On information, a police team led by OC Ali Ahmed chased down the bus and forced it to pull over at Bharasimla intersection on Satkhira-Kaliganj road.

Fearing trouble, the section in Satkhira town. Islamist party activists attacked the cops and injured OC Masud, Subinspectors Yasin and Belal and constables Mahbub and Sona Miah.

Police rounded up 103 Jamaat-Shibir men from the bus and recovered two rifles looted from the law enforcers.

However, bus driver Abu Jafar and some other attackers managed to flee the scene.

In an arson attack, two ATM booths of Islami Bank and some papers of a local madrasa were set ablaze in the town.

As part of their countrywide demonstration, some Jamaat-Shibir activists brought out a protest procession around 4:30pm, according to witnesses.

As the procession reached the local mosque intersection, police obstructed the protesters.

Being halted, the Jamaat-Shibir men hurled brickbats at police, forcing the law enforcers to retaliate by firing 30 rubber bullets.

Meanwhile, activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League and Jubo League brought out a procession in the town around 5:30pm.

After parading through different streets, they set the ATM booths of Islami Bank afire and burnt the papers of Al-Madrasatud Deenia Madrasa, allegedly run by Jamaat men, near Godar mosque area.

On information, firefighters rushed to the spot and doused the flames.

Mahbubur Rashid acting superintendent of police in Noakhali, confirmed the incident.

it clear that under his stewardship, Pakistan's crisis over the language question would only be exacerbated. He visited Dhaka in January 1952. At a public meeting on January 27, he reiterated the old argument of the ruling classes that Urdu would be the state language of the country as noted in the report of the Basic Principles Committee. His pronouncement left Nurul Amin, chief minister of East Bengal, surprised and irritated. Amin, who briefly was to serve as Pakistan's prime minister nearly two decades later in December 1971 before going on to serve as its vice president

was to recall the day 20 years after Nazimuddin made his comments:

"In the course of (Nazimuddin's) lengthy speech from a written script, he mentioned that Urdu shall be the state language. The statement was not only uncalled for but also inconsistent with the stand of the Muslim League members of the CA (Constituent Assembly) from East Pakistan and the assurances received from a section of their counterpartsfrom the West...

"The prime minister seemed to have been so effectively briefed from interested quarters that he kept such an inflammable issue a guarded secret from me even and did not have the courtesy to consult me.

. . I was sitting on the dais where he was speaking from and as soon as he uttered the sentence I could foresee its consequences. When I charged him after the meeting, he under Zulfikar Ali Bhutto, told me that the brief was was on the dais that day. He prepared in Karachi."


