#### International short film fest from December 13

The weeklong 12th International Short and Independent Film Festival will begin on December 13 at five venues in Dhaka.

The venues are: Shawkat Osman Auditorium at Central Public Library; Bangladesh Shilpakala Academy; Goethe-Institut; Bangladesh National Museum; and Chhavanaut Sanskriti Bhaban Auditorium

This year, the organisers expect to screen approximately 200 films from 40 countries. The festival will be dedicated to the late filmmaker

Tareque Masud and cinematographer Mishuk

Finance Minister Abul Maal Abdul Muhith will inaugurate the festival as chief guest. Hedayetullah Al Mamun, secretary, Ministry of Information will be present as special guest. Noted novelist and film critic Hasnat Abdul Hye; Morshedul Islam, president of Bangladesh Short Film Forum (BSFF); and Nasiruddin Yousuff, vice president of the festival committee, will also be present at the inaugural session.

Since its inception 1986, BSFF has arranged the festival regularly as a biennial event in an attempt to introduce local film buffs to world cinema.

### Male artists lead 2013 Grammy nominations

Male artists led the nominations announced on Wednesday for the 2013 Grammys, as fun., Frank Ocean, Mumford & Sons, Jay-Z, Kanye West and Dan Auerbach from The Black Keys landed six nods each for music's biggest awards.

The nominations for New York-based indie-pop band fun. - made up of Nate Ruess, Andrew Dost and Jack Antonoff - included the four main categories for record, song and album of the year, and best new artist. fun., which also performed at the Grammy nominations concert with Janelle Monae, said it felt good to be recognized and "took pride" in its live performances.

"Tonight, all I wanted to do was get up and really give it our all ... receiving the nomination is amazing and a culmination of hard work the three of us have put into this band," lead singer Ruess told reporters The group scored a huge hit with its first single, "We Are Young," and

then followed that up with its successful album "Some Nights" and single of the same name. Joining it in the album, record of the year and best new artist catego-

ries was hip hop artist Ocean. His debut album, "Channel Orange" was a critical and commercial

success, debuting at No. 2 on the Billboard 200 album chart in July. Ocean and fun. will be competing with blues-rock group Alabama Shakes, country singer Hunter Hayes and folk-rockers The Lumineers for the coveted best new artist title.

While young male artists made up a large portion of nominees in key categories, noticeably absent was 18-year-old Canadian singer Justin Bieber, one of 2012's biggest pop music stars with chart-topping album "Believe" and singles such as "Boyfriend."

The winners will be announced at the televised awards show in Los Angeles on February 10.


