Bangladesh's GSP facility might be scrapped if govt fails to show improved labour standards

After several years of warning to act on labour standards that fell on deaf ears, the US has finally initiated actions that may take away Bangladeshi products' dutyfree access to the US.

The United States Trade Representative on December 21, 2012 sent a letter to Commerce Minister GM Quader stating that, "We are beginning to consider options that would affect Bangladesh's continued eligibility for benefits under

the GSP".
