Amendment to the Call for Expression of Interest (EOI) for National Consultant

The advertisement published in the dailies dated 9 January, 2013 regarding the appointment of National Consultant for the Program of Ministry of Public Administration funded from Revenue Budget has been amended. The details of Terms of Reference with amendments are as follows:

Ministry of Public Administration (MoPA) has undertaken a program for "Networking, Automation, and Database Development in the Ministry of Public Administration" under the revenue budget of the Government for the period of July, 2012 to June, 2014. The Ministry will implement the program. With a view to this, the Ministry intends to engage one individual consultant who will provide consulting services.

The program includes (i) Software Development for automation of major functions of the Ministry such as maintenance/monitoring/disposal of audit objections, pension cases, accommodation allotment, wealth statement of officials, disciplinary actions taken against the officials including Corruption Report of officials, Leave/Lien/Deputation information of officials, legal cases lodged against MoPA, budgetary allocation and expenditure of the Ministry etc; (ii) Design and Development of an integrated database system for all the above functions; (iii) Digitization of Secretariat Library functions; and (iv) Procurement & installation of related hardware, LAN/WAN/VPN in the Ministry.

2. Outline of Terms of Reference of the National Consultant

The main task of National Consultant is to assist the Program Director in implementing the action plan and achieving the objectives of program. The consultant will report to and work under the control and supervision of Program Director. The specific tasks are as follows:

- Requirement Analysis and Specification (RAS) for the abovementioned functions;
- System design and appropriate hardware-software specifications;
- Guiding the Program Director in procuring required hardware/software;
- Assisting the Program Director in installation of LAN/WAN/VPN;
- Preparing standard tender documents as prescribed in Public Procurement Rules;
- Designing training programs for the staff/officials for maintaining of new systems; and
- Assisting the Program Director in commissioning new system for different functions.

3. Qualifications and experiences required

- Minimum Bachelor Degree in Computer Science and Engineering;
- Ten years practical experiences in system designing and developing software for different jobs in public sector;
- Five years experience in database design and development particularly by Oracle;
- Excellent computer skills and ability to work in a fast-paced environment; and
- Strong communication, liaison and negotiation skills.

4. Duration: The duration of the program will be around 18 (eighteen) man-months/person-months.

5. Age: Applicants under 50 years will be given preference.

6. Salary: Salary is negotiable and will be based on the experiences and qualifications in line with the provision of PPR-2008.

7. Interested experts must provide adequate information indicating their qualifications to perform the services. Employed interested persons are advised to apply through proper authority. Only short-listed candidates will be contacted. The consultants will be selected in accordance with the Public Procurement Rules (PPR) 2008.

Re-Invitation for Application for the Post of District Facilitators (DF) under Second Local Governance Support Project (LGSP-II)

The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a credit (Credit No. 5019-BD) from the International Development Association (IDA) towards the cost of Second Local Governance Support Project (LGSP-II) and intends to apply a part of the proceeds to cover eligible payments under the contract for providing support services by recruitment of 40 District Facilitators for the project as staffs for the project period.

The scope of work of the selected District Facilitators include but not limited to: (i) Assist Deputy Director of Local Government (DDLG) to introduce and explain the various aspects of the project to key District, Upazila and UP personnel; (ii) Under the supervision of DDLGs, coordinate project activities with Deputy Commissioners, Upazila Parishad functionaries, UNOs and other key District and Upazila level officials; (iii) Assist DDLGs to arrange District Coordination Committee Meetings at least once every 6 months and help prepare the agenda and minutes of the meeting; (iv) Help prepare Upazila level progress reports for Block Grant Coordination Committee meetings, working closely with the UPs and the UNOs; and (v) Undertake visits to all Upazilas and UPs in the District and communicate project strategies and activities to UNOs and UP chairs, members, secretaries and other relevant stakeholders, as needed. It is expected that the DFs will spend a considerable amount of time -- at least 40% of their working time - in the field engaged directly with UPs and other stakeholders; (vi) Assist UPs to identify their institutional development needs, including systems, personnel and skills, and help prepare institutional development plans; (vii) Link UPs to accredited capacity building service providers; (viii) Support UPs to identify and document their existing good practices and support DDLGs in enabling peer learning and networking among UPs, working with the Horizontal Learning Centre at NILG; (ix) Provide backstopping support and on the job training to UPs in areas of planning, budgeting, financial management, expenditure management, reporting, disclosure, financial audit, performance assessment, safeguards compliance etc., in line with the UP Manual and LGSP II Manual; (x) Assist DDLGs to organize periodic exchange meetings between UPs and government officials at the Upazila and District levels; (xi) Assist DDLGs to monitor UP activities as well as LGSP II implementation progress, as well as to solve LGSP II related implementation issues at the local level; (xii) Assist DDLGs to enter data received from the UPs in the Management Information System and help undertake analyses of the data to prepare district level monitoring reports which will be shared with LGD, district and Upazila administration, UPs, and other relevant stake holders; (xiii) Assist the Upazila administration to select resource persons to act as Upazila Resource Team (URT) members and coordinate training of URTs, working with agencies such as NILG, BARD, and RDA; (xiv) Assist DDLGs and the Upazila administration to organize training of UP functionaries by URTs and other entities, as needed; (xv) Assist DDLGs and NILG in monitoring and evaluating various UP capacity development programmes; (xvi) Assist consultants engaged in LGSP II evaluation and studies, as needed; (xvii) Support functioning of the UP Helpline by providing relevant LGSP II related information, as needed; (xviii) Facilitate audit activities to be performed by FAPAD & CA Firms; (xix) Follow up preparation of broad sheet reply and settlement of audit objections; (xx) Any other responsibility/job assigned by the Project Authority. Details are provided in the Terms of Reference (TOR) of the assignment.

The qualifications and experiences required for the assignment are:

(i) **Qualification:** Key qualifications include-

- A master's in social sciences or any other relevant discipline.
- At least five years practical experience on program management in GOB or donor supported projects.
- Experience of working with local governments will be a plus.
- Excellent communication (written and verbal) and computer skills.
- Ability to work in a fast-paced environment.

The candidates shall be within the age of 45 years on the last date of receiving applications. Copy of SSC certificate must be attached with the application as a proof of age. The District Facilitators will have to work at different districts as decided by the project authority. Selected candidates need to be prepared for extensive field visit for day-to-day monitoring purpose. The DFs will be paid a gross consolidated pay within the range of BDT 65,000.00 to 86,000.00 per month and will be finalized after negotiation with successful candidates only. Deduction of all taxes and VAT, if any, will be applicable on the contract amount as per prevailing rate.

The Local Government Division now invites applications from eligible applicants of Bangladesh to indicate their interest in providing the services. Applicants are invited to provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services and to submit a complete CV along with duly attested copies of (i) recent photograph-2 copies, (ii) relevant certificates-academic and experience, (iii) Copy of National ID/Voter ID/Passport, (iv) Certificate by Chairman, Union Parishad or applicable Local Government authority, (v) Character certificate by Class I Gazetted Officer. Candidates serving in government, semi-government or autonomous bodies of Bangladesh are required to apply through proper channel.

The candidates will be selected through written, computer and oral test. It is expected that the services will be commenced on March, 2013 and shall be completed on June, 2016 at different districts. The continuation of the contractual service will depend on satisfactory annual performance of the District Facilitator.
