Stray incidents of violence mark half-day hartal

Stray incidents of violence marked the eight-hour-long Jubo Dal called hartal in Rangpur Division yesterday.

The youth wing of main opposition BNP enforced the hartal from 6:00am, demanding immediate withdrawal of all 'false' cases against the party central leaders including BNP acting secretary general Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir and their release.

Our Rangpur correspondent reported that pickets vandalised the motorbike of Moinul Islam, a photojournalist of daily Prothom Alo, when he was taking snaps at Paira Chattar in the city around 11:45am.

Protesting the incident, district correspondents and photojournalists of different media houses staged a sit-in for 15 minutes from 12 noon on the intersection.

In another incident, pickets vandalised three battery-run auto-rickshaws in front of the Town Hall building in the city.

Our Thakurgaon correspondent adds: Jubo Dal activists vandalised a Panchagarh-bound BRTC bus and a goods-laden truck on Thakurgaon-Dinajpur highway in 29 Miles area of

Sadar upazila around noon.

In Lalmonirhat, a chase and counter-chase took place between Jubo Dal activists and policemen for a few minutes at Mission Crossing Road in the district town around 8:30am, reports our correspondent.

Gaibandha also saw chase and counter-chase in Palashbari upazila between cops and activists, reports our correspondent.

Besides, pickets vandalised at least six motorbikes.

The hartal was observed peacefully in Dinajpur, according to our correspondent.

All the shopping arcades and educational institutions in the eight districts of the division remained closed during the hartal hours.

Vehicular movement was thin but rickshaws were seen on the roads.

Rangpur divisional unit Jubo Dal, youth wing of main opposition party BNP, called the hartal on January 2 in the eight districts of the division.

Party sources said they called the hartal also to protest against the killings and arrests of opposition leaders and activists, price hike of essentials, electricity and fuel; violence at educational institutions; corruption and to press for restoration of the caretaker government system.

Chhatra Dal and Swachhchasebak Dal of Rangpur divisional unit extended their support to the hartal.

Schoolgirl killed after rape in Pirojpur

An eight-year-old schoolgirl was killed allegedly after rape in Nazirpur upazila of the district on Sunday.

Police arrested a youth in this connection.

The deceased was identified as Ankhi, daughter of Abdul Quader Sheikh, and a class-II student of a local primary school at Garghata village of the upazila.

M Babul Sheikh, brother of Ankhi, said his sister remained missing since she went to collect new textbooks distributed at her school on Wednesday afternoon.

At about 11:00am on Sunday, a local farmer spotted Ankhi's body at a rain tree garden of one Lutfur, adjacent to their house, and police recovered the body.

Since after the incident, their neighbour M Rezaul Sheikh's son Abdur Rab Sheikh, 28, remained absent from his house.

At this, Ankhi's family members suspected that Abdur Rab might have killed the girl taking her to the rain tree garden.

Acting on a tip-off, police detained fugitive Rab from Baburhat Bazar of the upazila.

Locals said Rab, who is a drug addict, mostly lives in Dhaka.

Abdul Khaleq Hawladar, officer-in-charge of Nazirpur PS, said as there were many injury marks on Ankhi's body, police suspected that she had been killed after rape.

Ankhi's brother Babul Sheikh filed a case with the PS in this connection.

Youth caught while trying to abduct schoolgirl

Villagers caught a youth while allegedly attempting to abduct a schoolgirl at Haybatpur in Sadar upazila yesterday morning.

The accused was identified as Nazrul Islam, 25, son of Abdur Rahim of Laxmipur Chauri village.

The girl is a class ten student at a local high school and resident of the village.

Her father alleged that one Abu Bakkar, 28, of Laxmipur Chauri village, often teased his daughter on her way to school.

Bakkar and his accomplices Nazrul Islam, 24, Faruk Hossain, 23, Tofazzal Hossain, 25, Anisur Rahman, 24, of Laxmipur Chauri entered the school and tried to pick up the girl at gunpoint yesterday at around 11:30am, he said.

The gang also threatened to shoot the teachers and students as they tried to resist the matter.

Hearing the hue and cry, locals rushed to the spot and chased the culprits and caught Nazrul while the rest managed to flee the scene by a microbus.

Nazrul was later handed over to police, said family members.

Agitated villagers blocked Natore-Dhaka highway for about one and a half hours, demanding immediate arrest and punishment of the criminals.

They withdrew the barricade at around 1:00pm following an assurance by police of taking steps to arrest those responsible for the offence.

A case was filed accusing five people in this connection, said assistant superintendent of police Apel Mahmud.

Police were raiding different areas to arrest the criminals, said the ASP.
