Her mother, one brother and husband went to the Joypurhat Shanti Committee office at least six days to know the whereabouts of her father and to have him released, emotion-chocked Beauty said.

"I want justice for my father's killing," said Beauty, the eighth prosecution witness. On November 19, Golam

Rasul, husband of Beauty, also narrated the same incident and give a similar description.

The three-member tribunal headed by Justice ATM Fazle Kabir with members Justice Obaidul Hassan and Judge M Shahinur Islam recorded Beauty's testimony before adjourning the case proceeding until December 5 when she would face crossexamination.

During her 54-minute testimony, Beauty from Panchbibi said she was a class-IX student in 1971 and was 15-16 years old.

She said her father Jabbal Hossain, a subeder major of East Pakistan Rifles (EPR) in Chittagong, attacked the Pakistani army and opened the EPR arsenal for Bangalee EPR men during the war.

He was injured as the Pakistani army opened fire, said Beauty.

In the first week of May, 1971, two armed force's men brought her injured father and his family members to her in-law's home in Dhurail of Panchbibi.

Feeling insecure, her father, mother and other family members including Beauty moved to the home of Najimuddin in the neighbouring village of Fiska Para, she said.

She said, "Razakar Alamuddin was living beside Fiska Para. Getting information about my father's presence at Najimuddin's home, he informed Joypurhat subdivision Shanti Committee chairman and Razakar commander Abdul Alim.

Bin Laden was killed by a navy Seal team that swooped on his compound in Abbottabad, Pakistan.

One email stamped secret and sent on 2 May by a senior navy officer briefly describes how bin Laden's body was washed, wrapped in a white sheet, and then placed in a weighted bag. According to another message from the Vinson's public affairs officer, only a small group of the ship's leadership was informed of the burial.

"Traditional procedures for Islamic burial was followed," the 2 May email from Rear Admiral Charles Gaouette reads. "The deceased's body was washed (ablution) then placed in a white sheet. The body was placed in a weighted bag. A military officer read prepared religious remarks, which were translated into Arabic by a native speaker. After the words were complete, the body was placed on a prepared flat board, tipped up, whereupon the deceased's body slid into the
