the popular winter vegetable go to Dhaka, Chittagong, Sylhet, Narayanganj and other areas of the country every day from Muladuli market, said Aminur Rahman Babu, a bean wholesaler, also a leading farmer of the region.

"The farmers from different villages of Muladuli union in Ishwardi upazila,

Zonail, Haripur and the adjoining villages of Chatmohar upazila under Pabna district bring their produces to this market," said Abdul Hamid, president of Muladuli vegetable traders' association.

The farmers from Baraigram, Gopalpur and Lalpur upazilas in Natore district also bring their beans to Muladuli market, he said, adding, "Now a maund of bean is selling for Tk 600 to 650. The price will reduce within next couple of weeks when the supply becomes more available."

"We collect the beans from the farmers and later sell it to the traders coming from different areas of the Khidirpur, Par Khidirpur and country. At least 3,000 to

are opting for profitable bean cultivation in Ishwardi and adjoining areas of the district. Around over 3.5 thousand hectares of cultivated land in the district, including 1500 hectares in Muladuli union alone, have been brought under bean cultivation this year while the area was 2200 hectares

Khurshid Alam said. "Tk 12/14 thousand is spent for farming bean on each bigha of land. If there is no natural calamity a farmer can get 80 to 100 maunds of bean in a season (production available for two months). Covering the production cost, a farmer can easily earn Tk 15 to 20 thousand from a bigha of land,"

On November 4, a few central leaders of AL went to Ghatail and warned 'rebel' candidate Rana of expulsion from the party if he does not withdraw his candidature within three days while Rana on the same day declared that he will be in the polls race as 'a candidate of Ghatail people'.

Rana and Tuhin have sought deployment of army in the byelection to prevent 'possible rigging' while Lebu expressed his 'no objection' to the matter.

"I want deployment of army as Shahidul Islam Lebu, after being sure of his defeat in the by-election, is using the members of the law enforcement agencies to create panic among my workers and supporters," Rana said.
