BIKASH SCHOOL



'BIKASH' in traditional Bengali terminology means 'to blossom'. With that in mind, a school for the physically challenged and underprivileged children of the local community has been given the name 'BIKASH'. This special school will cater to physically handicapped children from physical deformities to children with vision problems (blindness) along with underprivileged children of the local community. VIYELLATEX believes in the motto of 'we do not feed but we teach to fish'. The school is a joint-initiative supported by VIYELLATEX Welfare Trust of VIYELLATEX group and the OLYMP-BEZNER-FOUNDATION of OLYMP Germany. Both parties will share equal expense of the school.

The school will follow the national curriculum set by the Ministry of Education and it is set to be formally inaugurated on 24th January 2013. BIKASH presently has five (5) teachers who received a yearlong special training from the Center for the Rehabilitation of the Paralyzed (CRP) at Savar. The school will house a total of 200+ children from classes 1 to 5 along with a special pre-primary class called the Early Childhood Development (ECD) program. With the motto of promoting VIYELLATEX's social sustainability charter, BIKASH is set to be another milestone project of VIYELLATEX in the education sector.


