FRIDAY'S ATTACK SPARKS PROTEST IN TANGAIL

'Punish culprits, ensure security of newsmen'

Journalists in the district yesterday formed a human chain and held a rally in the town, demanding punishment of the culprits who attacked reporters of private television network Channel 71 on Friday.

Around 100 journalists of different print and electronic media joined the programme in front of the Tangail Press Club in the morning.

Speakers at the rally condemned the brutal attack on the journalists. They demanded security of the local newsmen and quick trial of the attackers.

Later, they went to the office of the superintendent

of police (SP) in Tangail and held a meeting there.

SP Saleh Mohammed Tanvir assured the journalists of taking tougher steps against the attackers and also vowed to take police action against the illegal drug traders in the district.

Meanwhile, the upazila administration in Kalihati served notices on 76 people asking to remove their houses from Sawdagor Para that were constructed illegally on the government khas land.

Acting upazila nirbahi officer in Kalihati Abu Naser Beg issued the notices on Sunday giving the recipients 7 days time.

Earlier on Friday, a group of drug peddlers attacked three journalists of Channel

71 when they were going to Sawdagor Para in Hamidpur area between the border of Ghatail and Kalihati upazilas for covering a report on illegal drug network.

The gang hit them with sticks and sharp weapons indiscriminately, leaving them injured. They also took away the all valuables of the journalists including their cameras.

A day later, hundreds of agitated locals blocked the Tangail-Mymensingh highway, demanding arrest of the culprits who swooped on the newsmen and removal of the drug den from Sawdagor Para.

Later on the same day they vandalised and then set more than 50 houses of alleged drug paddlers on fire.

MANIK SAHA MURDER CASE Journalists demand reinvestigation

Journalists here yesterday demanded reinvestigation into journalist Manik Saha murder case.

They also demanded immediate arrest of the masterminds behind the killing and trial of the killings of around 20 journalists, including Manik Saha, Humayun Kabir Balu, Sagar Sarowar and Meherun Rumi, in a special tribunal.

The demands were made at a discussion held at Khulna Press Club, marking the ninth death anniversary of Manik Saha, senior reporter of the Daily Sangbad and New Age.

Among others, Talukder Abdul Khaleque, mayor of Khulna City Corporation (KCC) and secretary of city unit Awami League Mizanur Rahman Mizan, took part in the discussion with Mokbul Hossain Mintu, president of the press club, in the chair.

Earlier on the day, different socio-cultural organisations, Manik Saha Smrity Parishad, Khulna city unit of AL, CPB and Khulna Union of Journalists (KUJ) placed wreaths at the monument built on the press club premises in memory of the slain journalists.

Manik Saha, also the former president of the press club, was killed in a bomb attack in front of the press club in Choto Mirzapur area on January 15, 2004.

The following day, the

then sub-inspector Ranjit Kumar Das of Khulna Police Station filed two cases without mentioning anyone's name as accused.

On March 19 in 2004, SI Asaduzzaman of the Detective Branch of KMP submitted a charge sheet in a case filed under the Explosive Substances Act to the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate's Court, accusing ten people.

Mosharraf Hossain, the then officer in-charge of Khulna Police Station, submitted another charge sheet in the murder case to the CMM Court on June 20 the same year, accusing five people.

Later, the case was transferred to the Speedy Trial Tribunal in Khulna. Judge of the tribunal asked the DB to reinvestigate the cases following a petition filed by prosecution lawyer Abu Zafar.

As per directive, the then DB inspector Chitta Ranjan Pal submitted a supplementary charge sheet in the murder case on December 2 in 2007, accusing six people.

Contacted, Public Prosecutor Kazi Abu Shaheen said the trial of Manik Saha murder case is being delayed as Magistrate Dewan Abdus Samad, prime prosecution witness of the case, is yet to appear before the court for giving his statement despite issuing summons several times.

2 teenage boys murdered

A schoolboy was murdered at Baladkhal village in Sadar upazila in the district on Monday night.

The deceased was identified as Bidyut Kumar Karmaker, 16, class ten student at Gangoil High School under the upazila and son of Chaitanya Karmaker of the village.

Krisna Mohon, sub inspector of police at Natore police station said, Bidyut and his friend Belal went to Abdulpur for a trip at the

house of Belal's uncle on Monday morning.

They left for home in the afternoon but Bidyut went missing. Locals later found Bidyut's body in a paddy field near their residence and informed the police. Police arrested Belal Hossain, 16, from village in this connection.

Victim's father Chaitanya Karmaker filed a case with Natore police station accusing Belal and 4-5 unidentified criminals yesterday afternoon.

In Dinajpur, a teenage boy has been beaten to

death in the district town.

The deceased was identified Md Alamgir Hossain, 15, son of Abu Bakkar Siddique of Kherpatti in Dinajpur Satellite Town area, reports our correspondent.

Police said, a gang of criminals mercilessly beat up the boy and left him on the roadside at Dinajpur Satellite Town on Monday afternoon.

Later the locals of the area rescued him in a critical condition and took him to Dinajpur Medical College and Hospital where he succumbed to his injuries at

BSF tortures Bangladeshi boy

A Bangladeshi teenage boy was tortured allegedly by Indian Border Security Force (BSF) on Monday night on Nagorbhita border under Baliadangi upazila.

The victim was identified as Mahmud, 19, son of Solaiman of Kashidanga village under the same upazila. His hands and legs were badly damaged.

Operation Officer of 30, Thakurgaon Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) Maj Kazi Alamgir Hossain told this correspondent over cell phone that BSF of Chaklagar camp caught Mahmud and tortured indiscriminately, leaving him seriously injured when he crossed the Indian border about 7:00pm.

Later the BSF men left Mahmud on the

Bangladesh side of the border.

Local people rescue him from the border at about 8:30pm and took him to hospital.

BGB yesterday sent a letter to BSF strongly protesting the indiscriminate torture on the teenage boy.

Meanwhile, 75 cows of Bangladeshi farmers, seized by BSF from Mandumala area in the upazila on Thursday, were not returned till yesterday, reports UNB.

Lt. Col. Towhidul Islam, commander of 30 BGB, said BSF members of Sonamoti Camp took away the cows on allegation of intrusion into Indian land.

The six affected farmers alleged that the cows were grazing inside Bangladesh territory when the Indian border guards seized their domestic animals.

40 hurt in AL infighting

At least 40 people were injured as two rival factions of Awami League (AL) clashed at Ekdala village under Paka union in Bagatipara upazila yesterday. Police said that the clash took place between the activists of Mazibar group and Tipu Sultan group over forming an AL ward committee of the union. Police and locals said, the supporters of both groups gathered at Ekdala at about 4:00pm to form the committee. But they locked in a clash over selecting the president of the committee. Of the injured, Rabiul Islam, 30, Sajal Hossain, 35, and Sujon Ali, 27, were admitted to Bagatipara upazila health complex while the rest took treatment at different local clinics.

Formalin-free kitchen market

Rajganj kitchen market in the city on Monday became the district's first commercial centre pledging to prevent traders from selling formalin-tainted commodities. Comilla City Corporation Mayor Monirul Haque Shakku made the declaration in the morning. Donated by the Comilla City Corporation, the market will now have a machine that can correctly detect formalin in commodities like fish, fruits and other foodstuff. Addressing on the occasion, the Mayor said from now on legal step would be taken if any businessman of the bazar uses formalin in their goods. He called for public awareness, especially among buyers and sellers for checking food adulteration.

Accident death sparks protest

Locals blocked the Dhaka-Aricha highway, protesting the killing of a minor boy in a road accident at Manra in Sadar upazila yesterday. Witnesses said, Ramzan Ali, 5, son of late Berek Mia, resident of Manra, died on the spot as a bus hit him while he was crossing the highway at about 11 am. The bus driver along with his vehicle fled away following the accident. Angered by the accident, local people blocked the highway, hampering traffic movement through the highway at Manra point for about half an hour. The protesters withdrew their blockade after police assured them of taking action and build a speed-breaker at the point.
