'Robber' beaten to death

A suspected robber was killed in a mob beating at Dakkhin Majbaria village in Sadar upazila early yesterday. The identity of the deceased could not be known immediately. Police said, a gang swooped on the house of one Abdul Kader of the village at around 3:00am. Hearing the hue and cry, locals chased the robbers and caught one of them while the rest managed to flee. The mob then gave him a good beating, leaving him critically injured. He was rushed to Feni Sadar Hospital where he died after sometime, said Mosharaf Hossain, assistant sub-inspector at Feni Sadar Model police Station.

Indian citizen held

Members of Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) on Monday arrested an Indian citizen on Kashipur frontier in Phulbari upazila on charge of illegal intrusion. The arrestee is Ukil Chandra Sarker, 45, of border village Sheuti under Dinhatata police station in Cooch Behar district of Paschimbanga. Mohammad Ali, company commander of 45 BGB Battalion in Kurigram, said they arrested Ukil while he was entering Bangladesh territory through the border. He was handed over to Phulbari police, said the commander.

UP chairman suspended

Local government and rural development (LGRD) ministry on Sunday suspended the chairman of Kazla union in Sariakandi upazila on charge of misappropriating Tk 3 lakh. The accused is ASM Rafiqul Islam, said Md Zillur Rahman Khan, upazila nirbahi officer. The UP chairman recently misappropriated the money of a project under the ministry, said the UNO. Following a probe report, the ministry sent a letter to his office over the suspension, he said. Despite repeated attempts, this correspondent could not reach the accused over phone for his comment in the regard.

Procession, rally demanding smooth supply of gas

Townpeople brought out a procession and held a rally yesterday, demanding adequate gas supply to households.

The speakers at the rally held in front of the deputy commissioner's office warned that they would stop payment of bill if the authorities failed to ensure gas supply.

To mitigate the woes of the townspeople, they urged the authorities to ensure gas

supply to the households at least three times a day each for two hours.

They blamed a section of corrupt officials and employees at the gas office in the town for creating the gas crisis by selling gas to the industries and CNG stations.

They also threatened to go for tougher programmes if the problem was not resolved within seven days.

The programmes include Dhaka-Aricha road blockade and laying siege to the district gas office.

Among others, Jatiya

Samajtantrik Dal (JSD-Inu) Manikganj district unit president Iqbal Hossain Khan and Gazi Kamrul Huda Selim, general secretary of district unit AL, spoke.

Contacted, Sirajul Islam, manager of Titas Gas and Distributing Company Limited, Manikganj, said they informed the higher authorities about the matter but yet to get any response.

There are 13,932 domestic, 100 business and 60 industrial lines and 20 CNG stations under the office, said sources.

771 Jamaat-Shibir men sued in two districts

Police filed cases against 771 Jamaat and Shibir activists in Chapainawabganj and Rangpur districts on Monday.

They sued 271 Jamaat-Shibir activists in Chapainawabganj on charge of obstructing police from duty and attacking police and local Awami League office, reports our correspondent.

Sub-Inspector Kabir Hossain of Shibganj police station filed the case with the PS at night.

Of the accused, 71 were named while 200 others remained unidentified.

Earlier, police arrested 7 Jamaat-Shibir activists from Shibganj municipal area on Monday afternoon.

Officer in-charge (OC) of Shibganj PS Zamil Uddin said, a group of Jamaat-Shibir activists brought out a procession near Academy area of Shibganj municipality and tried to stop the vehicular movement.

When police rushed to the spot and tried to disperse the procession, the activists attacked them.

Jamaat-Shibir men also brought out a procession at Shibganj bazar on Monday morning and ransacked chairs, tables, banners and screen of Gono Jagoran Mancha at T&T ground.

They also attacked Awami League office and ransacked it, police said.

Rangpur Kotwali police filed two separate cases on Monday against 300 leaders and activists of Jamaat-Shibir, reports our correspondent.

The cases were filed on charge of attack on police, arson and vandalising of two police pickup vans in the morning on Rangpur-Dinajpur highway in Hajirhat area in the city during the countrywide dawn-to-dusk hartal enforced by Jamaat-e-Islami.

Police and locals said, at around 11:00am on Monday, Jamaat-Shibir activists blocked Rangpur-

Dinajpur highway in Hajirhat area by putting logs.

On information, police rushed to the spot and charged baton to disperse the pro-hartal activists, triggering a clash.

Jamaat-Shibir men attacked police with bamboo sticks, leaving at least 20 people including two police men injured. They also damaged a police van and set it on fire.

Following the incidents police lodged two separate cases accusing 300 Jamaat-Shibir leaders and activists at night.

Pirgachha police on Monday afternoon filed a case accusing 200 leaders and activists of Jamaat-Shibir for attack on police during the hartal hours on Monday in Deuty Bazaar area.

Jamaat-Shibir men attacked police, leaving Shahidul Islam 30, a constable of Pirgachha police station, injured.

He was admitted to Rangpur Medical College Hospital.

ALLEGATION OF RAPE OF HOUSEWIFE

Two Jubo League activists arrested in Patuakhali

Two Jubo League men were arrested on Monday night on charge of raping a 35-year-old housewife at Nijkata village under Rangabali upazila of the district.

Following a case filed by the victim on Monday, five days after the incident, Rangabali Police arrested Md Kawsar, 28, general secretary of Jubo League Mowdubi union unit, and Jahir, 27, a member of the unit, from their houses at the same village.

In the case statement, the

victim stated that as her husband had gone fishing on the Bay, she along with her three daughters was asleep at their house. "Taking advantage of his absence, Kawsar and Jahir entered the house by breaking open the door at midnight on February 13 and raped me in front of my daughters," she said.

She further stated that Kawsar and Jahir threatened to kill my daughters and asked them not to make a sound.

Police quoted locals as saying that the victim informed her neighbours of

the matter the following day, but they advised her to go to the police station.

Her husband returned home on Wednesday and heard about the incident. When they were going to file a case with Rangabali Police Station on Thursday, they got waylaid by the rapists.

The victim along with her husband came to Patuakhali Police Station on Monday and told the law enforcers about the incident. Being informed by Patuakhali police, Rangabali Police Station recorded the case the same day and arrested the Jubo League men.

Madrasa boy falls off swing, dies

A madrasa student was killed as he fell off a swing at Pratappur village in Keshobpur upazila in Jessore on Monday afternoon.

The deceased was identified as Mohsin Ali, 12, a class VI student of Pratappur Dakhil Madrasah and son of Abul Hossain Sarder of the village.

Abul Hossain, said Mohsin along with his classmates was playing at a tin-shed room of the madrasa in the afternoon. Suddenly he fell off the swing which left him injured, he said.

He was rushed to Keshobpur upazila health complex and then referred to Khulna Medical College Hospital, but he died on the way.
