

# Jamaat-Shibir to face tough action if violence continues

Says Suranjit

Minister without portfolio Suranjit Sengupta yesterday said the government would take stern action against Bangladesh Jamaat-e-Islami and Islami Chhatra Shibir if they continued creating anarchy. "The government will not tolerate such mayhem and continued attacks on policemen as they have crossed the limits," he told a discussion on "Present context of politics and banning of Jamaat-Shibir" at the capital's Jatiya Press Club, organised by

Bangabandhu Academy. Suranjit also criticised BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia for her claim that her son Tarique Zia led an honest life. "Claiming Tarique honest, you have cut a great joke before the nation, as an FBI agent testified in the money-laundering case against your son," he said. Suranjit, also chief of the parliamentary standing committee on the law ministry, asked Transparency International, Bangladesh (TIB) to

withdraw its survey on lawmakers and replace it with a more objective one. "An MP may do some wrong. For that people could punish him by rejecting him in polls or charges could be pressed against him," he said. Released in October, the TIB report said 97 percent of the 149 sitting MPs surveyed were involved in "negative activities", including being linked to or being supportive of criminal activities, misusing public funds and influencing government decisions.

## European team starts free plastic surgery

A three-nation European humanitarian medical mission started free plastic surgery at Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Medical University (BSMMU) yesterday. The 2-week services are being given to the poor people suffering from deformations of faces, burn-injuries, mutilations of hands, and birth-defects. The nine-member team consisting of surgeons from Germany, Holland and Hungary arrived in Dhaka on November 10 under the aegis of "For-Bangladesh Association", a German-based voluntary organisation. Professor Shafiqul Islam and Assistant Professor Anwarul Islam of the university and President of "For Bangladesh Association" Dr Krishna Priya Das spoke at the inaugural session.

## ATTACK ON POLICE 13 Jamaat-Shibir men held

At least 13 leaders and activists of Bangladesh Jamaat-e-Islami and Islami Chhatra Shibir were arrested yesterday on charges of attacking police and vandalising and torching public property in Narayanganj, Chittagong and Gaibandha. The fresh arrests raised the tally to 80 in the last three days in the country. Narayanganj police arrested eight activists of Jamaat and Shibir raiding different areas across the district. They are Delwar Hossain, Nurul Haq, Shamsul Alam, Hafez Mohammad, Hasan Ali Bablu, Ramjan, Abdur Rahim and Shoyebur Rahman. Meanwhile, a Narayanganj court yesterday granted two days' remand for district Shibir President Nasirullah, district Jamaat Finance Secretary Jubaid, Shamsul Haq, Tajul Islam, and Nurunnabi and one day's remand for Neyamat Ullah, Kamal Hossain, Abdus Salam, Mushfiqur Rahman and Nazir in two separate cases filed by police. In Chittagong, police arrested four Shibir activists along with banned books, posters, leaflets and CDs in Fatikchhari upazila for anti-state campaigning and

attempt to create anarchy. The detainees--Rashedul Rased, 26, Mozammel Hossain, 25, Jahed Hossain, 26 and Shahed Hossain, 24--hail from the upazila's Uttar Dhurung village. Police arrested them while they were slapping posters on the walls in the area, which contained the demand of release of the arrested Jamaat leaders, said MA Sabur, officer-in-charge of Fatikchhari Police Station. Police also seized some banned Islamist books, posters, leaflets and CD from them, he said. A case was lodged with the police station in this regard, he added. Sunderganj police in Gaibandha arrested one Rafiqul Islam, secretary of Sunderganj municipality unit Jamaat and assistant super of Sunderganj Sadar Dakhil Madrasa. Police said Rafiqul was accused in a case filed by police during the country-wide agitation programme on September 30 when they attacked cops injuring eleven persons, including five police. Police had filed the case against 500 leaders and activists of the 18-party alliance in this connection. Rafiqul was arrested at Government Model Primary School.

## GRAFT ALLEGATION AGAINST MILON ACC starts probe

The Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) has started an investigation into the corruption allegations against former state minister for education ANM Ehsanul Haque Milon and his wife. On November 13, ACC commissioner (investigation) gave approval for the investigation on the basis of a complaint filed by Rezaul Karim, secretary general of Sarbajonin Human Rights Commission, a rights body, said an ACC letter sent to The Daily Star from the home ministry yesterday. According to the letter signed by ACC Director Tahidul Islam, there have been allegations of embezzling money and committing corruptions against Milon and his wife. Preferring anonymity, an official at the home ministry said they sent the letter on order from the high command of the ministry.
