

# Arbitration's bid to save rapist, victim's father sues culprit

Persuaded by the rapist, Chandra Kanta Roy, son of Tarani Kanta Roy, a local ruling party activist forced the rape victim's parents to sit with them and resolve the matter amicably in the evening of Sunday, locals said.

Chandra also compelled the victim's family members to accept Tk 15,000 as "compensation", they said.

The father of the victim said he received the amount under duress, while Chandra Kanta Roy claimed that the victim's parents willingly accepted the money.

"I resolved the case in exchange for Tk 15,000," Chandra said.

Hossain Ali, Sub-Inspector at Parbatipur police station and Investigation Officer (IO) of the case said he had heard about the settlement.

"But any case filed under the Women and Children Repression Prevention Act cannot be resolved by a village arbitration," he said.

"We will arrest the criminal as soon as possible," he added.

Later, Roop Kumar, husband of a ward member of Chandipur union parishad tried to settle the matter locally holding back the victim's family from filing any case against Aminul, a married man of the same locality.

However, the father of the rape victim filed a case with Parbatipur police station, accusing Aminul Islam under Women and Children Repression and Prevention Act on November 26, six days into the incident, said the family members.

### Boy abducted, 2 held

A six-year-old baby boy was abducted from New Kalabagan area of the district town yesterday noon. The victim, Arafat, son of local trader Alamgir Hossain, of the area, is a student of nursery at City Kindergarten. Alamgir said his son remained missing since he went to one Sujon's shop in the area buying a packet of chips at around 12:00pm. The kidnappers demanded Tk 10 lakh as ransom from the family members over mobile phone, said Arafat's mother. Abdul Mannan, officer in-charge at Jhalakathi police station, said they detained shopkeeper Sujon and neighbour Kaniz Fatima for primary interrogation in this regard.

### Cylinder blast injures 3

UNB, Khulna

Three workers of Khulna Shipyard sustained severe burn injuries as a gas cylinder exploded in the city yesterday. The injured were identified as Liton, Monir and Jewel. Witnesses said, when some workers were working at the shipyard, a gas cylinder exploded with a big bang and a fire broke out leaving three workers injured. The injured workers jumped into the Rupsha river. However, the blaze was extinguished within half an hour. The co-workers rescued them from the river and took them to general hospital from where they were shifted to Khulna Medical College Hospital. Later, the three workers were sent to Dhaka as their condition deteriorated.

### 100 old clothe shops gutted

A devastating fire gutted over 100 old garment shops at Gobindaganj municipal hawkers market early yesterday. Delver Hossain, OC at Gobindaganj police station said the fire originated from a garment store and rapidly spread to the adjoining shops. Within half an hour, more than 100 shops were burnt to ashes, he said. Goods and valuables worth over Tk 50 lakh were damaged in the fire incident, said Abdus Salam, a shop owner. Two fire units from Gaibandha district and Sonatola upazila rushed to the spot and brought the fire under control after a hectic struggle for two hours, but nothing could be saved, witnesses said.

### Cattle looted from farm

Criminals looted 26 cattleheads from a dairy farm at Mahimapur Char under Kazipur upazila on Monday. Shimul of Bhetuajagannathpur and Sejur of Madarganj upazila under Jamalpur district jointly set up a cattle farm with 100 buffaloes and 27 cows. On Monday midnight, an armed gang of 20/25 raided the farm and took away 26 cattleheads worth Tk 20 lakh. Motiar Rahman, OC of Kazipur PS, said Shimul came to the PS but did not file any case. Police are looking into the matter at own initiative, he said.

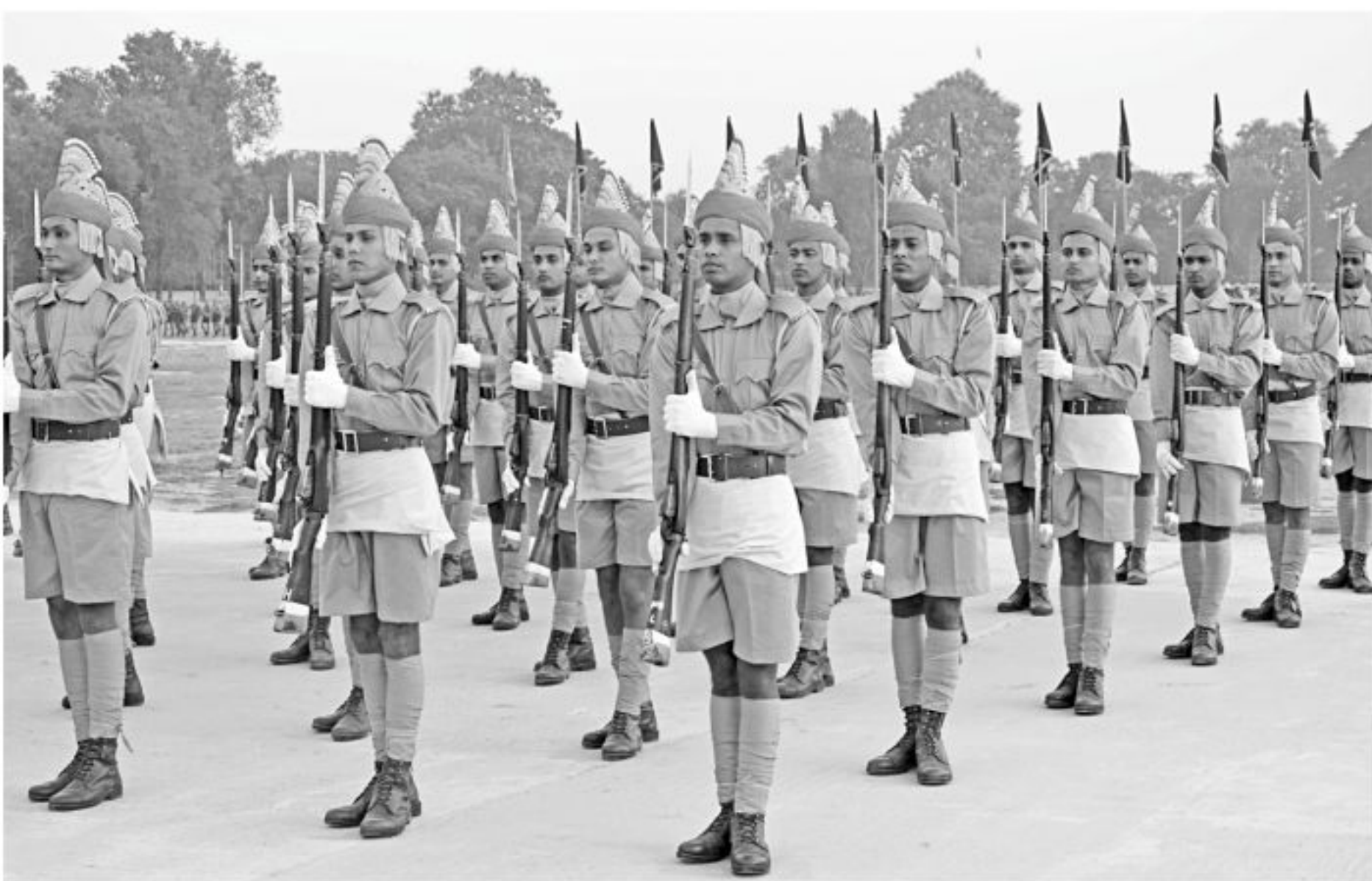

# BCL factions clash over LGED tender in Barisal

Two people were injured as activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), student front of ruling Awami League, got locked in a factional clash over dropping of tender and distribution works worth Tk 3.5 crore under Local Government Engineering Department in Barisal Sadar upazila yesterday noon.

Fariduddin, sub-assistant engineer of LGED, and member-secretary of the tender committee, said tenders under four groups worth Tk 3.33 crore were called for reconstruction of four community primary schools at Char Kyotia, Mollar Hawla, Pashurikathi and Dakkhin Panbaria of Barisal Sadar upazila and supplying furniture there.

Tenders under another

group worth Tk 18 lakh were called to repair six government and registered non-government primary schools in the upazila and Tuesday 1:00pm was the deadline for dropping tender documents, he said.

Supporters of Moin Tushar, joint convener BM College unit of BCL, and Jasimuddin, president of city unit of BCL, got locked in a clash at the upazila parishad office complex in C and B Road area of Barisal city at about 12:45am, witnesses said.

During the incident, Sayed of Tushar group, and another unidentified contractor who came to drop tender, were injured due to beating.

The clash occurred as Moin Tushar dropped tender without any 'negotiation' with the intra-party rivals, BCL activists said.

Called by the authority,

police and Rapid Action Battalion brought the situation under control at around 12:30pm.

Twenty tender forms were dropped for works under the five groups, said Raza Mia, upazila nirbahi officer of Barisal Sadar.

Development agencies like WB, ADB, IDA, DFID, EU, AUSAID, JICA, CIDA and SIDA provide fund for such works under Phase-3 of Primary Education Development Programme, said Hafizur Rahman, Barisal Sadar upazila engineer.

Police have been deployed to maintain law and order in the area, said Sakhawat Hossain, officer in charge of Kotwali police station.

Moin Tushar and Jasimuddin could not be contacted for their comments.

## BSF returns body of youth

Indian Border Security Force (BSF) yesterday returned the body of a Bangladeshi youth following a flag meeting with Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB).

Company Commander of Chanderhat BGB camp Subeder Nizamuddin said that the meeting was held of Boirchuna border under Pirganj upazila and the body was handed over in the evening.

Gonesh Chandra, 26, son of Sharat Chandra of Dastampur village under Pirganj upazila near Boirchuna border early Monday.

After receiving the body, the BGB men handed it over to the Pirganj police who later sent the body to the victim's family at night.


BSF members of Madya Gouripur camp in Uttar Dinajpur district of West Bengal opened fire on a group of Bangladeshi people when they approached the barded wire fence on Boirchuna border around 4.00am Monday leaving Gonesh Chandra dead on the spot.

The others including Ganesh's brother Polish and two associates, however, managed to flee the scene unhurt.

After the shooting, BSF personnel dragged the body into their territory.

At the meeting yesterday, BGB strongly protested the killing, saying that the Indian security force opened fire on the unarmed Bangladeshis violating the international borders.

BSF, however, claimed that the deceased was a terrorist.
