

BSRI scientists, workers on indefinite strike

Scientists and workers of Bangladesh Sugarcane Research Institute (BSRI) in the district went on an indefinite strike, demanding removal of the director general (DG) at the institute.

Earlier, we started demonstration in July last year, demanding promotion for over 40 scientists and workers but the DG turned a deaf ear, said.

Contacted, the DG said he could not take any step for promotion of the staffs as a case was pending with a court.

He also refuted the allegation of issuing any order for opening fire.

Ruling party man held with phenyl

Dipankar Raha Bappi, convenor of Birganj upazila Sweekhasebak League, was arrested with 32 bottles of phenyl on Saturday night.

Sources said, a police team, led by ATM Shahin Ahmed ASP (Birganj Circle) raided the party office in Birganj town at around 10.30pm and arrested him along with the phenyl.

However, his other associates managed to escape, police said.

Police also seized a motorbike from the spot.

As the news spread in the upazila, people started celebration of the arrest by bringing out processions by chanting slogans, demanding exemplary punishment to the arrestee.

On the other hand, the senior party leaders started their lobby to free Bappi.

20 shops gutted in Patuakhali

At least 20 shops were gutted in a fire at Pagla Bazar in Dumki upazila early yesterday.

Locals said the fire originated from an electric short circuit at a tea stall and soon engulfed the adjoining shops at about 1:30am.

On information, two fire fighting units from the district town rushed to the spot and doused the blaze after two hours of frantic efforts.

The shop owners claimed that the loss caused by the fire could go up to Tk 50 lakh.



KALPANA CHAKMA ABDUCTION

Roadblock programme in Rangamati passes off

A dawn to dusk roads and waterways blockade programme, called by United People's Democratic Front (UPDF) and its front organisations to press for the demand of an impartial judicial investigation into Kalpana Chakma abduction case, passed off peacefully in the district yesterday.

On Wednesday, Md Sirajuddaula Kutubi, additional chief judicial magistrate of Rangamati, ordered Masood-ul-Hasan, the superintendent of police to conduct further investigation into Kalpana abduction case and submit report by March 20.

Despite strong demand for judicial investigation by the plaintiff of the case and his counsels, the magistrate gave the order, showing reason of shortage of judicial officers and staffs for that task.

Demanding judicial probe into the sensational

case, leaders and activists of UPDF and its front organisations yesterday brought out processions and held protest rallies at different places including Kutukchhari Bazar, Naniarchar and Kawkhali.

Vehicles went off the roads and water transports stopped plying the river routes from the district town to upazilas during the daylong blockade.

All business establishments in Rangamati town also remained closed.

Kalpana Chakma, an activist of Hill Women's Federation, has remained traceless since her abduction from Rangamati on July 16 in 1996.

8 BNP men sued in Bogra

A case has been filed with Nandigram PS accusing 8 BNP leaders and activists on charge of vandalising the pictures of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman and Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina. According to the case statement, Nandigram Krishak League under Burul union was holding a meeting at its temporary office on Saturday noon. BNP leader Mosaraf Hossen and his party men, equipped with homemade lethal weapons, attacked the office and left several injured. The attackers also vandalised the pictures of Bangabandhu and Prime Minister Hasina. Later Krishak League ward-4 unit leader Nirmal Chandra lodged a case accusing 8 BNP leaders activists yesterday. Contacted, main accused Mosaraf Hossen said it was a false case because at that time he was at Biswa Ijtema in the capital.

12 hurt in BCL infighting

At least 12 activists were injured in a clash between two groups of Bangladesh Chhatra League at Noakhali Science and Technology University (NSTU) yesterday afternoon. Witnesses said, the incident happened when the admission of first year honours was in progress on the campus for the academic year 2013-14. Following an alteration between the supporters of Bappi group and Majed group over a trivial issue, a chase and counter-chase began which later turned into violent clashes.

College student shot

A college student was seriously injured as a gang of criminals shot him at Ganji Patti intersection at Narsingdi Bazar yesterday morning. Russel Mahmud, 22, a second year student of Narsingdi Government College, also son of Abdus Sattar of Boukur area in the town, was having his hair cut at a saloon. One Al Amir called him out of the saloon to the nearby road, where his gangman Shanta appeared on the scene and fired three shots at Russel. The two youths fled the scene as locals rushed to the spot hearing the sound of gunshots.

18-party calls hartal
