IMF for fresh fuel price hike

Sets conditions for releasing second instalment of \$1b credit

The International Monetary Fund has asked the government to increase prices of petroleum products by Tk 10 per litre by next month as part of its condition to release \$140 million, the second instalment of its \$1 billion credit.

The IMF early this month sent to the government a set of conditions for the disbursement of the money. The list also includes recommendations for introduc-

ing an automatic fuel price adjustment mechanism and amending some provisions of banking and VAT related laws, a top government official told The Daily Star.

Already, the Fiscal Coordination Council and Resource Committee sat with Finance Minister AMA Muhith on November 14 to discuss the matter, among other things.

The meeting agreed to hike fuel prices

Repair cost soars

Army makes Tk 447cr fresh proposal

Bangladesh Army has made a fresh proposal for repairing Meghna and Meghna-Gumti bridges on Dhaka-Chittagong highway with a cost of Tk 447 crore.

According to the revised project proposal submitted to the communications ministry earlier this month, over Tk 300 crore would be needed as the new proposal includes mending of Meghna-Gumti bridge and a different method to fill

the scoured riverbed near the Meghna bridge.

During a meeting between the ministry and army officials over the proposal, the ministry asked the army to have the opinion of Buett experts on the cost.

The army had made the proposal after conducting an underwater survey recently.

As per the revised plan, the filling up of the scoured part of the riverbed under

New addition to public transport

First 10 articulated buses hit Dhaka streets next month; 40 more to come

A fleet of 10 articulated buses is set to hit the streets in the capital next month to ease the city's chronic transport problem.

Bangladesh Road Transport Corporation (BRTC) is importing the fleet from India under an Indian line of credit. Another 40 buses will be brought in January, said sources in BRTC.

Ashok Leyland is supplying the buses -- single-deckers that are longer than other buses, yet manoeuvre easily on the roads.

Also known as bendy buses, these vehicles comprise two rigid sections but can bend in the middle. They are popular in many countries for their higher passenger capacity.

The articulated buses will ferry around 130 passengers
