6 suspected JMB men held

Police arrested six suspected members of Islamist outfit Jamaatul Mujahideen Bangladesh (JMB) from the district town's Dakkhin Courtgaon bus stand on Wednesday. They were identified as Mamunur Rashid, 24, of Kurigram, Islam Hossain, 24, and Ilyas Mahmud, 23, of Natore, Jahangir Alam, 23, of Sirajganj, Monirul Islam, 22, of Bhola and Rony Islam of Magura. All the youths were residing at a rented house near Haraganga Govt College since December 3, police said.

BSF kidnaps boy

Indian Border Security Force (BSF) kidnapped a Bangladeshi along Chanduria border in Kolaroa upazila on Tuesday evening. The kidnapped Bangladeshi was identified as M Abu Sayeed, 14, son of Jamal Uddin of Kadpur village of the upazila. BGB sources said several Bangladeshis, including the boy, were returning to the country from India after enjoying a cultural programme in the neighbouring country. BSF members of Porandupur camp of India chased them and caught Sayeed from the Zero Point of the border and took him to camp. Others managed to return to the country.

'Criminals' held with arms

A Rab-9 team arrested two alleged criminals from the playground of Susang Degree College in Durgapur municipal area on Wednesday night and recovered two foreign made revolvers with four bullets from their possession. The arrestees are Tajul Islam, son of Azizul Haque of Bagichapara and Abdul Mojim, son of late Raju Mahmud of village Bairaura under the upazila. During the operation, Tajul hit Rab member ASI Nasir with a sharp weapon leaving him seriously injured.

Schoolboy murdered

Police recovered the body of a nine-year-old boy from a sugarcane field in Madererchar Masterpara village under Dewanganj upazila of the district on Wednesday morning. The deceased, identified as Abdur Rahim alias Babu, son of Sabur Ali of the village, was a Class Two student of Madererchar Masterpara Registered Primary School. Victim's father said, Babu went out of the house to attend a function at the village on Tuesday evening. As Babu did not return home even after the programme was over at around 2.00am, the family members looked for him here and there for a couple of hours. Finally locals found the body lying in cropfield, around 300 metres away from the boy's house at around 10.30am. Police said that the boy was hacked to death.

Violence against women on rise in Sylhet

450 cases filed in 11 months from Jan '12

Incidents of violence against women have marked a sharp rise in Sylhet in the last 11 months.

At least 450 cases for torture on women were filed under the Women and Children Repression Prevention Act in the district from January to November this year while it was 300 during the same period in 2011.

The figure was revealed at a view-exchange meeting organised by Bangladesh Mohila Parashad, Sylhet at

sion, torture, instigating suicide and murder for dowry have increased in the district this year due to the deterioration of law and order.

The aforesaid cases were filed in connection with women repression in the district from January to November this year while it was 300 during the same period in 2011.

According to sources, crimes like women repression

the auditorium of the district council recently.

At the meeting, Superintendent of Police of the district Sakhawat Hossain said the women repression related cases were on the increase.

Highest number of incidents of torture on women took place in Golapganj upazila of the district, followed by Kanaighat, Jaintapur and Jakiganj upazilas while the lowest number of incidents was recorded in

Balaganj, the SP said.

Most of the incidents occurred over dowry, he added. The 450 cases include 191 for dowry, 59 for raping women and abusing children, 128 for abduction and 72 for other forms of crimes.

Police also recorded six women trafficking incidents during the period. Some cases have already been disposed of although the number of women repression cases is on the rise, sources said.

REKKAT MURDER

17 sued in Bogra

A case was filed with Bogra Sadar police station against 17 people on Tuesday night on charge of killing Khairul Anam Rekkat.

Father of the deceased, Abdul Kauim Ofa, filed the case identifying 11 of the accused.


The main accused is executive member of district Sweekchhasebok League Arifur Rahman. Besides, the case includes step-brother and father-in-law of the victim, Sweekchhasebok League leader Suter Shadhin and Arif's father-in-law Abu Taleb.

Police have already arrested Suter Shadhin and Abu Taleb in connection with the case.

Meanwhile, the superintendent of police (SP) in Bogra has appointed Mizanur Rahman, officer-in-charge (OC) of Detective Branch as the investigation officer (IO) in the case.

Earlier, Rekkat, 35, joint convenor of Sweekchhasebok League town unit, was shot at his business office at Abdullar intersection in Rahman Nagar area of the town at 11.45am on Monday last.

Locals rescued him and took to Shaheed Ziaur Rahman Medical College and Hospital (SZMCH) where he died at the operation room at 2pm.

Satkhira brickfields set to use rice husks, defying ban

Owners of the brickfields in the seven upazilas of the district are preparing to use rice husks to burn bricks in place of using coal, defying restrictions of the Department of Environment (DoE).

Most brick kilns have kept stockpiles of coal in the compounds of the brickfields, hiding wood and husks at other nearby places, local people said.

Burning bricks in these fields will start within a couple of days, they said.

As a result, owners of the zigzag brick kilns who constructed those using modern technology and spending several lakh taka, have to incur heavy losses.

There are 70 brick kilns in the seven upazilas of the district, most of which are

run by using traditional technology.

Complying with the DoE directive, the owners converted 15/20 brick kilns into zigzag ones, using modern technology.

Dr Tarun Kanti Shikdar, director of Khulna divisional office of DoE, had given the order to convert the brick fields into modern technology-based ones like zigzag by September 20.

The owners were asked to use only coal in their brickfields instead of wood, husks and old tyres.

Contacted, deputy commissioner Dr M Anwar Hossain Hawlader said that the local administration will take stern actions against those using rice husks in place of coal in their brick fields.

Their license will also be cancelled if they do not follow the order, the DC said.

Robberies in 3 districts

A gang of masked robbers injured three people and looted cash from two bankers at Kachirchar in Phulchhari upazila of Gaibandha on Tuesday.

Police said, two officials of Rupul Bank Gaibandha Branch were going to Chitalia Digor Government Primary School in Mollar Char union for distributing about Tk 1.9 lakh as stipend among the students of 10 other schools there by a boat.

As the boat reached the area, the gang attacked the duo and other passengers and took away the money at gunpoint after giving the three a good beating.

In another incident, robbers killed a night guard of a bank in the district town early Wednesday.

The deceased was identified as Sadequl Islam, 35, of Genopara village in Gangachara upazila, said Gopal Chandra Chakravarti, OC of Sadar police station.

The gang entered Pubali Bank Gaibandha Branch on DB road by breaking open the main gate and tied up.

Sadequl later died of suffocation.

The robbers tried to break open the vault of the bank

but fled the scene sensing the presence of patrol police, said the OC.

Away in Madaripur, robbers looted cash, gold ornaments and other valuables from a house at Mollakandi village in Shibchar upazila on Tuesday night.

The law enforcers arrested one Monu Sheikh, 35, in this connection, reports a correspondent.

Police said a gang of 7/8 swooped on the house of Oman expatriate Munshi Mia and took away two tolas of gold ornaments, Tk 15,000 and seven mobile phone sets on Tuesday night.

In Manikganj, robbers beat up three people and looted valuables from two houses at Golai village under Singair upazila early yesterday, reports our correspondent.

A masked gang numbering 15-20, entered the house of Kuddus Ali of the village at around 2:00 am. They beat up two members of the house when they tried to resist the gang and looted two tolas of gold ornaments, two mobile sets and other goods.

The robbers later went to the neighbouring house of expatriate worker Abdus Sattar. They beat up the wife of Sattar and looted valuables.
