

Construction of bldg on school playground triggers protest

People of Sadar upazila brought out a procession and formed a human chain in the town yesterday, protesting

construction of a multi-storied building on the playground of a school in the upazila.

The participants at the human chain alleged

that Abdus Sattar, president of the managing committee of Joyra High School, was constructing the building, occupying the school's play-

ground.

They demanded Sattar's removal as president of the school managing committee and urgent steps to stop the construction work.

They also threatened to go for a tougher programme if the demands were not met immediately.

Among others, chairman of the upazila Ataur Rahman Ata, and member of the managing committee Delwar Hossain, took part in the programme.

Contacted, Abdus Sattar said that he was constructing the building on a portion of land of the playground which he bought in 1996.

Headmaster Mahbuba Akter said that over 400 students of the school will be deprived of the opportunity to play due to the construction of the building.

Interns, BCL at Rangpur medical threaten strike

Interns and Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) at Rangpur Medical College will enforce an indefinite strike from Saturday in case of the authorities failure to arrest the killers of BCL leader Rezwanur Rahman Miraz before the deadline.

They also demanded a permanent police camp on the college campus, cancellation of internship of Dr. Pulok and permanent expulsion of students Rahat Al Rajib, Raisul Islam Nobin, Sonjib Kumar Shingha, Sohag Hossain, Imran Hossain and Shafi.

Intern Doctors' Association (IDA) and BCL unit jointly announced the decision at a press conference at Rangpur Medical College auditorium yesterday noon.

Among others, Md. Mehedi Hasan Sumon Prodhon, general secretary of BCL college unit, Dr. Sohel Rana, president of IDA college unit, Dr. Mahmud Shah Sujon, general secretary of IDA, spoke.

They alleged that a gang aided by Dr. Pulok, Rahat Al Rajib, Raisul Islam Nobin, Sonjib Kumar Shingha, Sohag Hossain, Imran Hossain and Shafi stabbed Rezwanur Rahman Miraz, president of BCL Rangpur Medical College unit on Monday night.

They said the college authorities expelled them from the hostels for life and for two years from the college for their involvement with different illegal activities.

They said, as the students of the college, led by Rezwanur Rahman Miraz, demanded cancellation of internship of Dr. Pulok and protested their illegal activi-

ties, they attacked Miraz. The gang stabbed Miraz indiscriminately with lethal weapons in his left hand, fingers, chest and neck, leaving him seriously injured.

As an ultimatum of 24-hours to the college authorities to arrest the criminals went unheeded, the IDA and BCL again issued a 24-hour deadline to fulfill the demands.

If the authorities again fail to meet our demands within the stipulated time, the IDA and BCL will enforce an indefinite strike from Saturday, the leaders said.

Meanwhile, Prof Abdur Rauf principal of Rangpur Medical College told this correspondent that they formed a 5-member body, headed by Prof Nur Islam, to probe the incident.

Prof Rauf said they gave the probe body seven days to submit their report.

13 hurt as AL, Jamaat men lock in clash

At least 13 people were injured in a clash between the local activists of Awami League and Jamaat-e-Islami in Burimari land port area of Patgram upazila yesterday.

At least 15 shops were vandalised and three motorbikes damaged during the clash.

Police arrested Mominur Rahman, 40, son of late Mokbul Hossain of Burimari village and Jamaat activist after the clash.

Police said the clash took place when AL men resisted the activists of Jamaat-Shibir who brought out a procession in the area, demanding immediate release of their leaders on war crime trial.

Additional police have been deployed in the area to avert further trouble, said Sohrab Hossain, officer in-charge at Patgram police station.

Drug racket smashed

Authorities on Monday smashed the drug racket at Sawdagor Para in Kalihati upazila of the district.

A team comprising executive magistrate in Tangail Bhaskor Debnath, additional superintendent of police (Gopalpur circle) Shajahan Miah, assistant engineer of Roads and Highways Department (RHD) in Tangail Abdul Hakim and Upazila Nirbahi Officer (Acting) in Kalihati Abu Naser Beg and policemen launched an eviction drive at noon.

Earlier on January 13, the upazila administration in Kalihati served notices on 76 people asking them to remove their houses from Sawdagor Para in 7 days as those were constructed illegally on the government khas land.

The administration on Monday evicted them as they failed to remove their houses by the deadline.

On January 11, a group of drug peddlers attacked three journalists of private television Channel '71. They are staff reporter Faisal Alam, Tangail district reporter SM Razzak and videographer Manzur Rashid Mamun. They were going to Sawdagor Para in Hamidpur area between the border of Kalihati and Ghatail upazilas for covering a report on illegal drug trade.

The gang hit them with sticks and sharp weapons indiscriminately, leaving them injured. They also took away the all valuables of the journalists including their camera, mobile telephone sets and cash money during the attack.

Stray incidents of violence mark Jamaat-Shibir hartal

The half-day hartals enforced by Bangladesh Jamaat-e-Islami and Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS) in Rajshahi, Natore, Chapainawabganj, and Laxmipur passed off amid stray incidents of violence yesterday.

Shibir, the student wing of Jamaat, enforced an eight-hour shutdown in Rajshahi, Natore and Chapainawabganj demanding release of Mostafizur Rahman, social welfare secretary of Shibir central committee and former president of its Rajshahi city unit, and Atiqur Rahman, central office secretary, report our correspondents.

The pro-hartal activists vandalised at least 11 vehicles in Natore and Chapainawabganj during hartal hours.

Our Noakhali corre-

spondent reported that Jamaat-Shibir enforced hartal in Laxmipur, home district of Atiqur, demanding his immediate release. The pickets blasted several cocktails during a clash with policemen in the district town, leaving at least five people injured.

On the other hand, Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), the student wing of the ruling Awami League, observed a hartal in Tangail until 2:00pm, protesting the killing of one of its leaders, according to our correspondent.

In Rajshahi city, the hartal supporters could not take to the street as huge contingents of law enforcers were deployed at all the key points.

Besides, police on Tuesday banned all kinds of gatherings and rallies in the city for 16 hours from 6:00am yesterday.

In Natore, the hartal supporters vandalised at least 10 vehicles in Lalpur, Baraigram and Singra upazilas in the morning.

In Chapainawabganj, the Shibir men staged demonstrations by burning tyres on road in different places of the district town in the morning.

Chase and counter-chase between law enforcers and Shibir activists took place at Shibtala in the town at around 10:00am when the Shibir men tried to bring out a procession in the area.

Pickets vandalised a truck in Swarupnagar area in the district town at around 11:15am. On Tuesday night, police picked up at least seven Jamaat-Shibir activists from Nachole, Gomastapur, Bholahat and Shibganj upazilas of the district.

In Laxmipur, Shibir

activists clashed with police in the bus terminal area during hartal hours, leaving at least five people, including a cop, injured.

The clash ensued when police intercepted a procession brought out by Shibir in the area at around 7:00am. Jamaat's student wing enforced the shutdown demanding release of their central leader Atiqur, who was arrested from Dhanmondi area in the capital on Monday.

Sub-Inspector Shahadat Hossain of Laxmipur Sadar Police sustained injuries when Shibir men blasted cocktails and hurled brick chips at the law enforcers.

Police lobbed several tear gas shells to disperse the pickets. Shibir activists also set fire to tyres on different roads of the district.
